The Nanos-UB North American Monitor Year 13 of Tracking

In 2005, Nanos Research, in partnership with the State University of New York at Buffalo embarked on a co-operative research initiative. The objective of the initiative was to add to the unfolding dialogue and discussion on Canada-US relations in a manner that engaged stakeholders, institutions, and entrepreneurs in a direct fashion. Now in its thirteenth wave of tracking, the current wave of research is based on the opinions of 1,000 Canadians and 1,000 Americans. Parallel questions on bi-national issues were tracked by means of a hybrid telephone and online random sample of Canadians in the month of May, and a random representative online sample of Americans conducted in the month of June. This report contains primarily the Canadian data.

A Nanos RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,000 Canadians was conducted between June 7th and June 9th, 2017 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone (land- and cell-lines) and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data. The margin of error for a random survey of 1,000 Canadians is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. Between June 7th and 9th, 2017, a random representative online survey of 1,000 Americans was conducted. Results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data.

The comparative countries tested in the research grid are based on the top trading partners common to both countries, including: Britain; Japan; France; Germany; China; and, Mexico. This initiative is intended as a mechanism through which Canadian and American regional and national stakeholders and institutions can (i) measure ongoing public opinion on issues relevant to the Canada-US relationship; and, (ii) continue the dialogue among key national, state and provincial government and business stakeholders.

Noticeable increase in Americans not wanting pursue their own interests; Canadian view on alignment with US on human rights hits 13 year low

The Nanos-UB North American Monitor has been tracking the sentiment of Canadians and Americans for 13 years. A look at the data trends suggests changing perceptions of the bi-national relationship. This is the first wave with Donald Trump as President of the United States.

Americans wanting to follow their country's own interests has seen a significant decline in this wave (2005 – 51%; 2016 – 61%; 2017 – 50%) after having increased over the past 12 years. Support from Canadians to follow their country's own interests has decreased marginally, (2016 – 64%; 2017 – 61%), and the percentage of those who strongly agree has decreased since 2016 (2016 – 28%; 2017 – 17%).

Canadians see Britain as the country closest to them in terms of human rights (44%), while their views on human rights alignment with the US continued to decrease to a new 13 year (16%), falling behind Germany (25%). Canadians also see Britain as closest in family values (45%), but continue to see Americans as having the most similar business values, although this has decreased since 2016 (2016 - 60%; 2017 – 51%). Americans continue to see Canada as the country closest to them in terms of human rights (43%) and family values (39%), but in terms of business values they have shifted towards Britain (24%).

While Canadian support towards increasing cooperation with the US on national security has risen over the past four years , it marginally decreased in 2017 (2013 – 45%; 2016 – 54%; 2017 – 53%), and in the United States support for closer cooperation on national security with Canada has increased slightly since last year (2016 – 68%; 2017 – 72%), changing for the first time since 2014. In terms of support Canadians have for cooperation regarding border security , this has decreased slightly since last year (2016 – 59%; 2017 – 56%), while there has been consistent results in the United States for the past three years (2015 – 69%; 2016 – 68%; 2017 – 69%). Support from both Canadians and Americans remains fairly consistent when it comes to closer cooperation on anti-terrorism measures (US – 78%; Canada – 59%).

