Strong majority of decision-makers in Canadian companies agree or somewhat agree that flexible working will be a permanent change at their company

Close to eight in ten decision-makers agree (34%) or somewhat agree (45%) that flexible working (sometimes from the office, sometimes from home) will be a permanent change at their company.



Decision-makers sense anxiety among their team around coming back to the workplace

A majority of decision-makers agree (34%) or somewhat agree (45%) they sense anxiety among their team around coming back to the workplace in-person



Majority of decision-makers say they plan to implement a number of health and safety protocols immediately

Decision-makers most often report they plan to immediately provide hand sanitizer (84%), have more frequent cleaning of common/shared spaces (80%), and limit the number of employees who can be in shared spaces (e.g. elevators, washrooms, break rooms) at any one time (73%).



Decision-makers in Canadian companies give a higher intensity of difficulty to enforcing social distancing in the workplace and convincing employees its safe to return

Decision-makers rate a number of potential safety procedures an average level of difficulty to implement, giving a higher intensity of difficulty to enforcing social distancing (mean of 6.3 out of 10) and convincing employees its safe to return to work (mean of 6.2 out of 10), and a lower intensity to enforcing the use of PPE (mean of 5.1 out of 10).




One in two decision-makers think their company will be changing the type of space it has in the next two years – not downsizing

Fifty per cent of decision-makers think their company will not be downsizing but will change the type of space they have in the next two years. Among those who think their company will downsize its space (22%), they estimate it will be looking to reduce space by 34% on average.

Get Working retained Nanos to conduct research among decision-makers at the C-Suite or Executive level in Canadian companies with 50 or more employees to gauge their concerns and expectations surrounding employees returning to the workplace in person. To follow is a summary of the findings.

Managing the Work of Employees



Decision-makers in Canadian companies are more likely to say they expect all their employees to return to working in-person in the first half of 2021


- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies report close to half of their employees who normally work at the office are going into work in person regularly on average** – Asked what percentage of their employees who normally work in the office/physical location are coming into work in person at their place of business regularly, decision-makers in Canadian companies report an average of 48 per cent (median of 50%). Smaller companies (50-99 employees) report a higher median (50%) than those with 500 or more employees (median of 40%).
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies more often mention ensuring safety of the working environment and maintaining social distancing in terms of their biggest challenges ensuring they can manage work as their team returns to the office** – Decision makers more often mention ensuring safety of working environment and that proper safety procedures are in place (22%) and maintaining social distancing (22%) are their biggest challenges in ensuring that they can manage work as their team returns to the office, followed by maintaining productivity (eight per cent), none/don't see a challenge (seven per cent), communicating effectively virtually and in new office set up (six per cent), retaining good employees/enough employees (five per cent), implementing policies and procedures (five per cent), and adjusting to new normal (five per cent).
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies report an average of forty per cent of their team currently teleworking want to return to the workplace** – Decision-makers in Canadian companies report an average of 40 per cent (median of 35%) of their team currently teleworking wants to return to the workplace.
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies are more likely to say they expect all their employees to return to working in-person in the first half of 2021** – Close to four in ten decision-makers say they expect all their employees to return to working at their physical location rather than working remotely in the first half of 2021 (37%), followed by during the fall of this year (27%), before this coming September (14%), the second half of 2021 (13%), and never, expect working remotely for some employees to continue (nine per cent).

Returning to the Workplace

- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies more often mention ensuring safety of the working environment and that proper procedures are in place in terms of their biggest concern about their team returning to the workplace** – Decision-makers more often mention ensuring safety of working environment and that proper safety procedures are in place (22%) as their biggest concern about their team returning to the workplace, followed by possible exposure/bringing COVID-19 into the workplace (21%), maintaining social distancing (17%), none/don't see a challenge (seven per cent), implementing policies and procedures and ensuring they are being followed (six per cent), and morale and culture in the workplace/establishing new normal (four per cent).
- **Close to eight in ten decision-makers in Canadian companies agree or somewhat agree that they sense anxiety among their team around coming back to the workplace in-person** – A strong majority of decision-makers agree (34%) or somewhat agree (45%) that they sense anxiety among their team around coming back to the workplace in-person, while two in ten somewhat disagree (12%) or disagree (eight per cent). One per cent are unsure.
- **A strong majority of decision-makers in Canadian companies agree or somewhat agree that flexible working will be a permanent change at their company** – Nearly eight in ten decision-makers agree (34%) or somewhat agree (45%) that flexible working (sometimes from the office, sometimes from home) will be a permanent change at their company, while under two in ten somewhat disagree (10%) or disagree (seven per cent). Four per cent are unsure.
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies are split on whether they agree that they are finding it awkward to communicate with their team about returning to the office** – One in two decision-makers disagree (26%) or somewhat disagree (24%) that they are finding it awkward to communicate with their team about the return to the office, while just under one in two agree (18%) or somewhat agree (31%). One per cent are unsure.



A majority of decision-makers in Canadian companies say they plan to implement a number of health and safety protocols immediately


Health and Safety

- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies more often mention their biggest health and safety challenge when returning their team to the office is ensuring enough space to physically distance** – Close to one in three decision-makers mention ensuring enough space to social distance/ensuring employees maintain physical distance (31%) as their biggest health and safety challenge in returning their team to the office, followed by ensuring no one is sick/contact tracing/avoiding the spread of COVID-19 in the office (17%), cleanliness/sanitization (11%), following safety protocols/regulations (11%), and ensuring everyone is wearing PPE (i.e. masks, gloves)(seven per cent).
- **Close to seven in ten decision-makers in Canadian companies report they plan to immediately limit the number of employees who can come to the office** – Asked if they are planning to limit the number of employees who can come to the office, 68 per cent report yes, immediately, while 19 per cent report yes, in the future and 13 per cent report they have no plan to do so/it's not necessary.
- **More than seven in ten decision-makers in Canadian companies report they plan to immediately limit the number of people who can be in shared spaces** – Over seven in ten (73%) decision-makers report they are planning to immediately limit the number of employees who can be in shared spaces (e.g. elevators, washrooms, break rooms) at any one time, while 18 per cent report yes, in the future and nine per cent report they have no plan to do so/it's not necessary.
- **Eight in ten decision-makers in Canadian companies report they plan to immediately have more frequent cleaning of common and shared spaces** – A majority of decision-makers (80%) report they are planning to immediately have more frequent cleaning of common/shared spaces, 80 per cent report yes, immediately, while 14 per cent report yes, in the future and six per cent report they have no plan to do so/it's not necessary.
- **Two in three decision-makers in Canadian companies report they plan to immediately require all people to wear masks at all times in the workplace** – Two thirds of decision-makers (66%) report they are planning to immediately require all people to wear masks at all times in the workplace, while 19 per cent report they have no plan to do so/it's not necessary, and 15 per cent report yes, in the future. Decision-makers for companies with 500 or more employees are more likely to say they will do this immediately (79%) than decision-makers for companies with 50-99 employees (64%).




