SUMMARY



Canadians most often say Justin Trudeau would be the federal party leader who would be the best at improving Canada's reputation and relationship with US

Canadians most often say Trudeau would be the federal party leader who would be the best at improving Canada's reputation and relationship with US, while marginally more say Scheer would be best at spending tax dollars wisely and say Elizabeth May would be the best at leading an ethical government.

- Canadians more often say Elizabeth May is the federal party leader who would be the best at leading an ethical government Under one in four Canadians (23%) say Elizabeth May would be the best at leading an ethical government, followed closely by Andrew Scheer (20%). Seventeen per cent say Justin Trudeau would be the best at this, while 13 per cent say none of them, 10 per cent say Jagmeet Singh, and three per cent each say Maxime Bernier and Yves-François Blanchet. Twelve per cent are unsure. Residents of the Prairies are most likely to say Andrew Scheer would be best at this (33%), while residents of BC are most likely to say Elizabeth May (39%).
- Canadians most often say Justin Trudeau is the federal party leader who would be the best at helping the middle class Just over three in ten Canadians (31%) say Justin Trudeau would be the best at helping the middle class, followed by Andrew Scheer (21%). Thirteen per cent say Jagmeet Singh would be the best at this, while nine per cent say none of them, six per cent say Elizabeth May, four per cent say Maxime Bernier, and two per cent say Yves-François Blanchet. Fourteen per cent are unsure. Residents of the Prairies are most likely to say Andrew Scheer would be best at this (31%), while residents of Atlantic Canada are most likely to say Justin Trudeau (37%).
- Canadians most frequently name Justin Trudeau as the federal party leader who would be the best at managing Canada's relationship with the U.S. Four in ten Canadians (40%) say Justin Trudeau would be the best at managing Canada's relationship with the U.S, followed by Andrew Scheer (25%), and none of them (10%). Four per cent say Maxime Bernier would be the best at this, while three cent each say Elizabeth May and Jagmeet Singh, and one per cent say Yves-François Blanchet. Fourteen per cent are unsure. Residents of the Prairies are most likely to say Andrew Scheer would be best at this (37%), while residents of Atlantic Canada and BC are most likely to say Justin Trudeau (46% and 44%, respectively).

Canadians are marginally more likely to say Andrew Scheer would be the best at spending tax dollars wisely

- Canadians are marginally more likely to say Andrew Scheer would be the best at spending tax dollars wisely One in four Canadians (25%) say Andrew Scheer would be the best at spending tax dollars wisely, followed by closely by Justin Trudeau (21%). Seventeen per cent say none of them, while eight per cent say Elizabeth May would be the best at this, seven per cent say Jagmeet Singh, six per cent say Maxime Bernier, and one per cent say Yves-François Blanchet. Fifteen per cent are unsure. Residents of the Prairies are most likely to say Andrew Scheer would be best at this (35%), while residents of Atlantic Canada are most likely to say Justin Trudeau (28%).
- Canadians most often say Justin Trudeau is the federal party leader who would be the best at improving Canada's reputation in the world More than four in ten Canadians (42%) say Justin Trudeau would be the best at improving Canada's reputation in the world, followed by Andrew Scheer (21%). Ten per cent say Elizabeth May would be the best at this, while nine per cent say none of them, six per cent say Jagmeet Singh, two per cent say Maxime Bernier, and one per cent say Yves-François Blanchet. Eleven per cent are unsure. Residents of the Prairies are most likely to say Andrew Scheer would be best at this (33%), while residents of Atlantic Canada are most likely to say Justin Trudeau (50%).



Federal party leaders













METHODOLOGY



Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,000 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between August 29th and September 4th, 2019 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada.

Individuals randomly called using random digit dialling with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for this survey is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

This study was commissioned by the Globe and Mail and the research was conducted by Nanos Research.

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