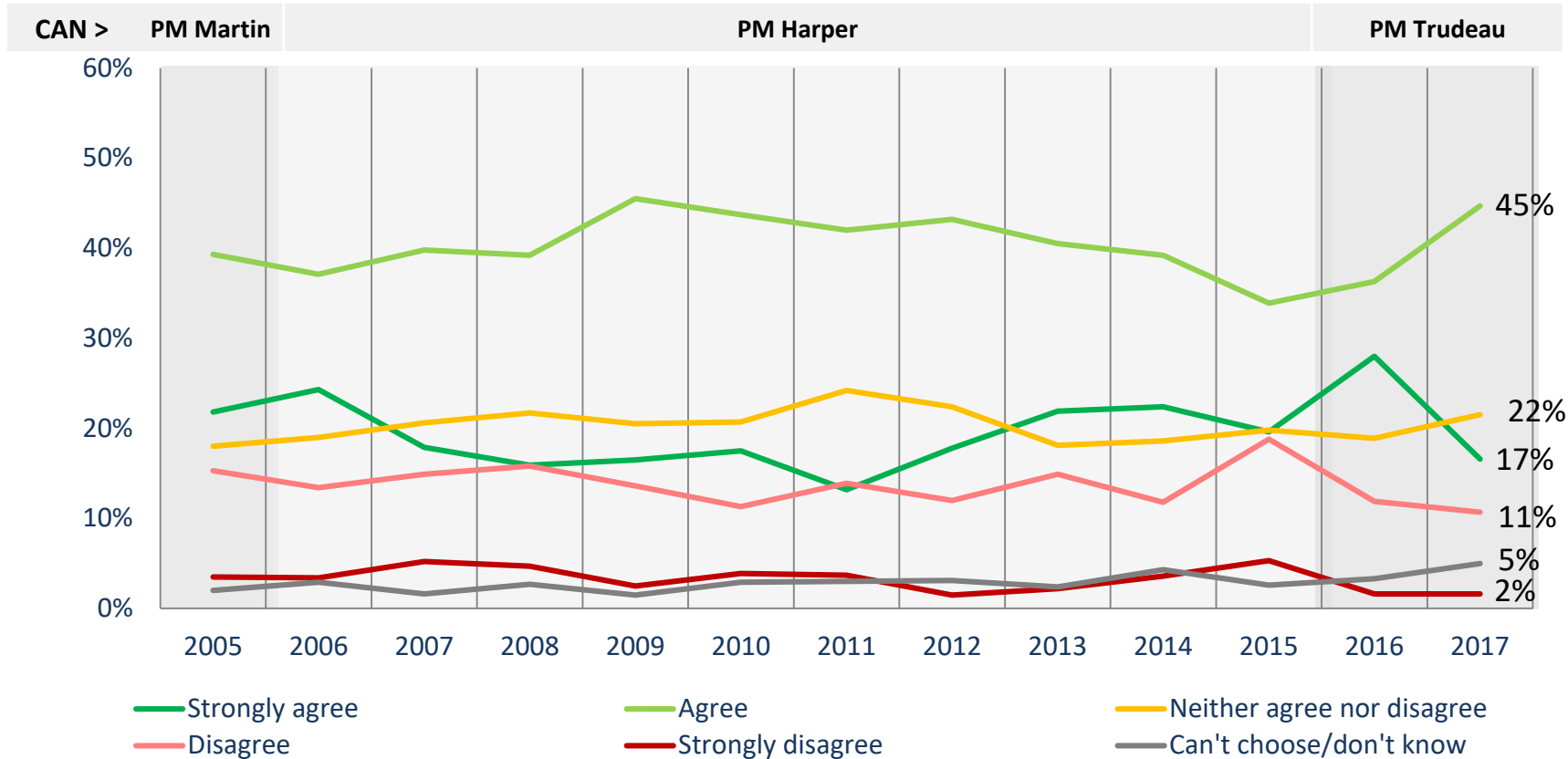

Canadians on following Canada's interests

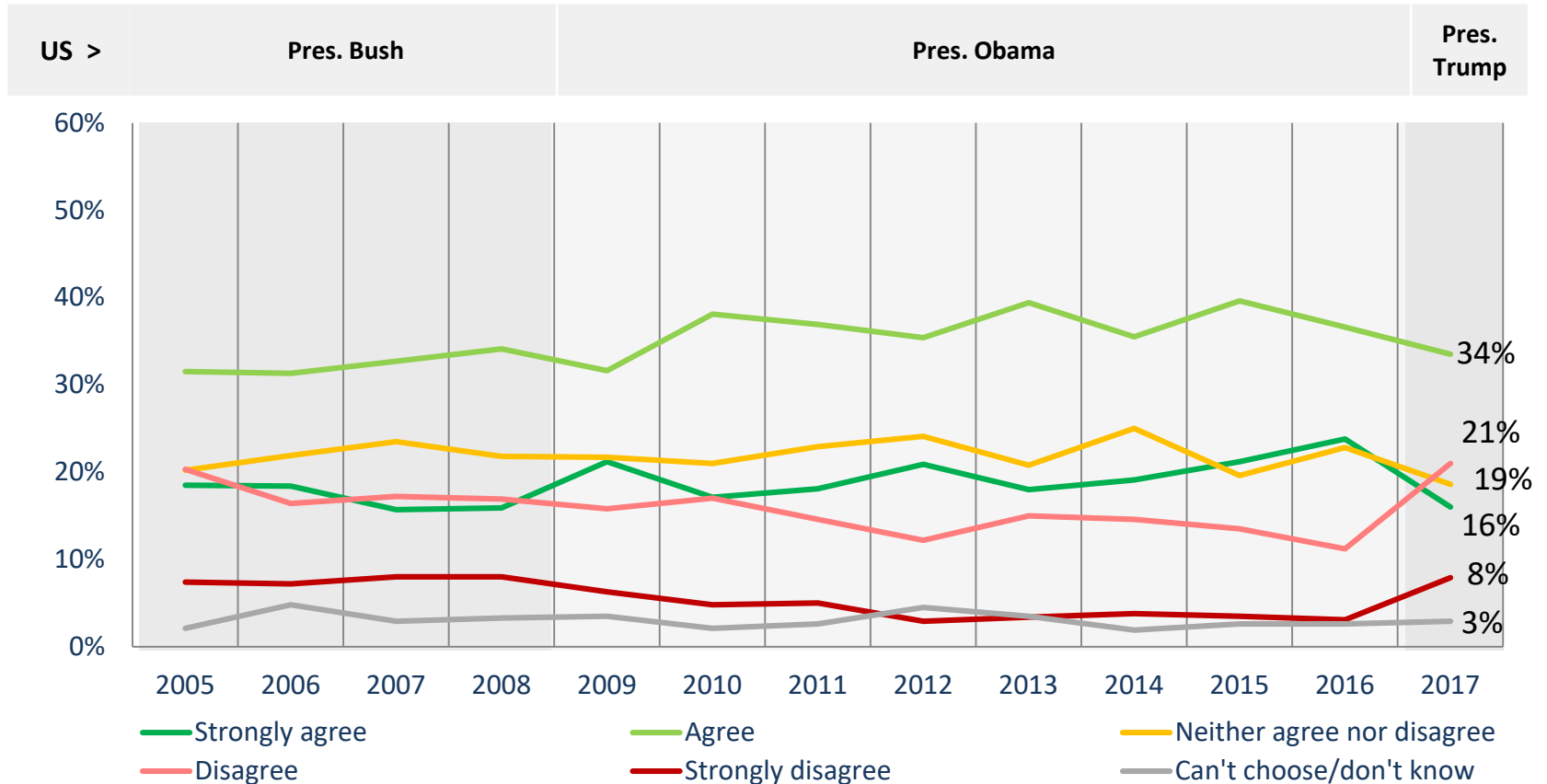

Americans on following US interests

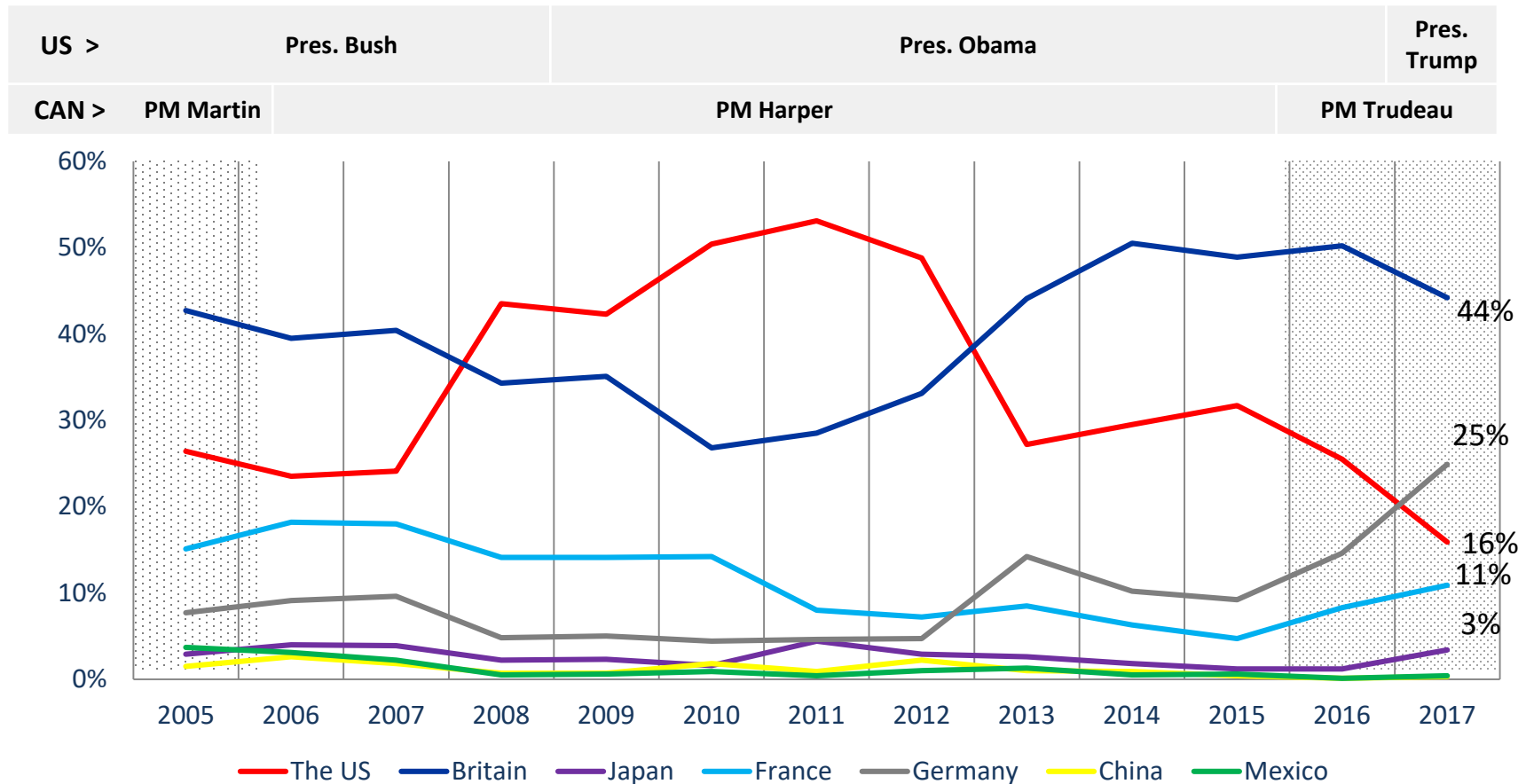

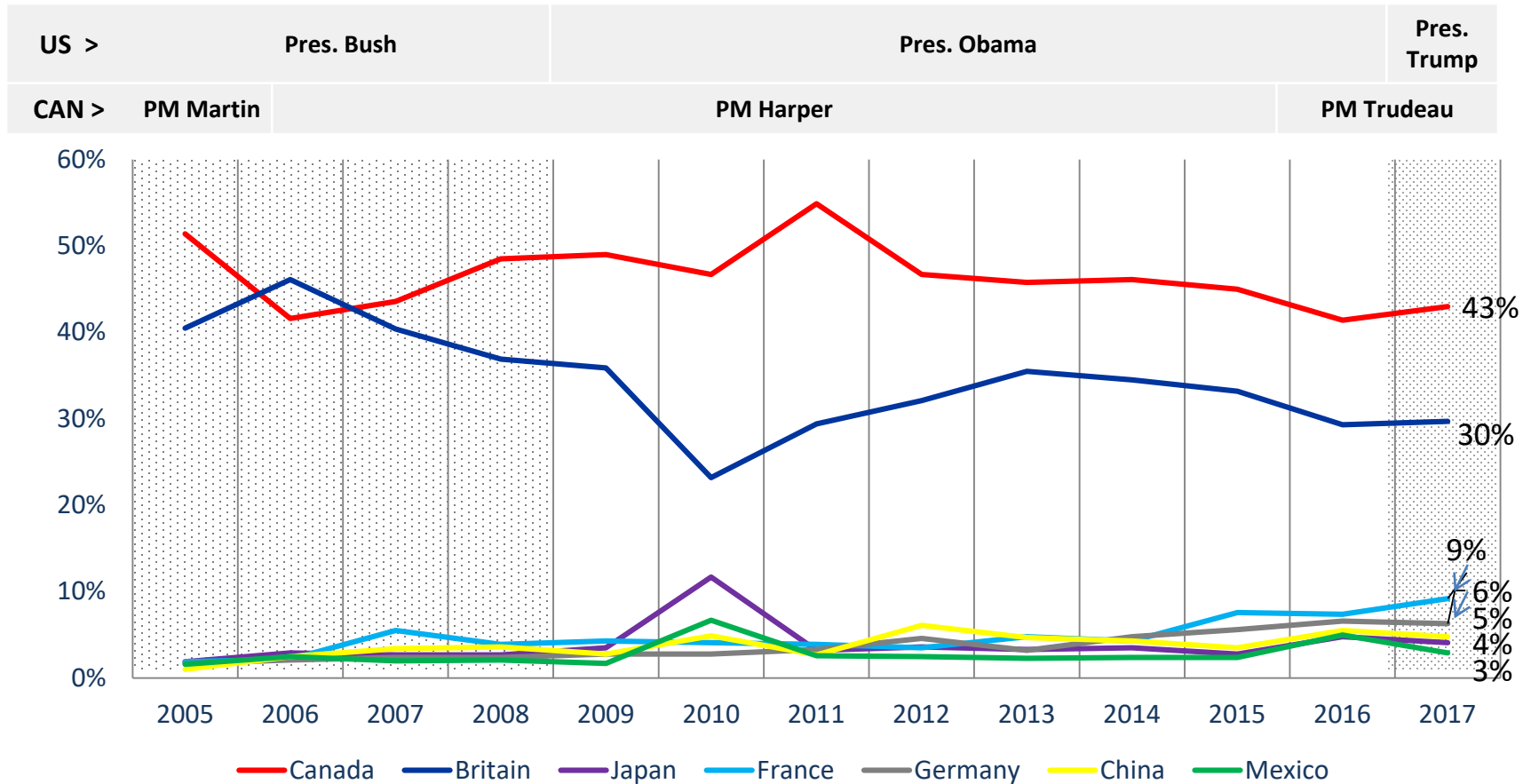

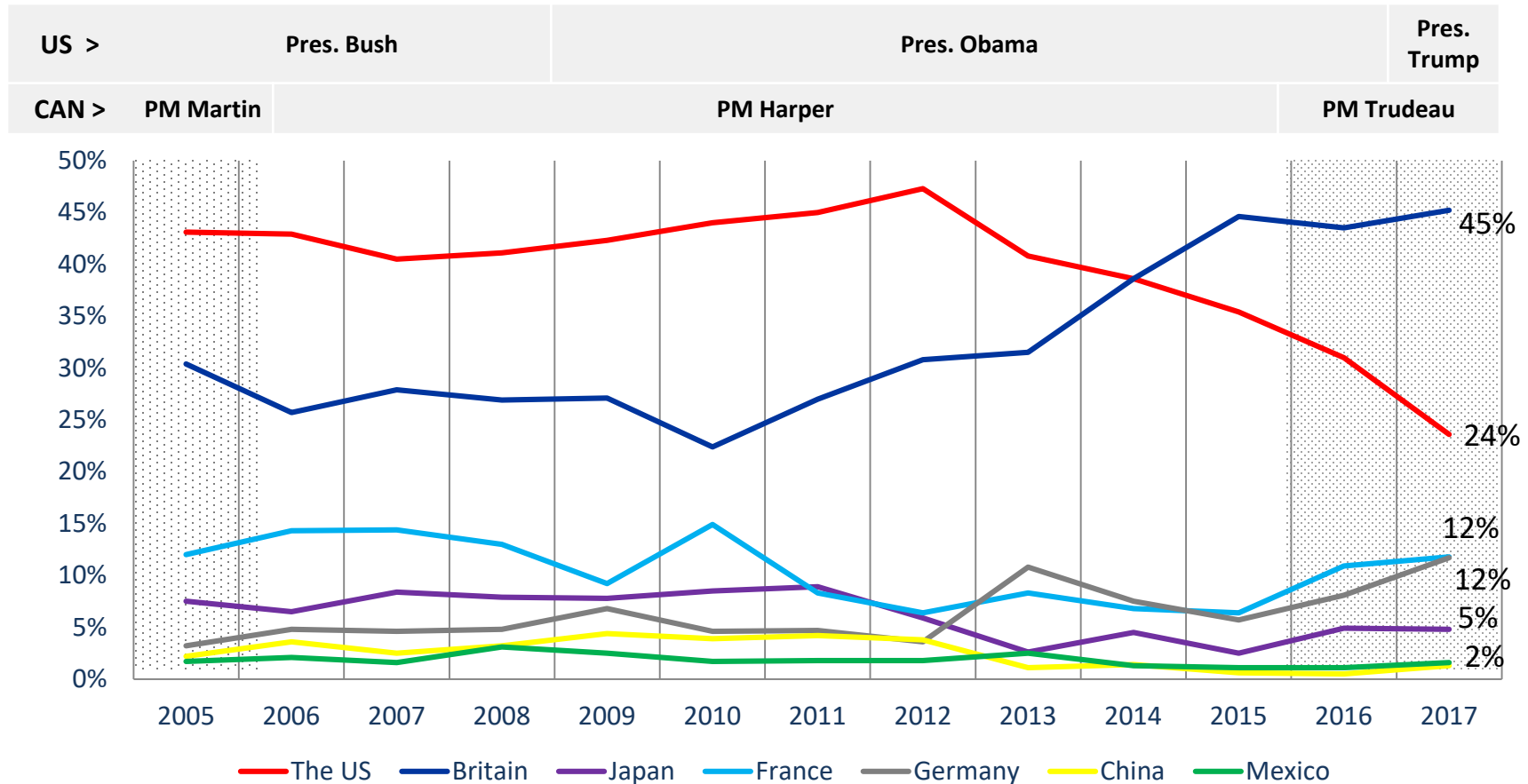