Decision-makers in Canadian companies give a higher intensity of difficulty to enforcing social distancing in the workplace

- **Over eight in ten decision-makers in Canadian companies report they plan to immediately provide hand sanitizer** – More than eight in ten decision-makers (84%) report they are planning to provide hand sanitizer immediately, while 12 per cent report yes, in the future and four per cent report they have no plan to do so/it's not necessary. Decision-makers for companies with 500 or more employees are more likely to say they will do this immediately (93%) than decision-makers for companies with 50-99 employees (81%).
- **Close to six in ten decision-makers in Canadian companies report they plan to immediately stop sharing tools such as computers among employees** – Just under six in ten decision-makers (59%) report they are planning to immediately stop sharing tools such as computers and machines among employees, while 23 per cent report yes, in the future and 18 per cent report they have no plan to do so/it's not necessary. Decision-makers for companies with 500 or more employees are more likely to say they will do this immediately (74%) than decision-makers for companies with 50-99 employees (58%).
- **Just over six in ten decision-makers in Canadian companies report they plan to immediately reconfigure offices to allow for easier social distancing** – A majority of decision-makers (61%) report they are planning to immediately reconfigure offices to allow for easier social distancing, while 23 per cent report yes, in the future and 16 per cent report they have no plan to do so/it's not necessary. Decision-makers for companies with 500 or more employees are more likely to say they will do this immediately (72%) than decision-makers for companies with 50-99 employees (58%).
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies rate enforcing social distancing an average score of 6.3 out of 10 in terms of its difficulty to follow in the workplace** – Decision-makers rate the difficulty of enforcing social distancing in the workplace an average score of 6.3 out of 10, on a scale where 0 is not difficult at all to follow and 10 is very difficult to follow. Over half say it is difficult to follow (score of 7-10)(55%), while more than one in four say this is of average difficulty (score of 4-6)(28%), and under two in ten say this is not difficult (score of 0-3)(16%). One per cent are unsure.



Decision-makers in Canadian companies give a lower intensity of difficulty to enforcing the use of PPE in the workplace

- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies rate managing office capacity an average score of 5.7 out of 10 in terms of its difficulty to follow in the workplace** – Decision-makers gave the difficulty of managing office capacity (limiting the number of employees and others in the building) a rating of 5.7 out of 10 on a scale where 0 is not difficult at all to follow and 10 is very difficult to follow. Close to half say it is difficult (score of 7-10)(47%), while just over three in ten say this is of average difficulty (score of 4-6)(32%), and under two in ten say this is not difficult (score of 0-3)(15%).
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies rate convincing employees it is safe to return to work an average score of 6.2 out of 10 in terms of its difficulty to follow in the workplace** – In terms of the difficulty of convincing employees it is safe to return to work, decision-makers give this a mean score of 6.2 out of 10 on a scale where 0 is not difficult at all to follow and 10 is very difficult to follow. Just over half say it is difficult (score of 7-10)(51%), while just over three in ten say this is of average difficulty (score of 4-6)(31%), and under two in ten say this is not difficult (score of 0-3)(16%). One per cent are unsure.
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies rate maintaining cleanliness of shared workspaces an average score of 5.5 out of 10 in terms of its difficulty to follow in the workplace** – The difficulty of maintaining cleanliness of shared workspaces was given a score of 5.5 out of 10 on a scale where 0 is not difficult at all to follow and 10 is very difficult to follow. Over four in ten say it is difficult (score of 7-10)(45%), while just under three in ten say this is of average difficulty (score of 4-6)(29%), and over one in four say this is not difficult (score of 0-3)(26%).
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies rate managing how people move about the space an average score of 6.0 out of 10 in terms of its difficulty to follow in the workplace** – With regards to the difficulty of managing how people move about the space (e.g. the use of elevators, stairwells, hallways, etc.), decision-makers give this a mean score of 6.0 out of 10 on a scale where 0 is not difficult at all to follow and 10 is very difficult to follow. Over half say this is difficult (score of 7-10)(52%), while over one in four say this is of average difficulty (score of 4-6)(27%), and two in ten say this is not difficult (score of 0-3)(20%). One per cent are unsure.



Half of decision-makers in Canadian companies think their company will not be downsizing its office space, but will be changing the type of space it has in the next two years

- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies rate managing preventing potentially ill employees from coming into the office an average score of 5.6 out of 10 in terms of its difficulty to follow in the workplace** – Decision-makers rate the difficulty of preventing potentially ill employees from coming into the office a score of 5.6 out of 10 on a scale where 0 is not difficult at all to follow and 10 is very difficult to follow. Over four in ten say this is difficult (score of 7-10)(43%), while over three in ten say this is of average difficulty (score of 4-6)(31%), and over two in ten say this is not difficult (score of 0-3)(23%). Two per cent are unsure.
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies rate enforcing the use of PPE an average score of 5.1 out of 10 in terms of its difficulty to follow in the workplace** – In terms of the difficulty of enforcing the use of personal protective equipment such as masks and hand sanitizer, decision-makers give this a rating of 5.1 out of 10 on a scale where 0 is not difficult at all to follow and 10 is very difficult to follow. Over one in three say this is difficult (score of 7-10)(37%), while close to one in three say this is of average difficulty (score of 4-6)(32%), and three in ten say this is not difficult (score of 0-3)(30%). One per cent are unsure.

Long term plans/real estate

- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies more often think their company will not be downsizing its office space, but will be changing the type of space it has in the next two years** – One in two decision-makers (50%) think their company will not be downsizing, but will change the type of space they have in the next two years, while 29 per cent are not expecting any changes to their space, and 22 per cent think they will be downsizing their space in the next two years. Decision-makers for companies with 500 or more employees are more likely to say they will be changing the type of space (60%; 50-99 employees: 47%) while decision-makers for companies with 50-99 employees are more likely to say they are not expecting any changes to the space (31%; 500 plus employees: 19%).
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies who think their company will downsize its office space say they are looking to reduce their space by 34 per cent on average** – Decision-makers who think their company will downsize its office space in the next two years say they think their company will downsize its space by an average of 34% (median of 30%).



Half of decision-makers in Canadian companies think their company will not be downsizing its office space, but will be changing the type of space it has in the next two years

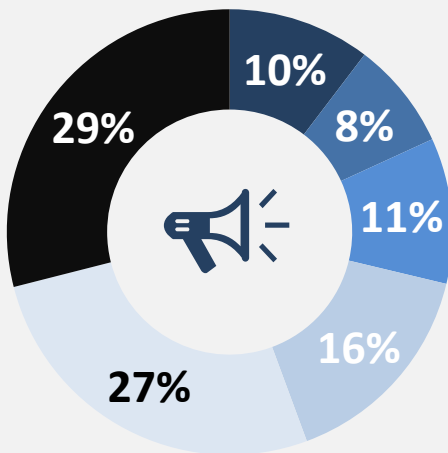
- **Decision-makers in Canadian companies who think their company will downsize its office space say they are unsure whether they are looking to end their lease or sub-lease some of their existing space** – Close to one in two decision-makers who think their company will downsize its office space in the next two years (48%) say they are not sure if they are looking to end their lease or sub-lease some of their existing space. Thirty-two per cent say they are looking to sub-lease some of their existing space, while 20 per cent say they are looking to end their lease and find an alternative.

Nanos conducted a representative online survey of 435 decision makers in Canadian companies with 50 employees or more, drawn from a non-probability panel between August 4th and 12th, 2020.

The research was commissioned by Get Working and was conducted by Nanos Research.

