> The Nanos-UB North American Monitor Year 12 of Tracking

In 2005, Nanos Research, in partnership with the State University of New York at Buffalo embarked on a cooperative research initiative. The objective of the initiative was to add to the unfolding dialogue and discussion on Canada-US relations in a manner that engaged stakeholders, institutions, and entrepreneurs in a direct fashion. Now in its twelfth wave of tracking, the current wave of research is based on the opinions of 1,000 Canadians and 1,000 Americans. Parallel questions on bi-national issues were tracked by means of a hybrid telephone and online random sample of Canadians in the month of May, and a random representative online sample of Americans conducted in the month of June. This report contains primarily the Canadian data.

> A Nanos RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,000 Canadians was conducted between May 27th to June 1st, 2016 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone (land- and celllines) and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data. The margin of error for a random survey of 1,000 Canadians is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. Between June 2nd and June 3rd, 2016, a random representative online survey of 1,000 Americans was conducted. Results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data.

The comparative countries tested in the research grid are based on the top trading partners common to both countries, including: Britain; Japan; France; Germany; China; and, Mexico. This initiative is intended as a mechanism through which Canadian and American regional and national stakeholders and institutions can (i) measure ongoing public opinion on issues relevant to the Canada-US relationship; and, (ii) continue the dialogue among key national, state and provincial government and business stakeholders.



Higher support for Canada and US to follow own interests; closer cooperation between the two countries on antiterrorism measures is on the rise

The Nanos-UB North American Monitor has been tracking the sentiment of Canadians and Americans for twelve years. A look at the data trends suggests changing perceptions of the bi-national relationship.

The support of Canadians to follow their country's own interests has surpassed the seven year high of 63% (2009 - 63%; 2016 - 64%), while the agreement of Americans to follow their country's own interests has increased in the past eleven years (2005 - 51%; 2016 - 61%).

Americans continue to see Canada as the country closest to them in terms of human rights (41%), family values (41%) and business values (22%), while Canadians see Britain as the country closest to them in terms of human rights (50%) and family values (44%), with the US ranking as the second country, but continue to see Americans as having the most similar business values (60%).

While there has been a rise for Canadian support towards increasing cooperation with the US on national security over the past three years (2013 - 45%; 2016 - 54%), there has been no increase or decrease in the United States for closer cooperation on national security with Canada since last year (2015 - 68%; 2016 - 68%). There has been an incline in Canada regarding support for cooperation regarding border security since last year (2015 - 56%; 2016 - 60%), while there has been no increase or decrease in the United States since last year (2015 - 71%; 2016 - 71%). Support from both Canadians and Americans is on the rise when it comes to closer cooperation on anti-terrorism measures.

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Bi-National Tracking Numbers













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Canadians on which country is closest in terms of human rights...







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


Business Values


Question: Thinking about the US in relation with the countries below, could you please rank the top two countries that are closest with the United States in terms of business values? [ROTATE]

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





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









Methodology

The Nanos-UB North American Monitor is conducted by the Nanos Research Corporation, which is headquartered in Canada and operates both in Canada and the United States. Parallel questions on bi-national issues are tracked by means of a hybrid telephone and online random sample of Canadians in the month of May, and a random representative online sample of Americans conducted in the month of June.

A Nanos RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,000 Canadians was conducted in May 2016 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data. The margin of error for a random survey of 1,000 Canadians is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

Between June 2nd and June 3rd, 2016, a random representative online survey of 1,000 Americans was conducted. Results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data.