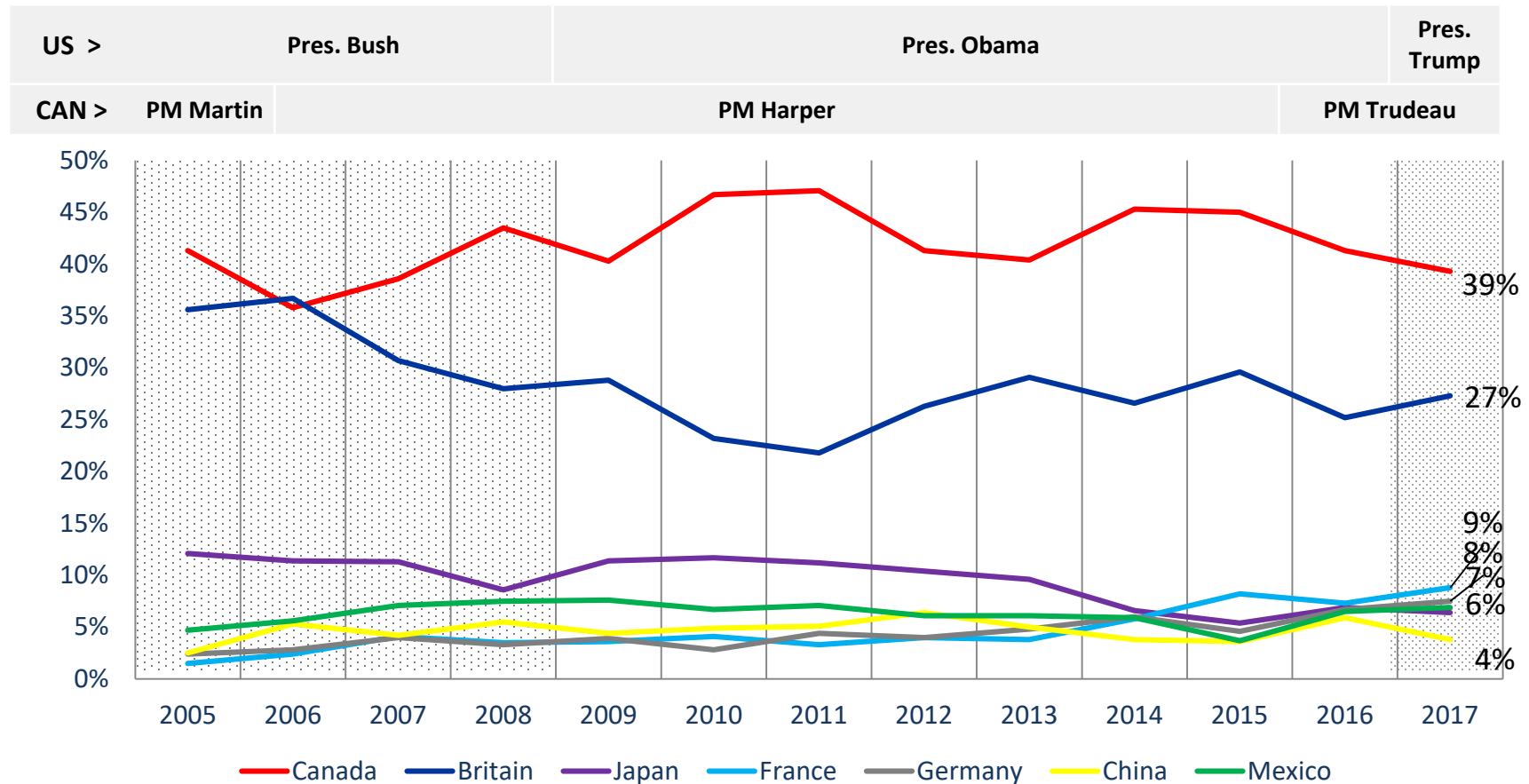

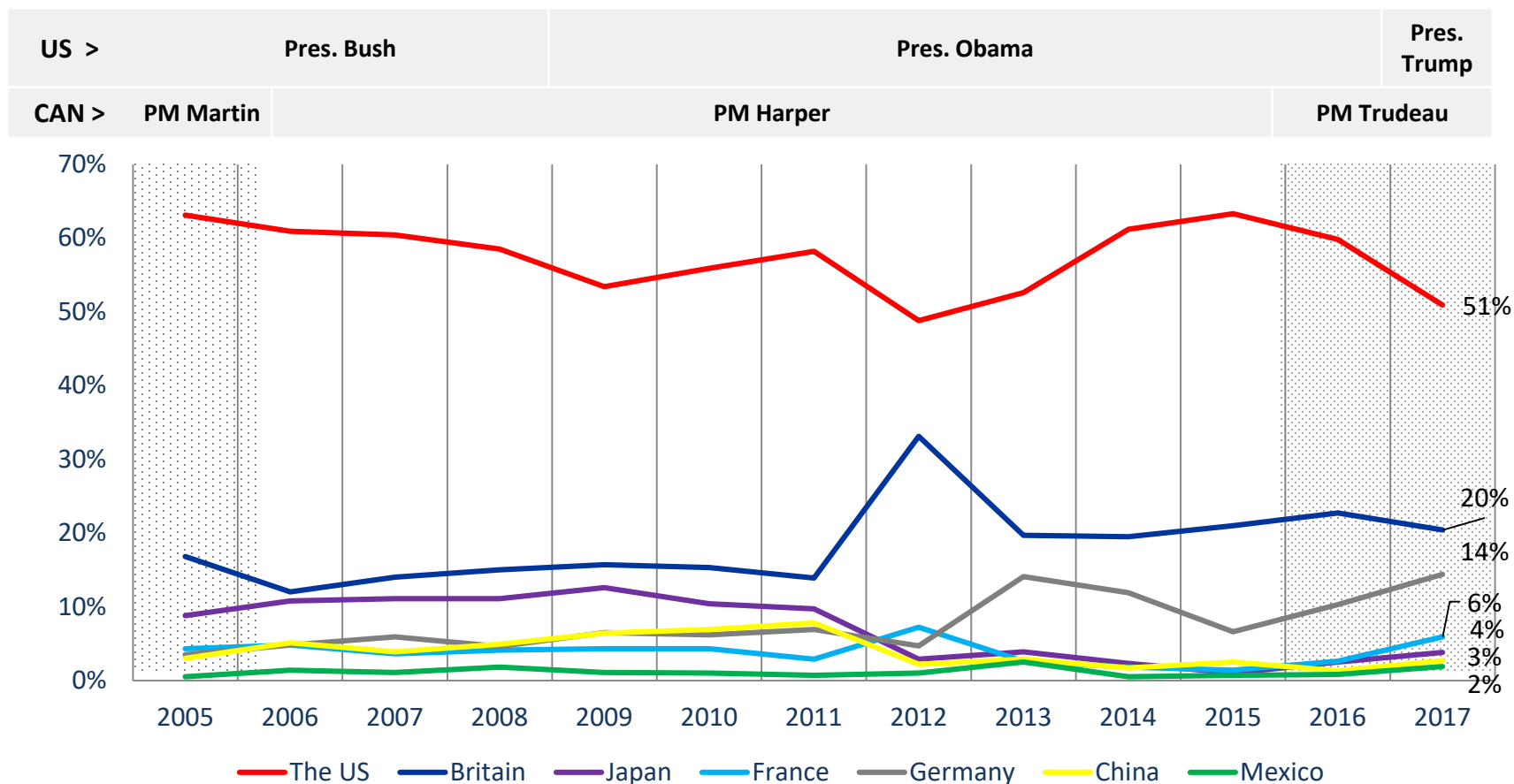

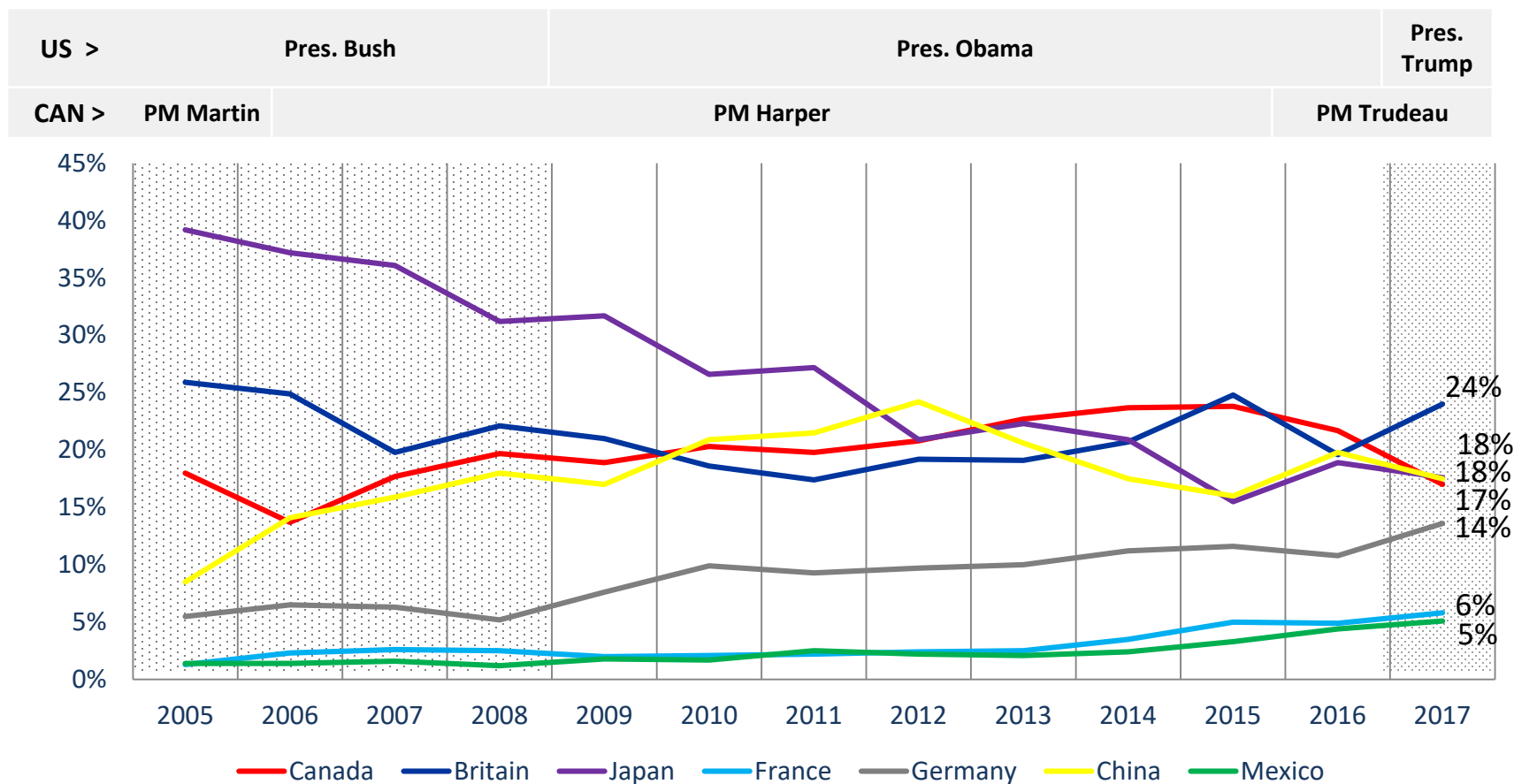

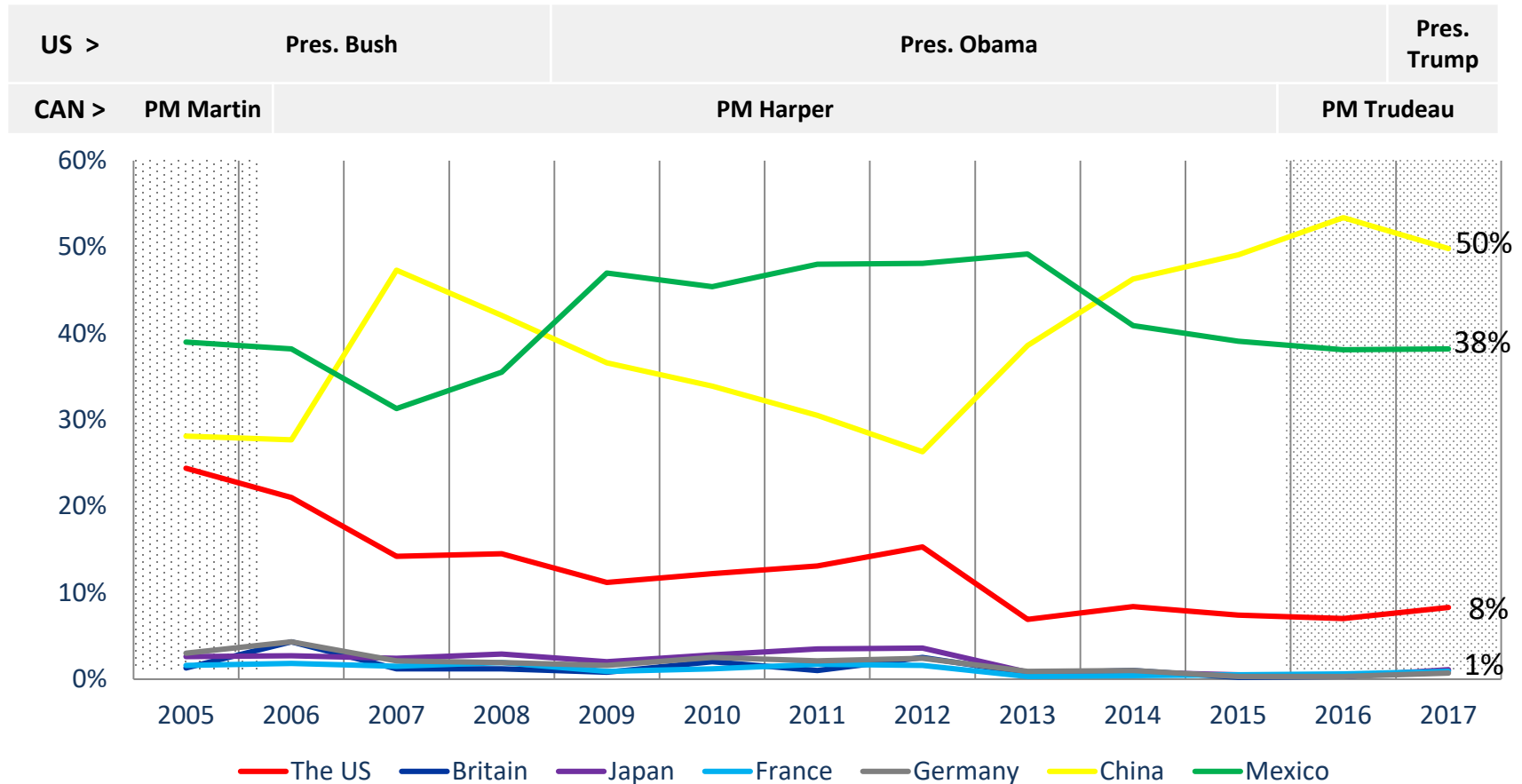

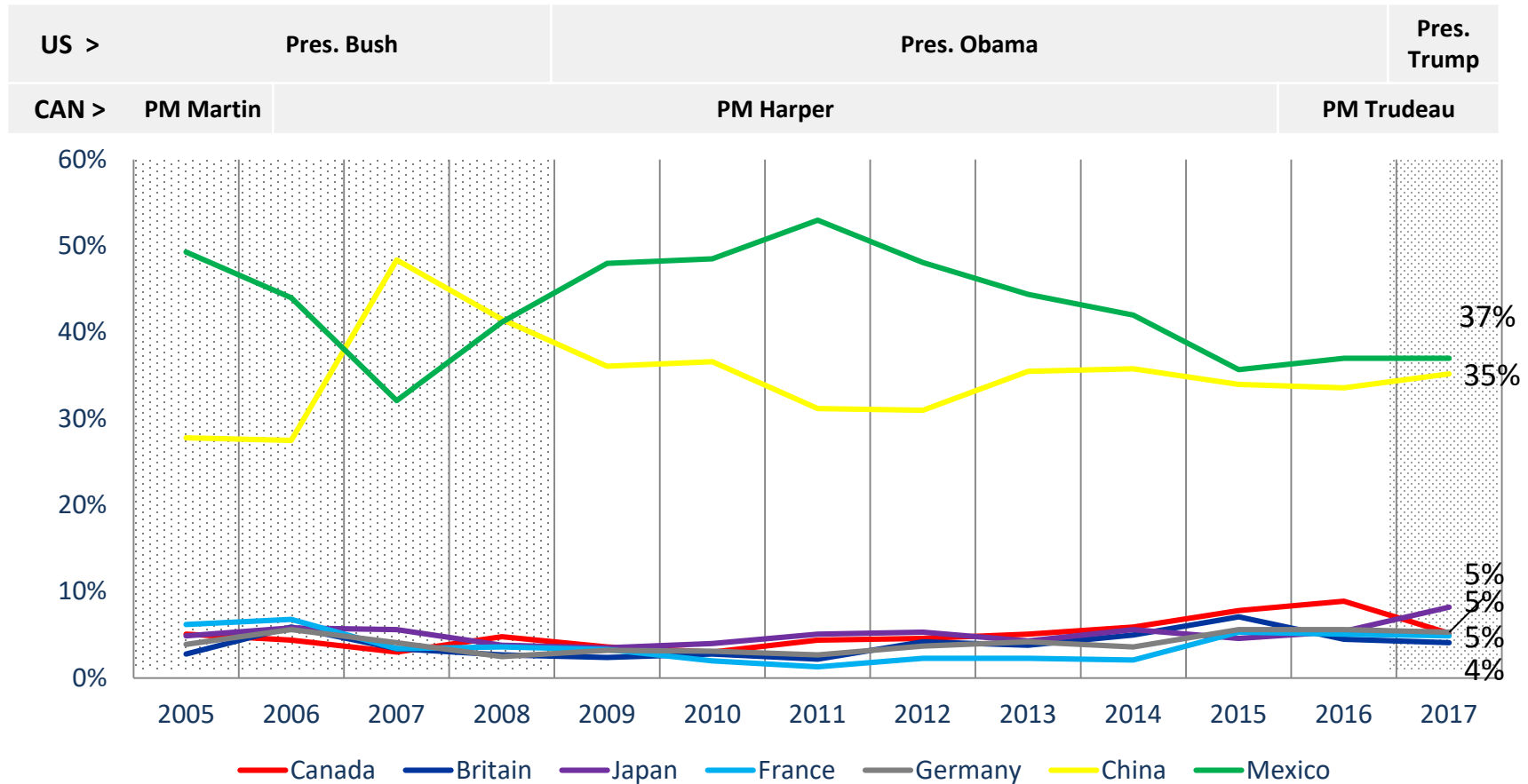

Americans on inspecting goods

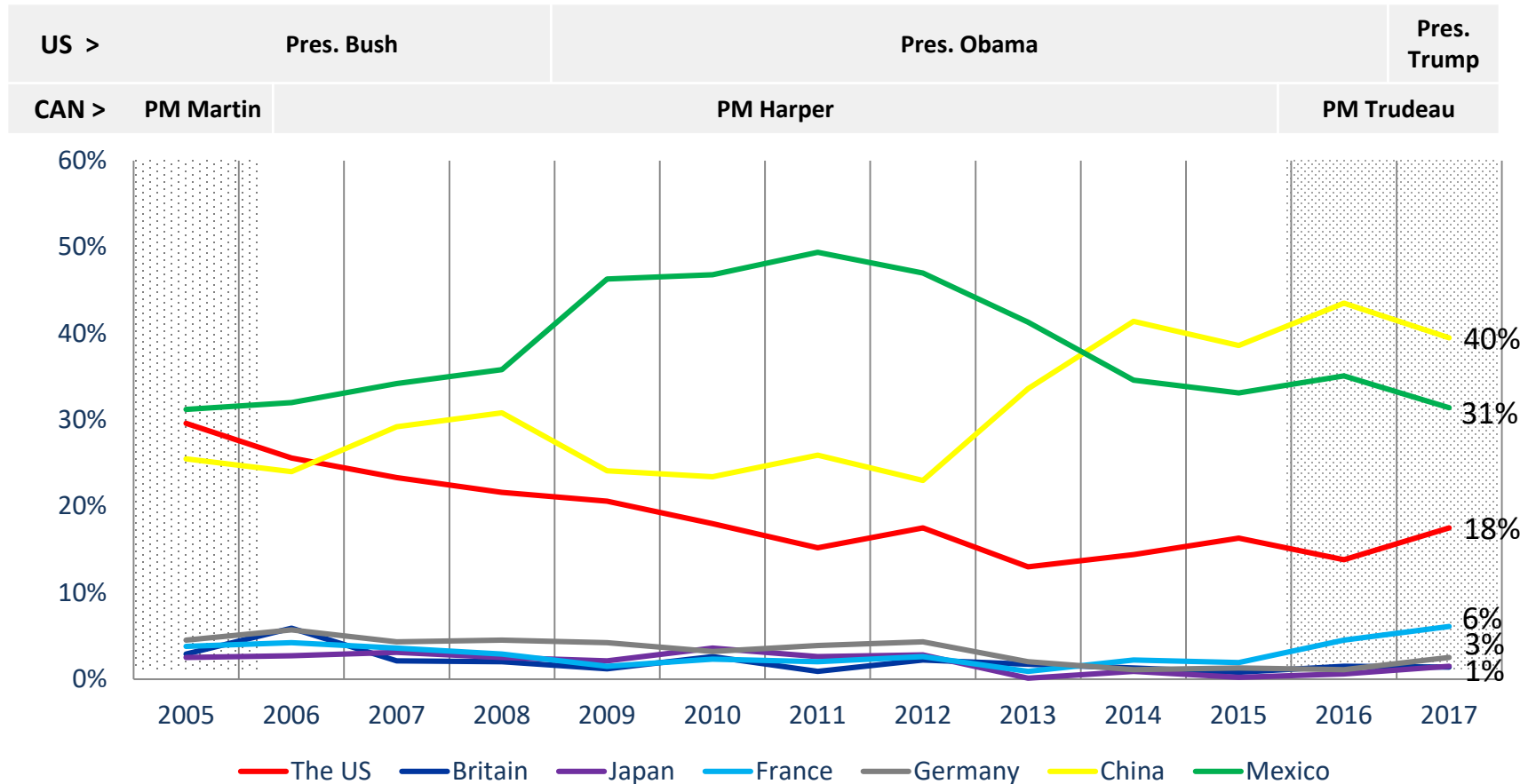