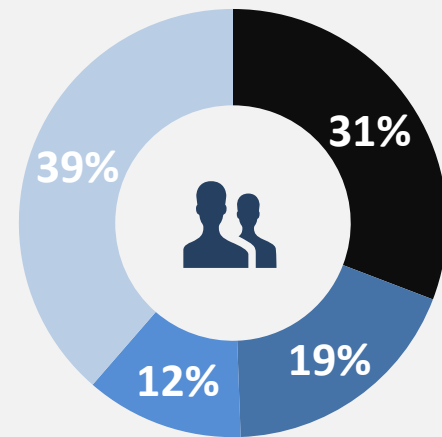

Percentage of employees returning to in-person work



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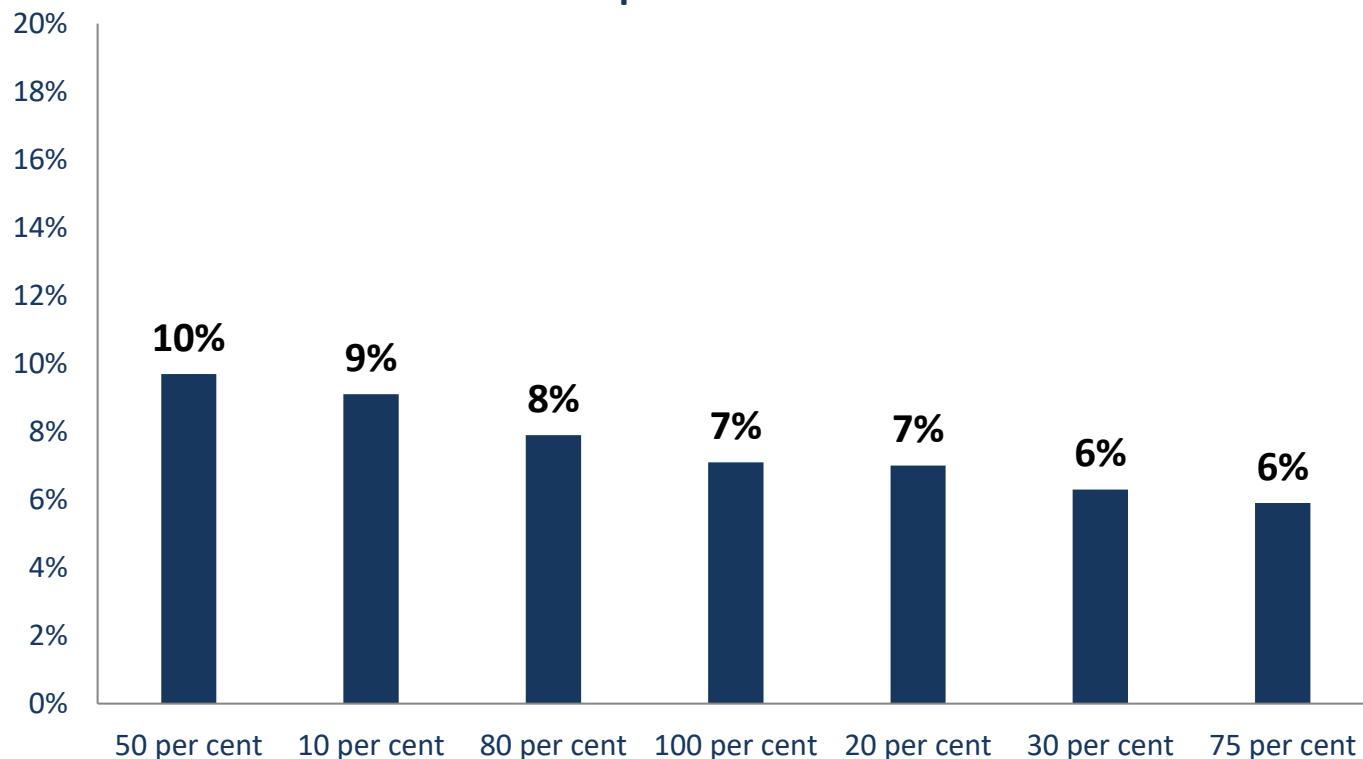

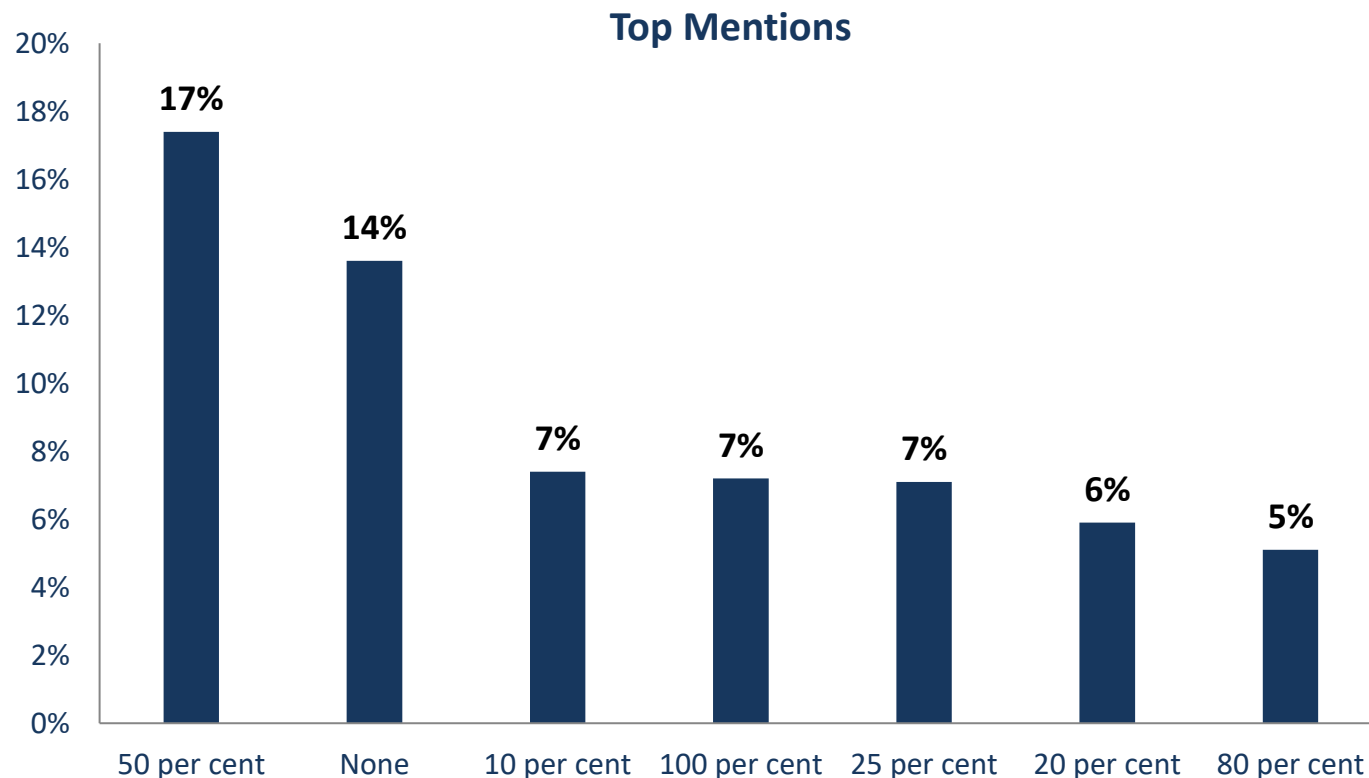
Desire to transition from telework to in-person work



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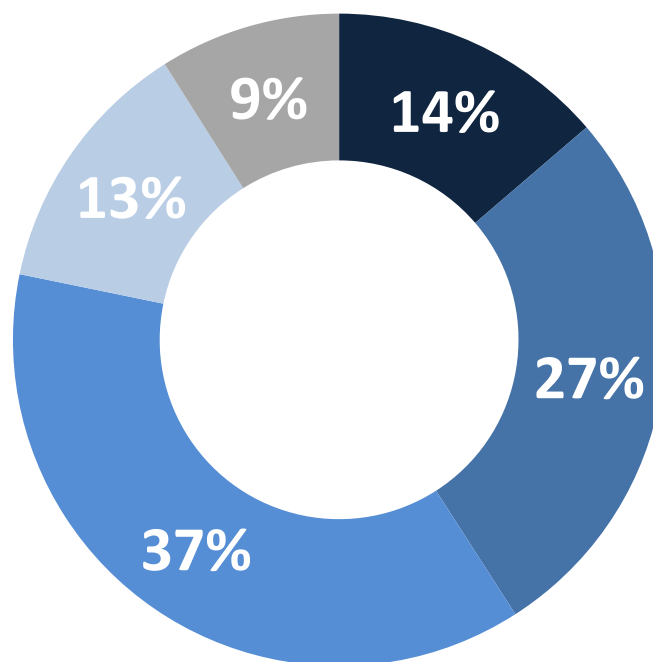