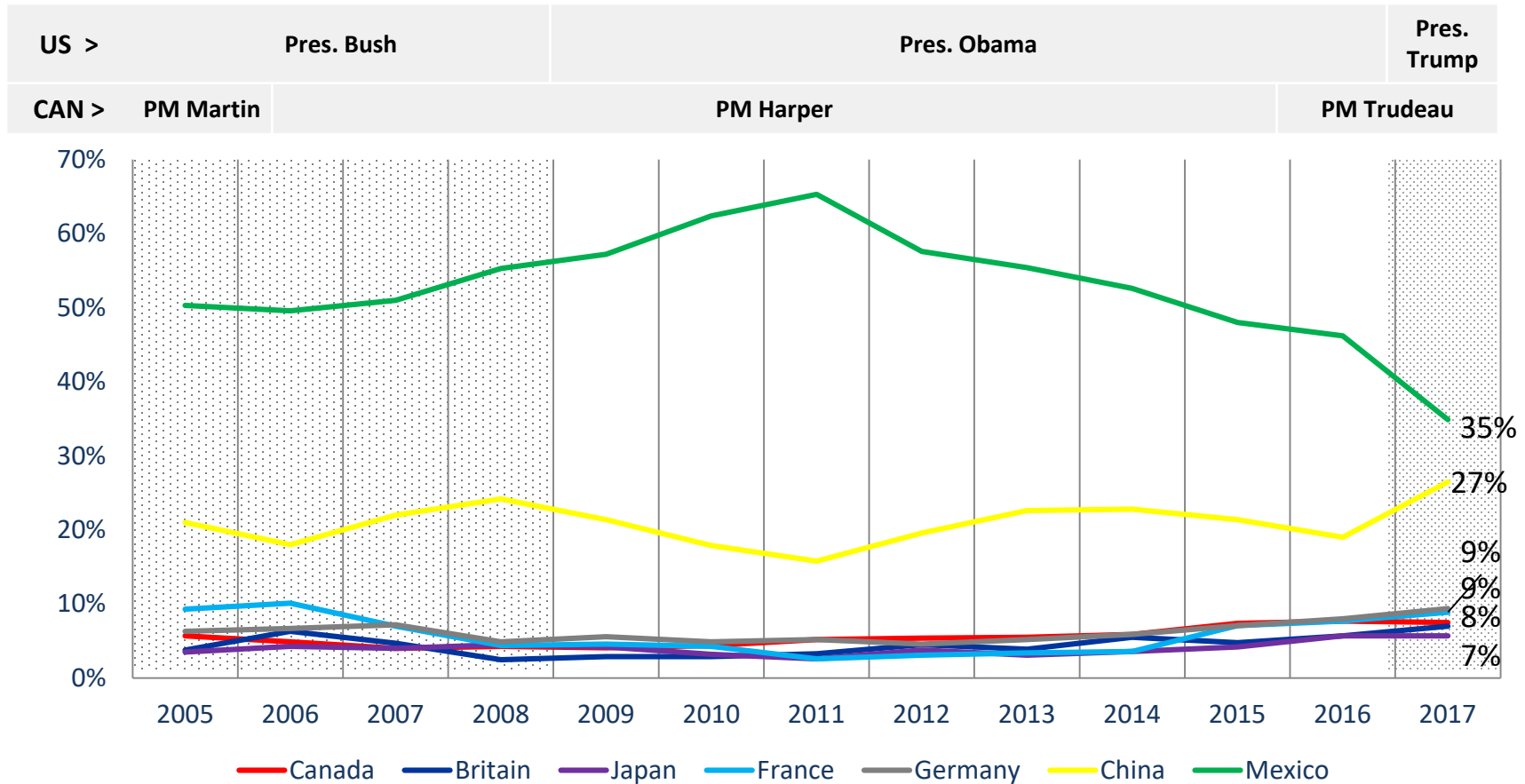

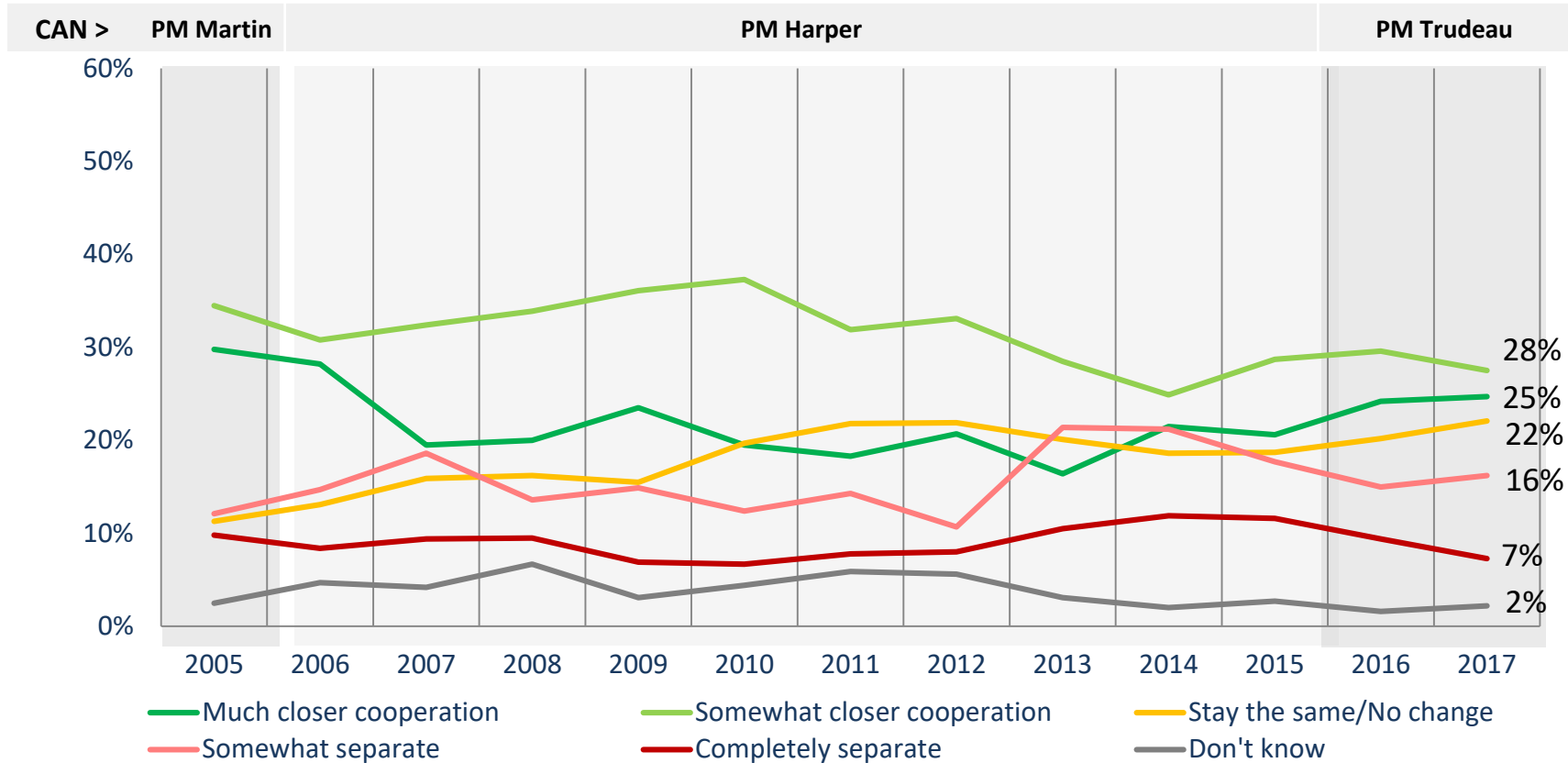

Canadians on national security

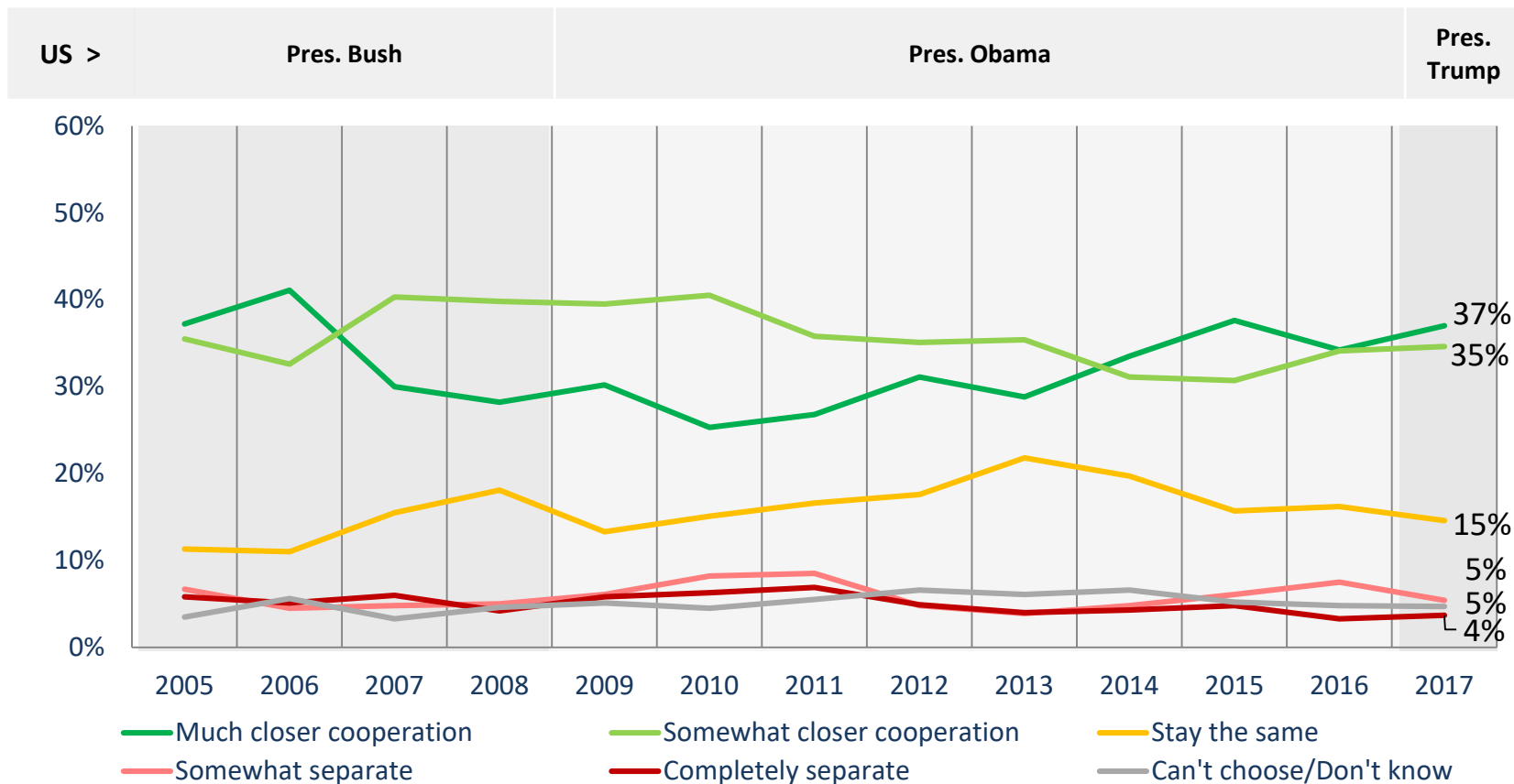

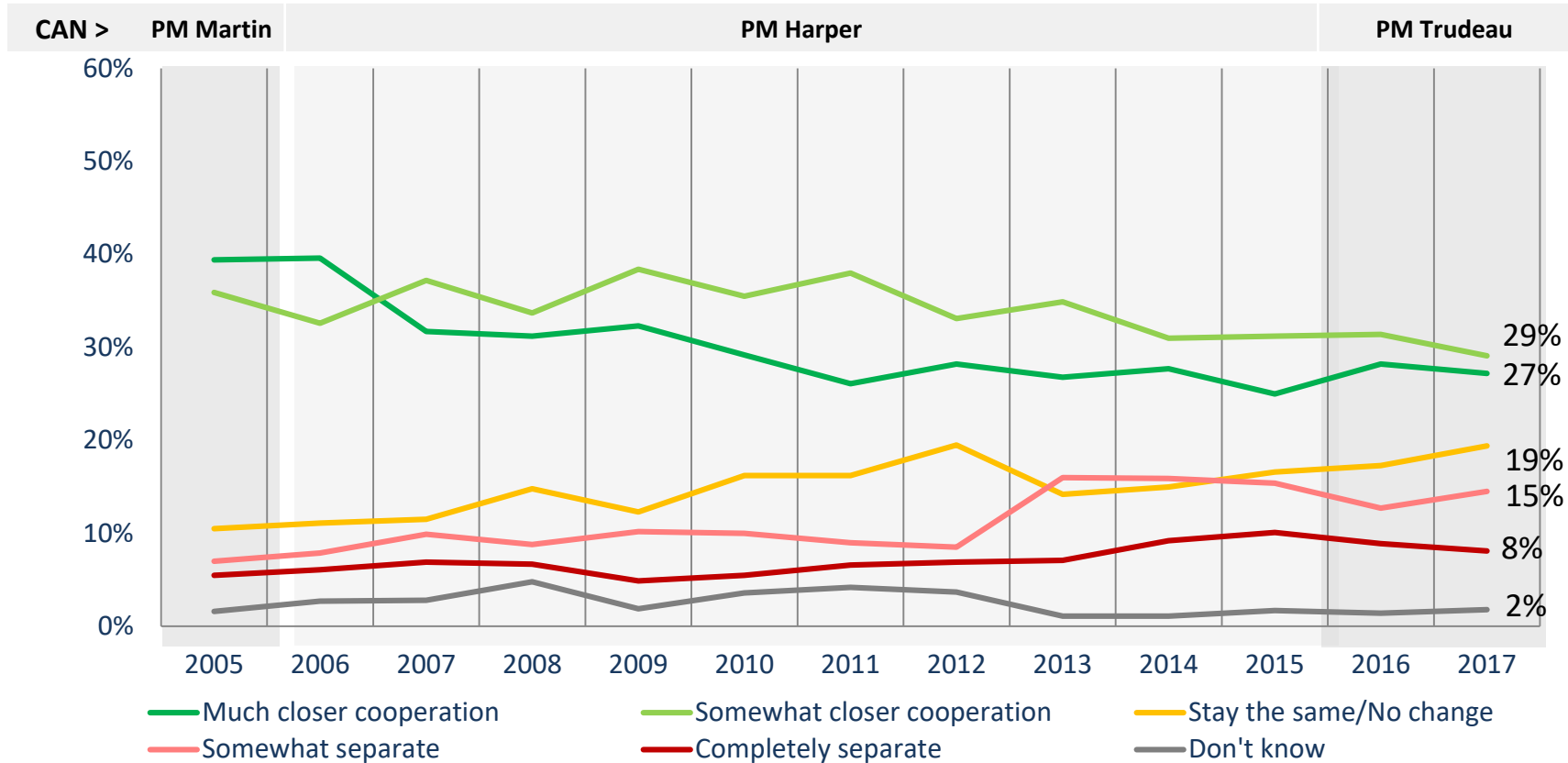

Canadians on border security

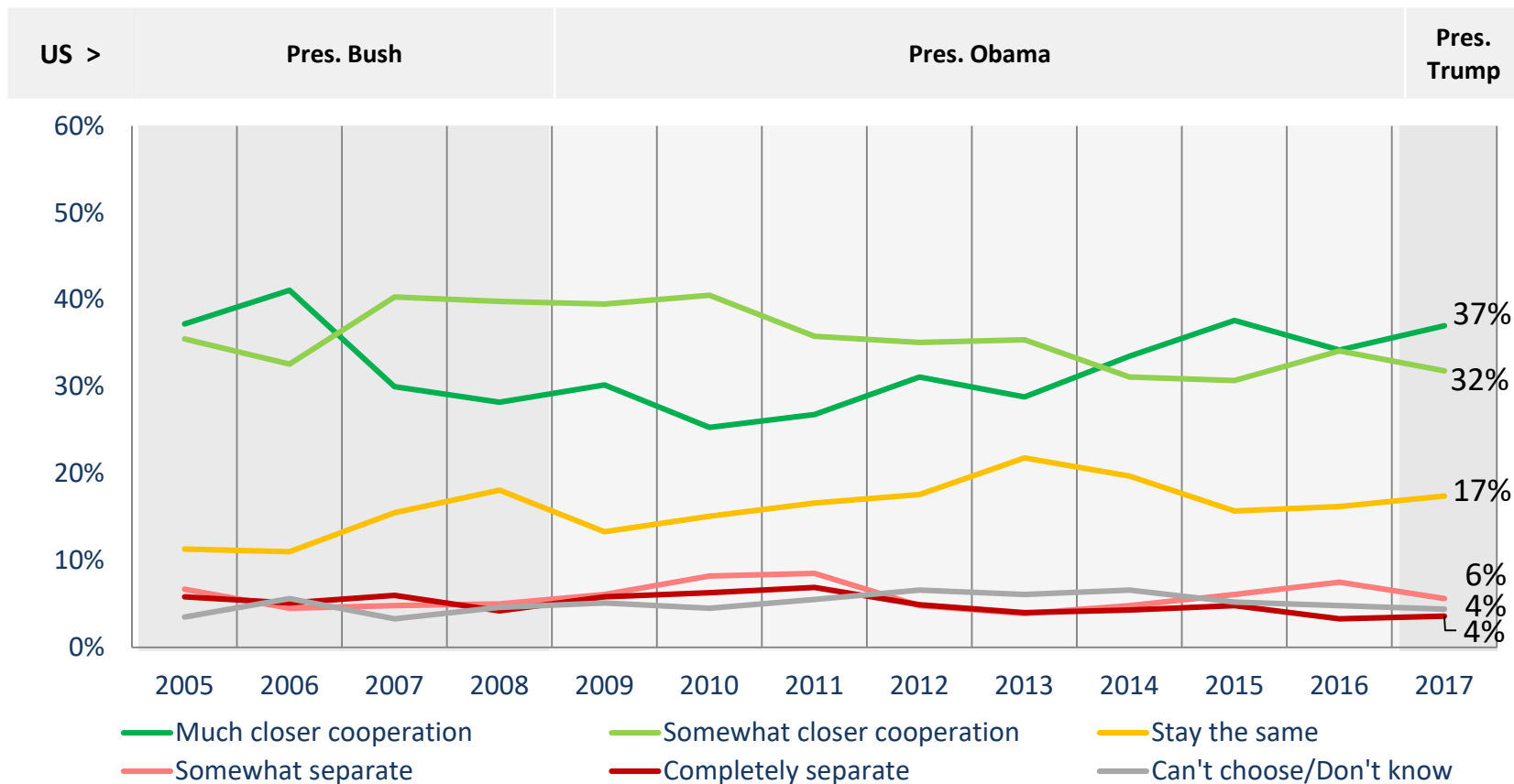

Americans on border security