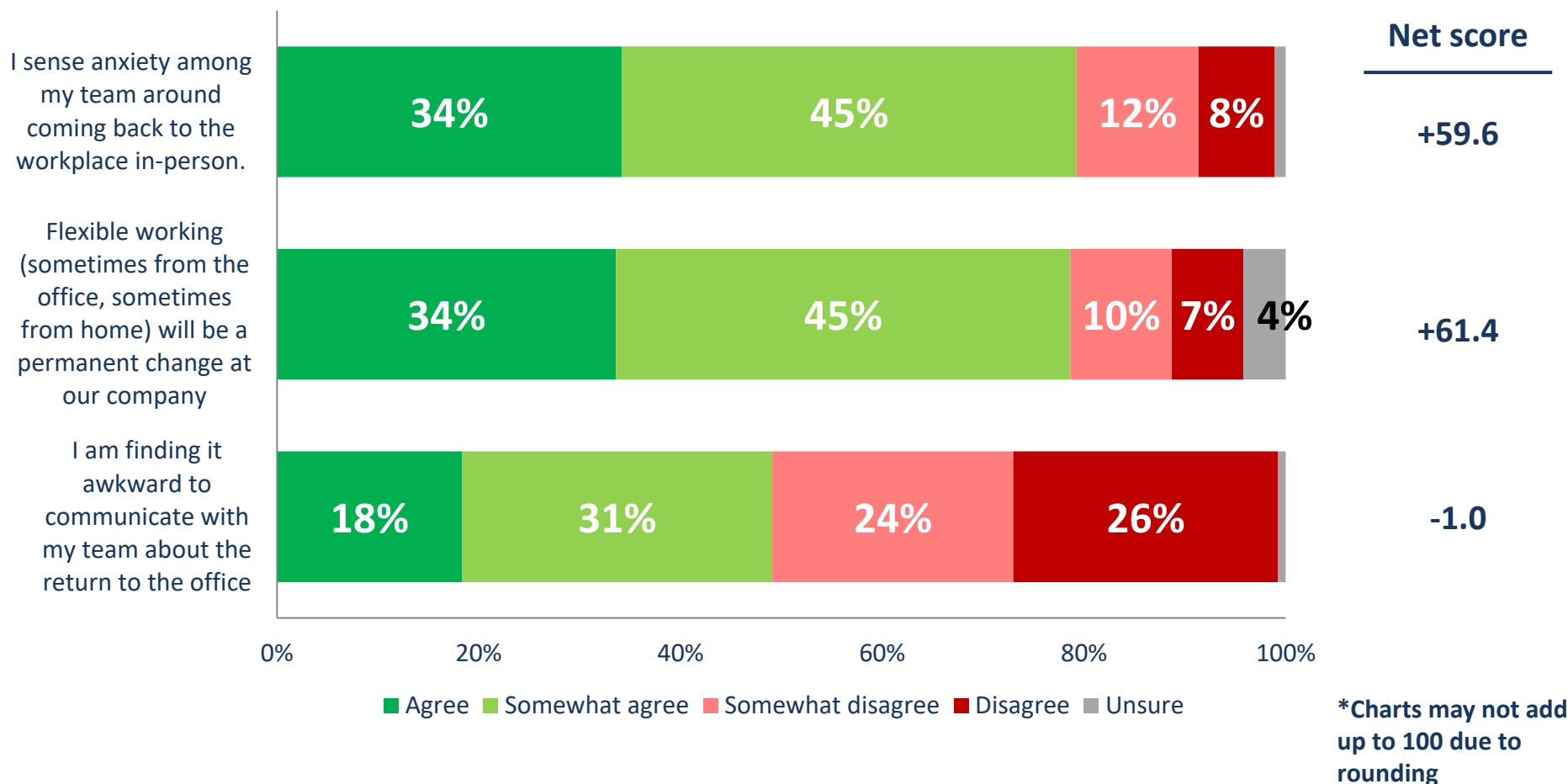

Feelings towards team returning to the workplace

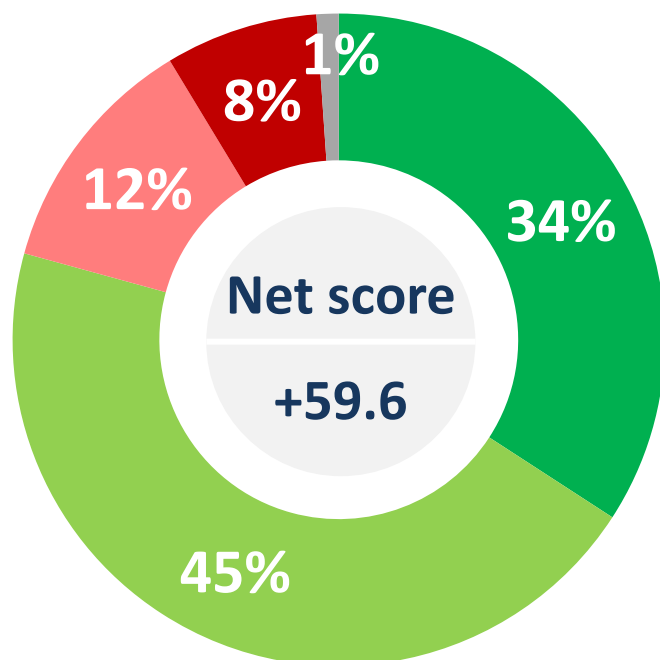

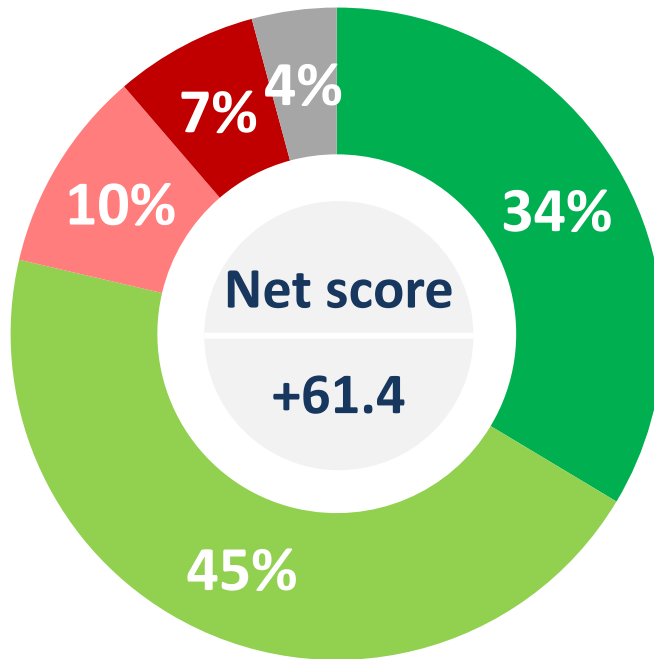

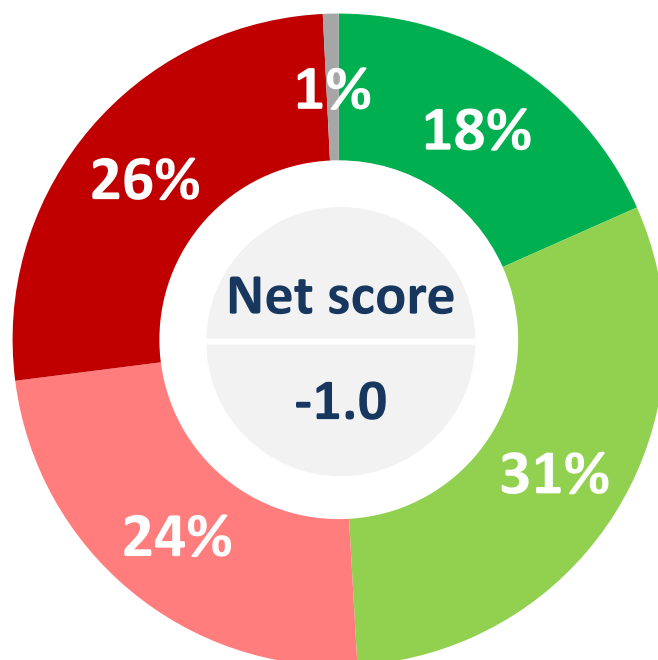



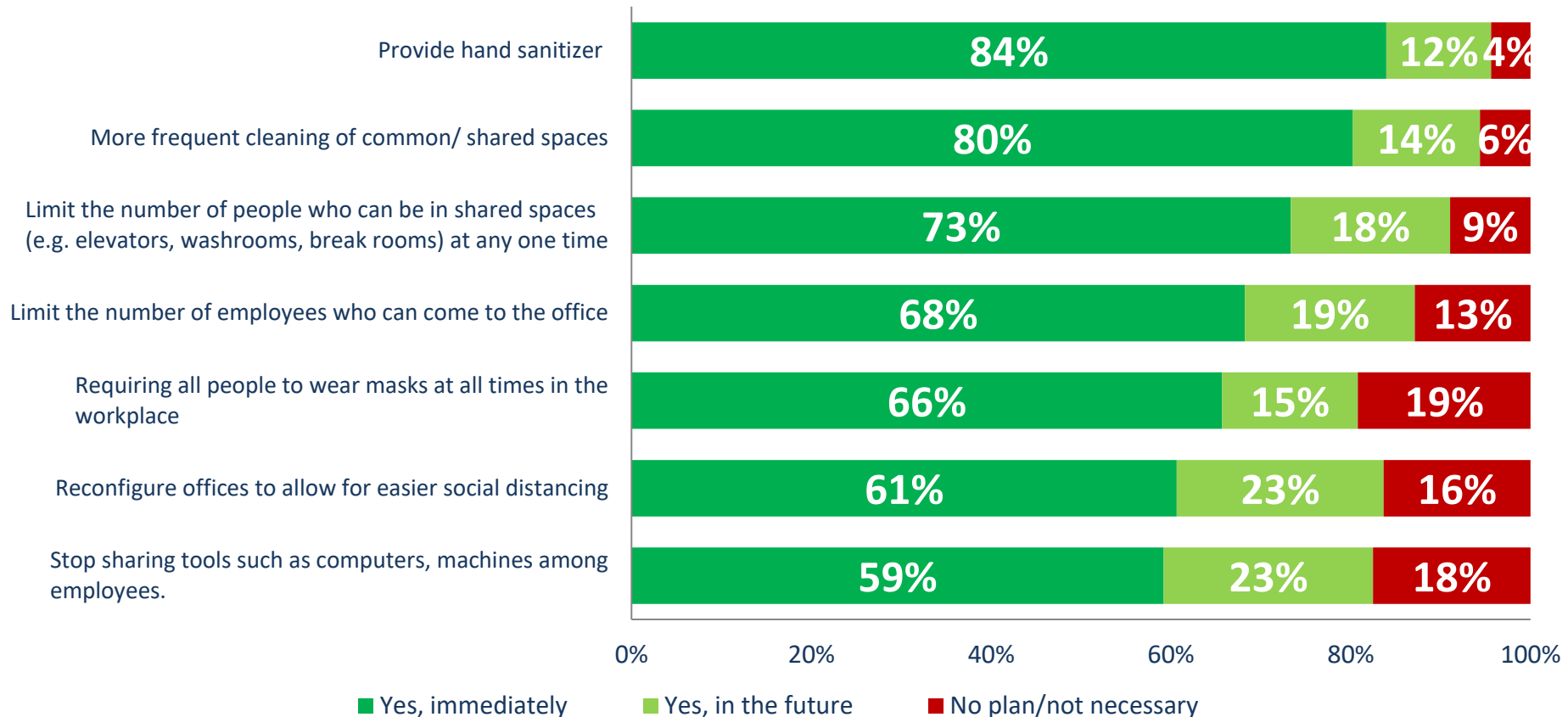

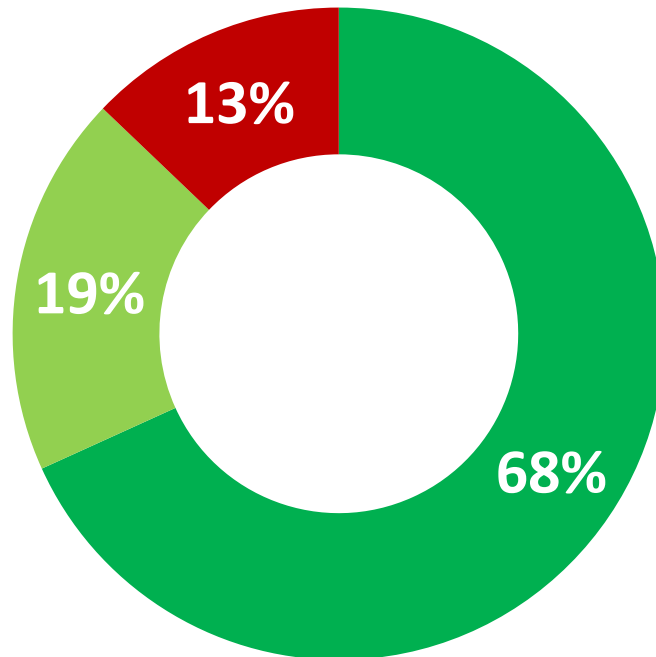

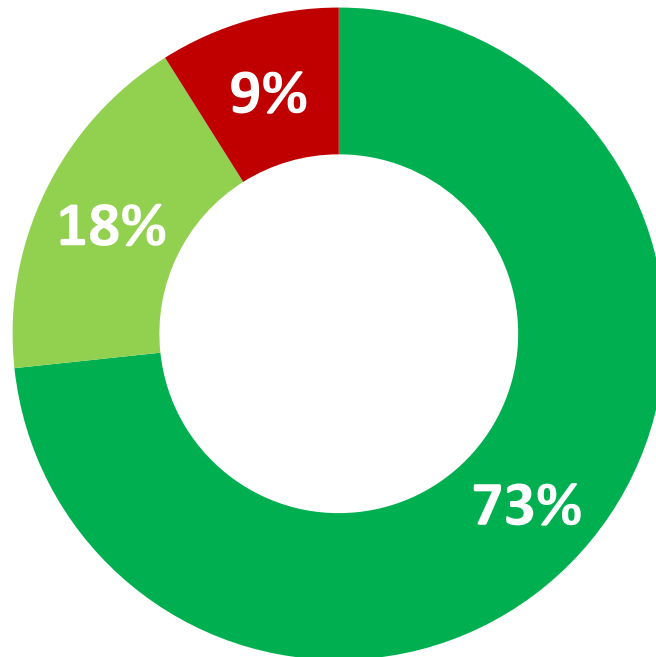

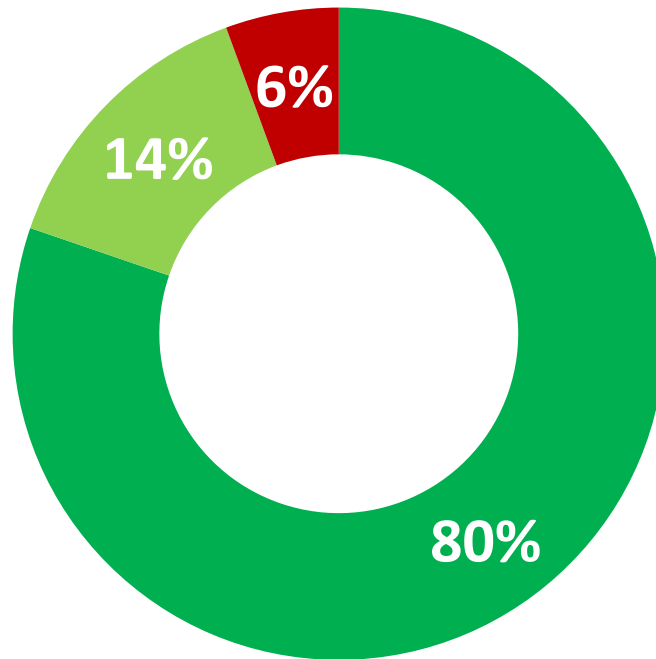

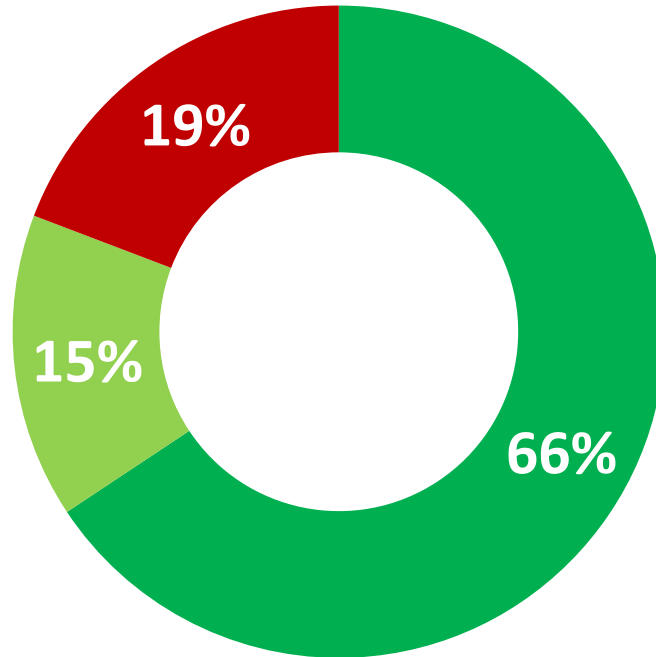

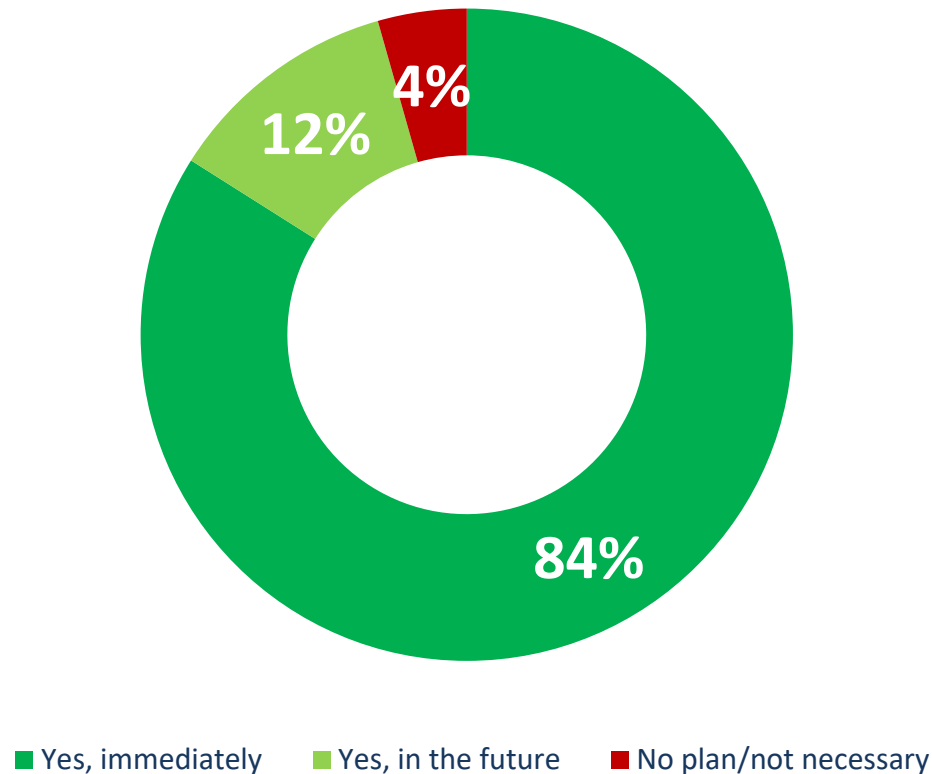