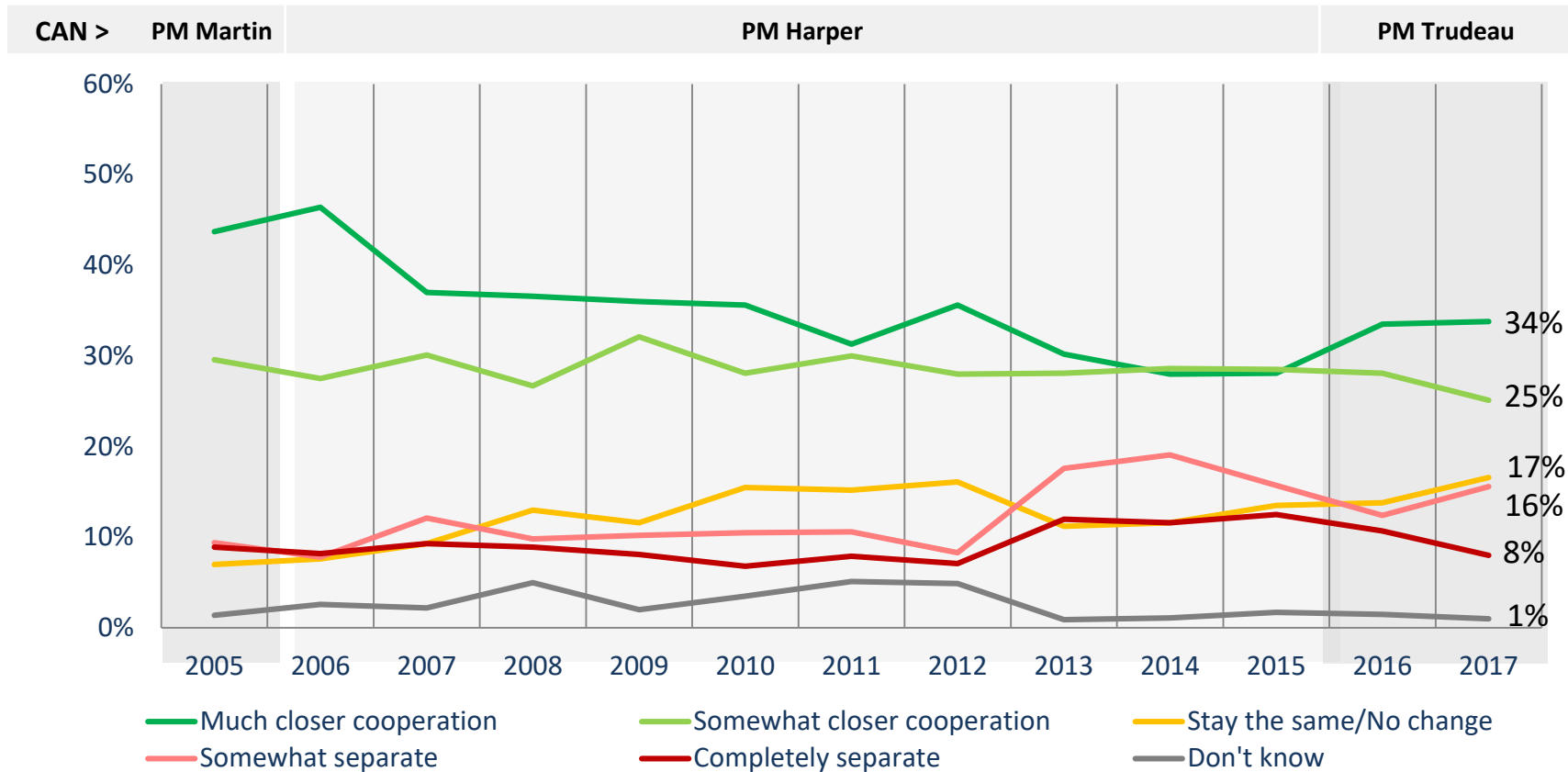

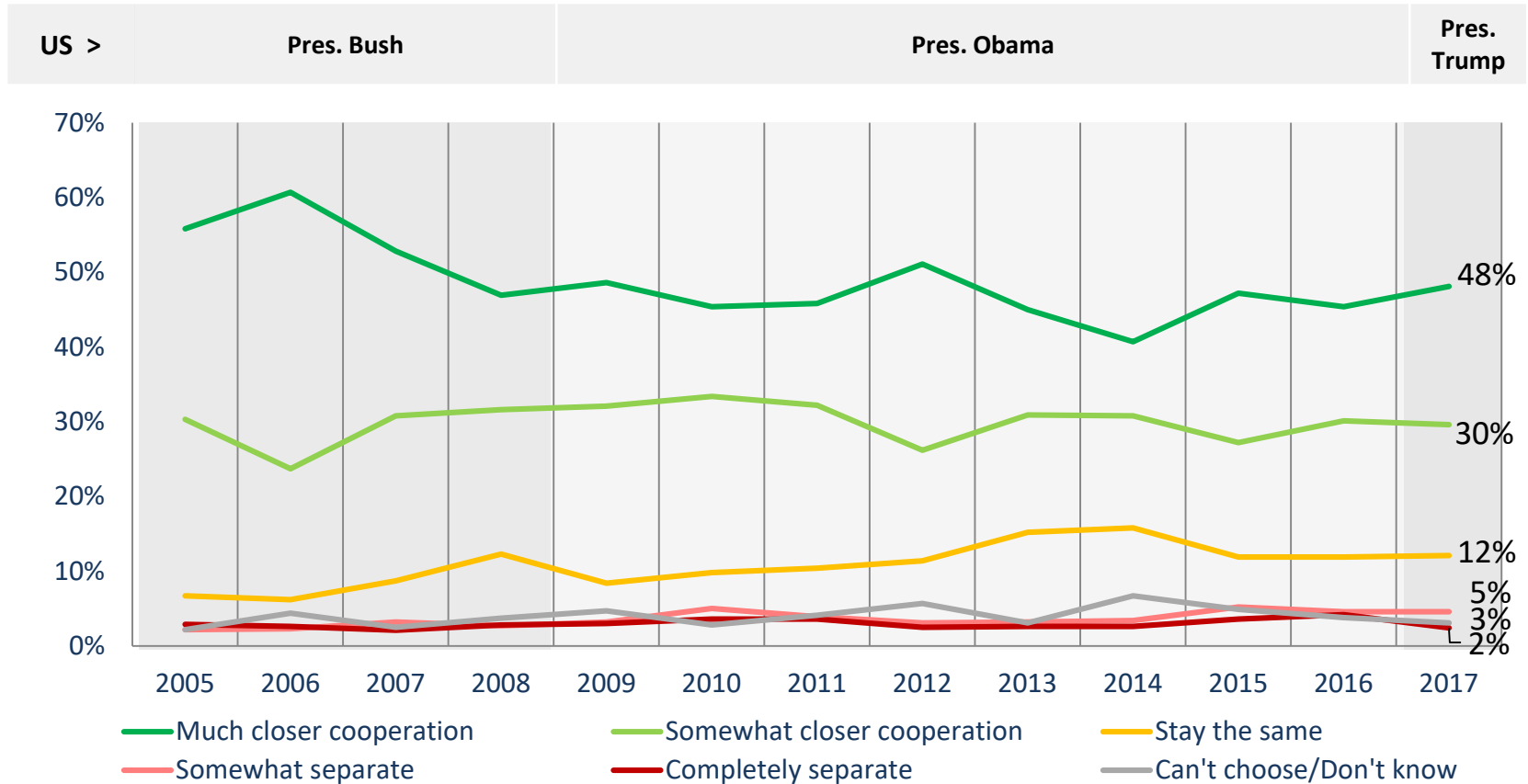

Americans on anti-terrorism

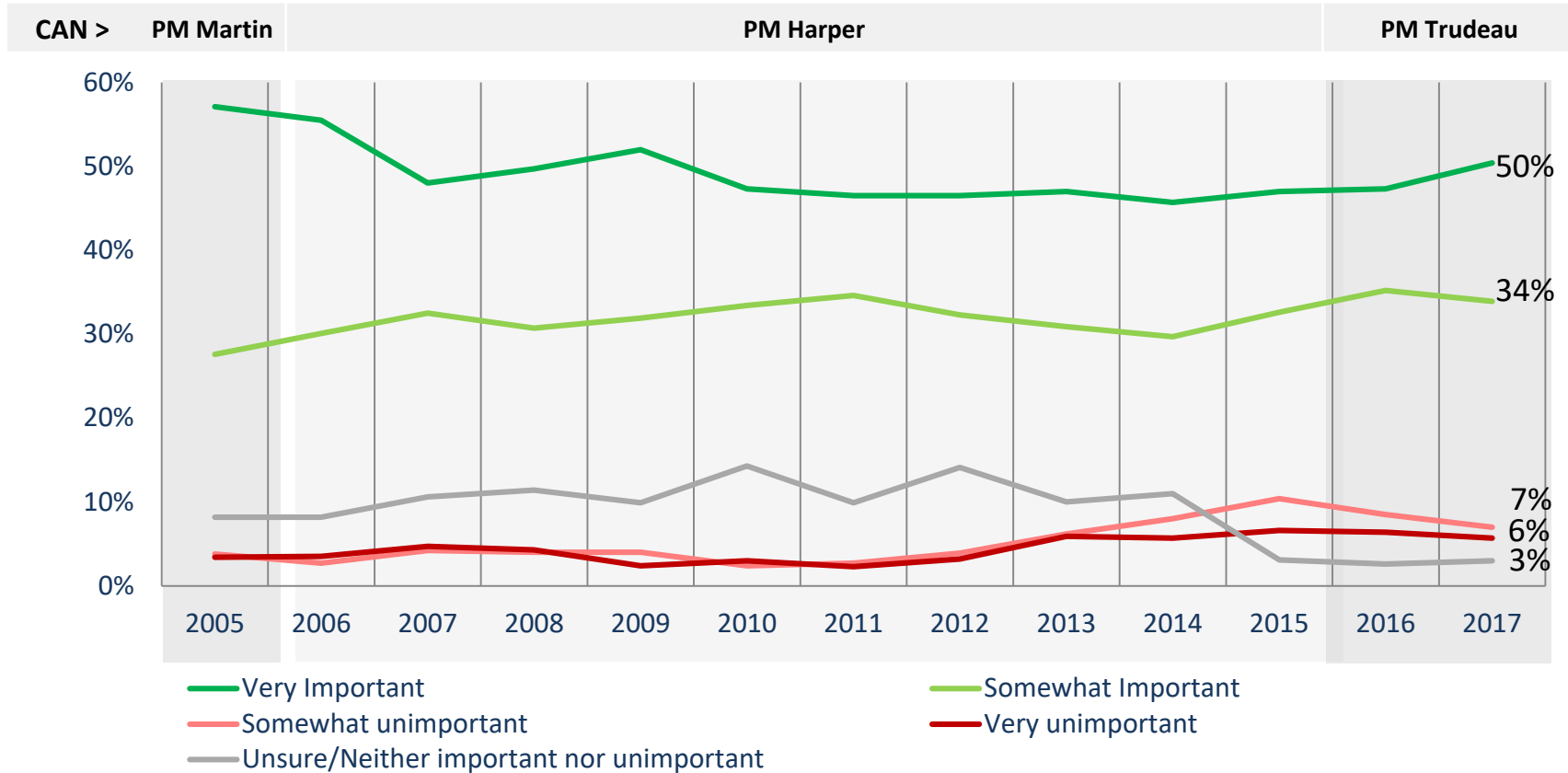

Canadians on developing an energy policy

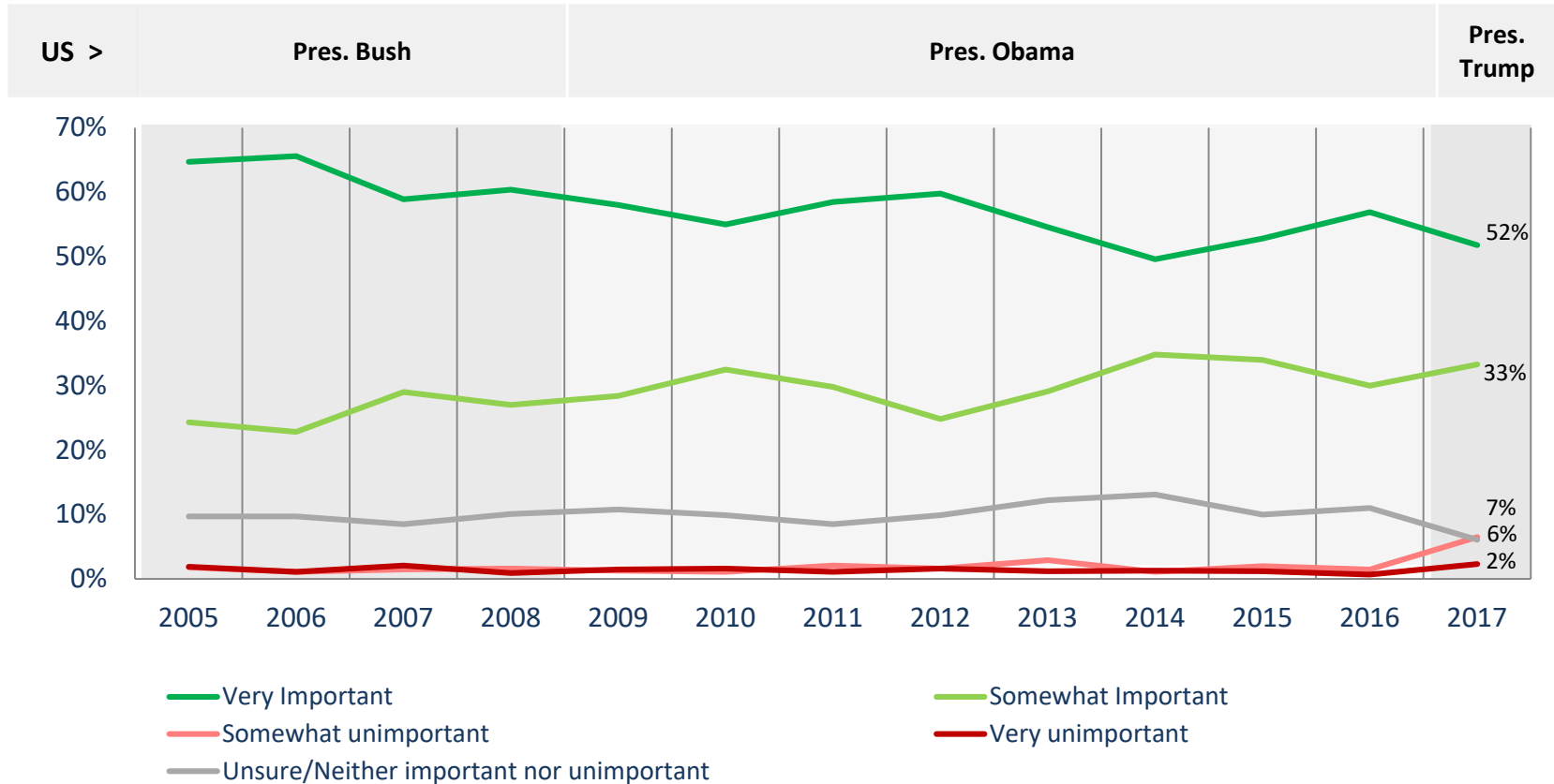

Methodology

Methodology

The Nanos-UB North American Monitor is conducted by the Nanos Research Corporation, which is headquartered in Canada and operates both in Canada and the United States. Parallel questions on bi-national issues are tracked by means of a hybrid telephone and online random sample of Canadians in the month of May, and a random representative online sample of Americans conducted in the month of June.

A Nanos RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,000 Canadians was conducted between June 7th and 9th, 2017 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data. The margin of error for a random survey of 1,000 Canadians is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

Between June 7th and 9th, 2017, a random representative online survey of 1,000 Americans was conducted. Results were statistically checked and weighted using the latest Census data.