Providing hand sanitizer



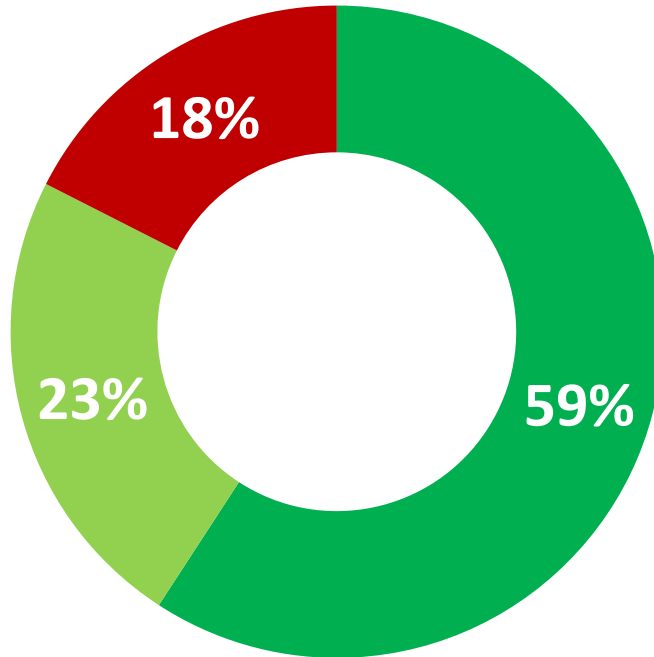

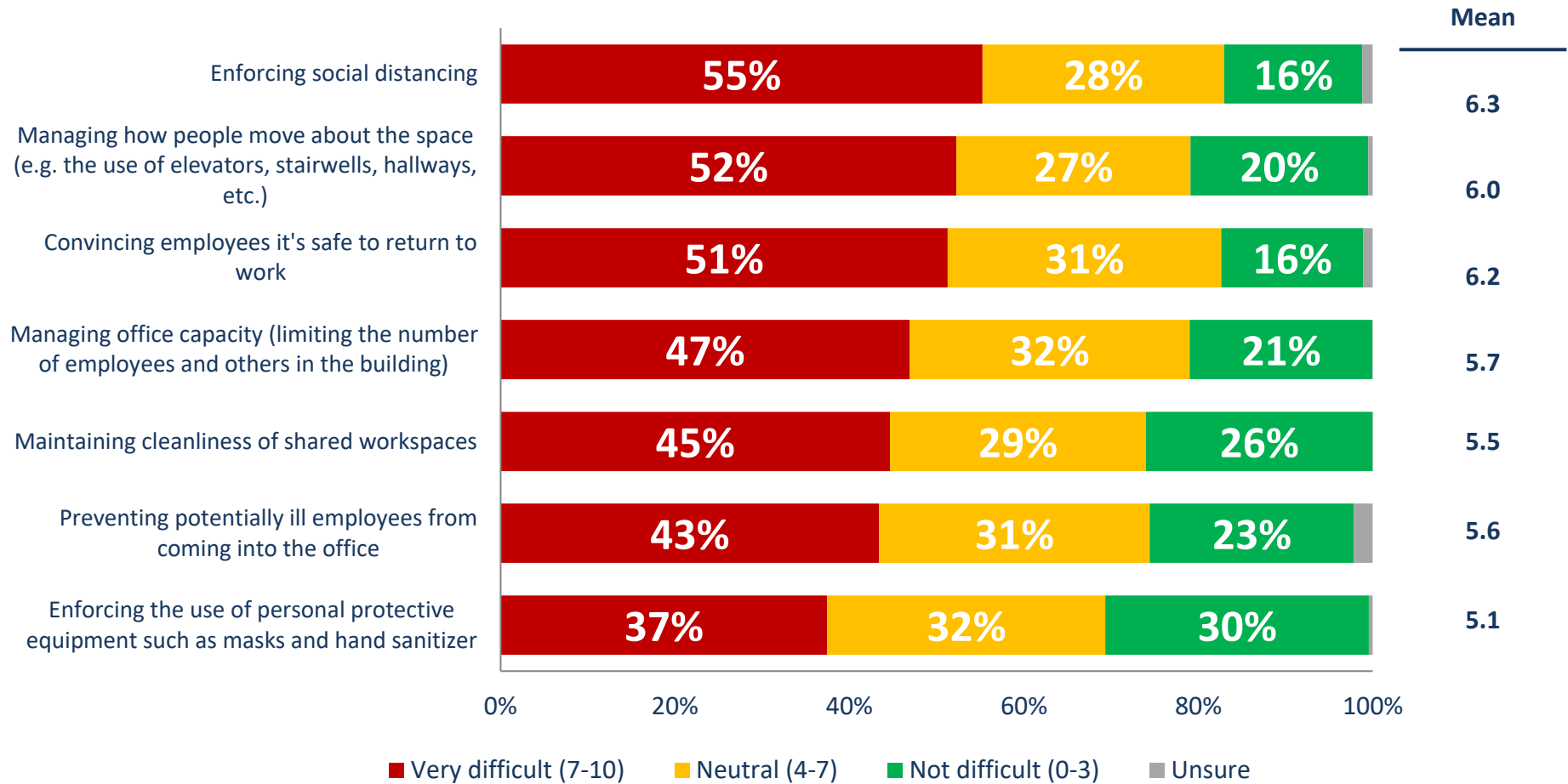

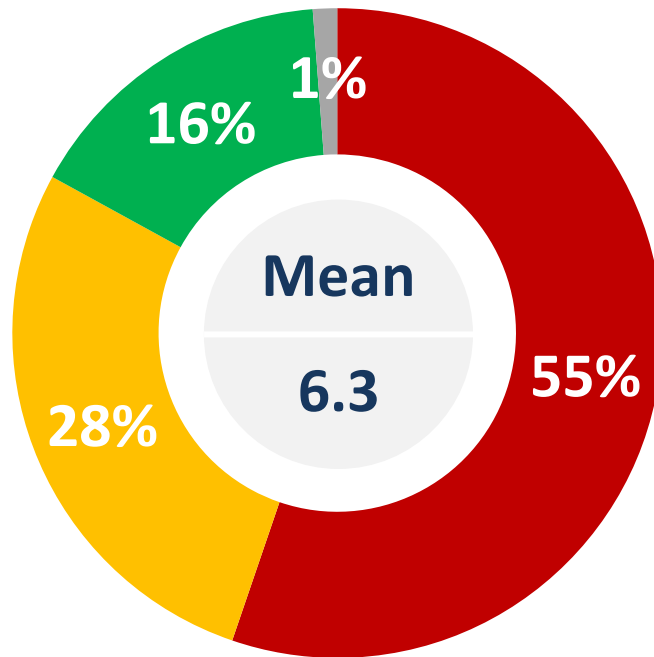

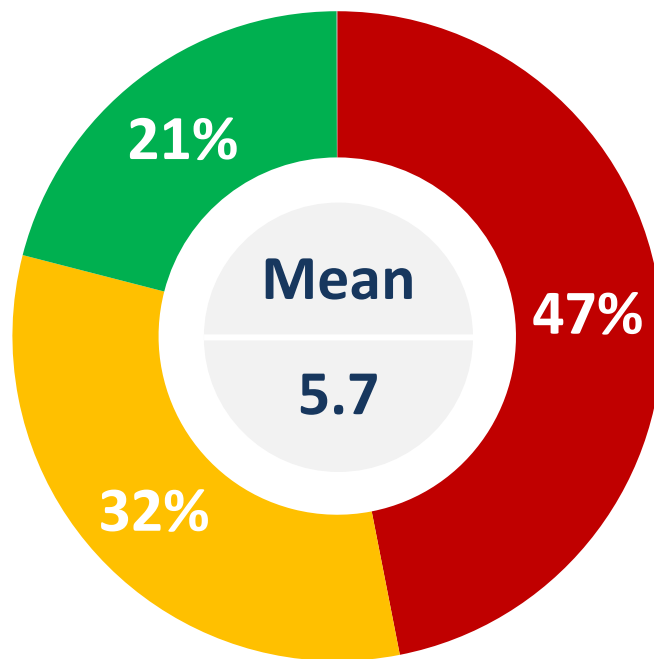

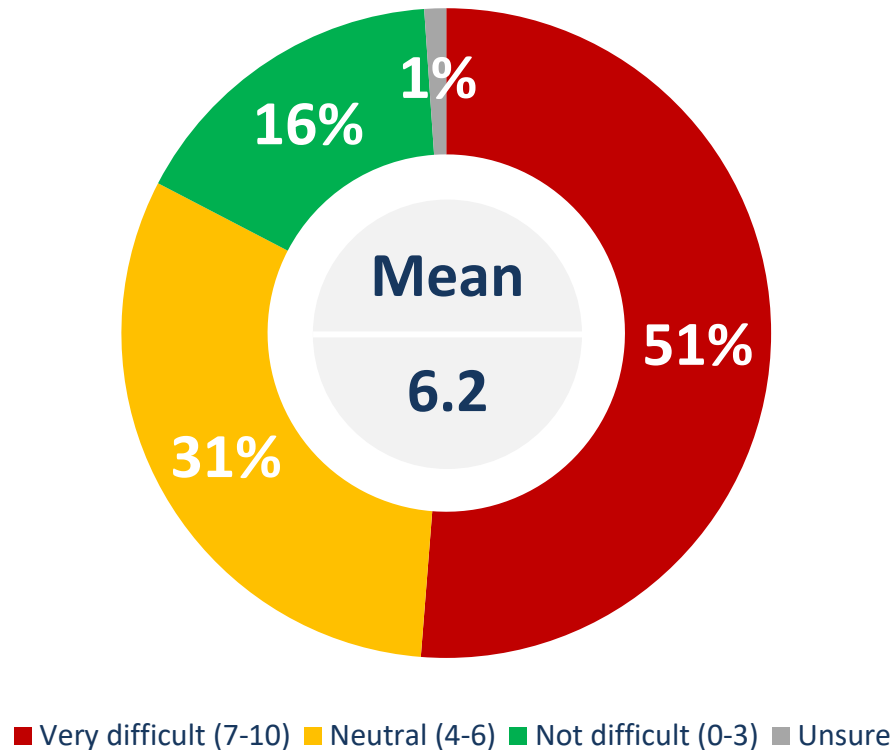

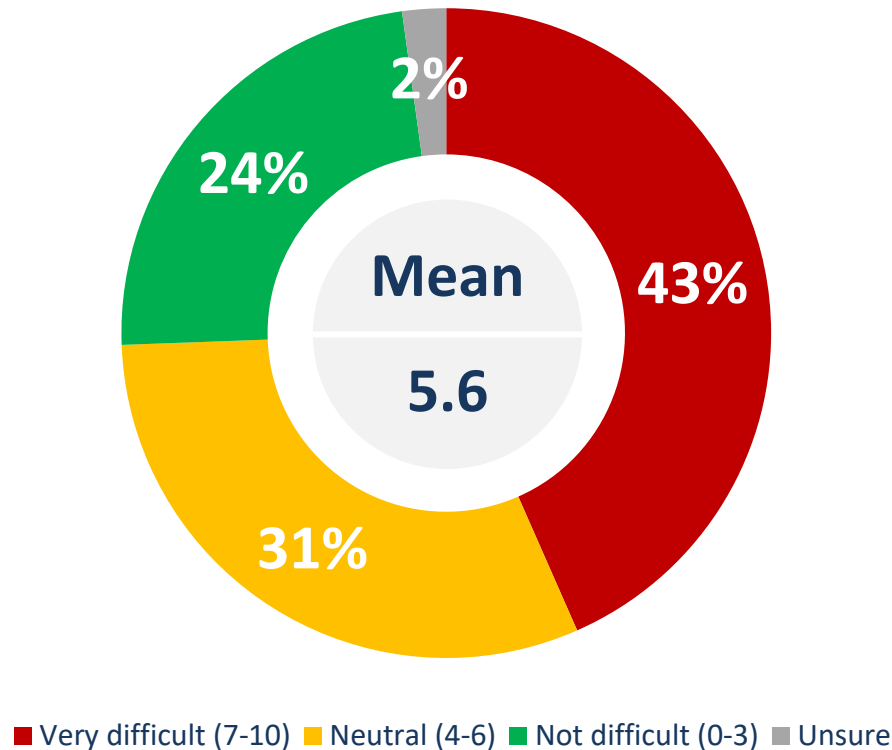

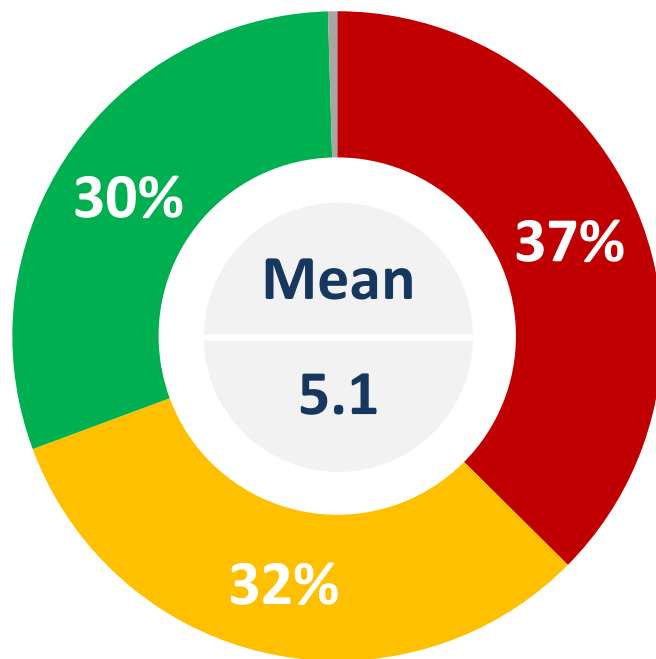

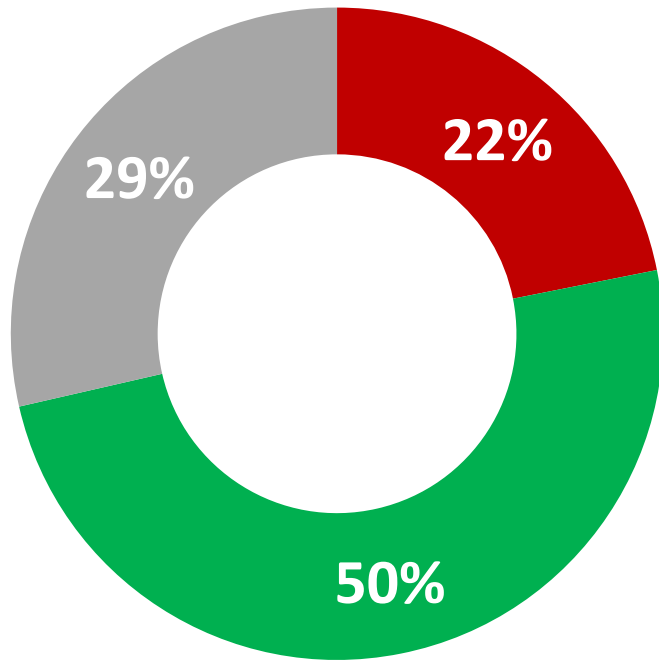

Percentage of reduction to office space



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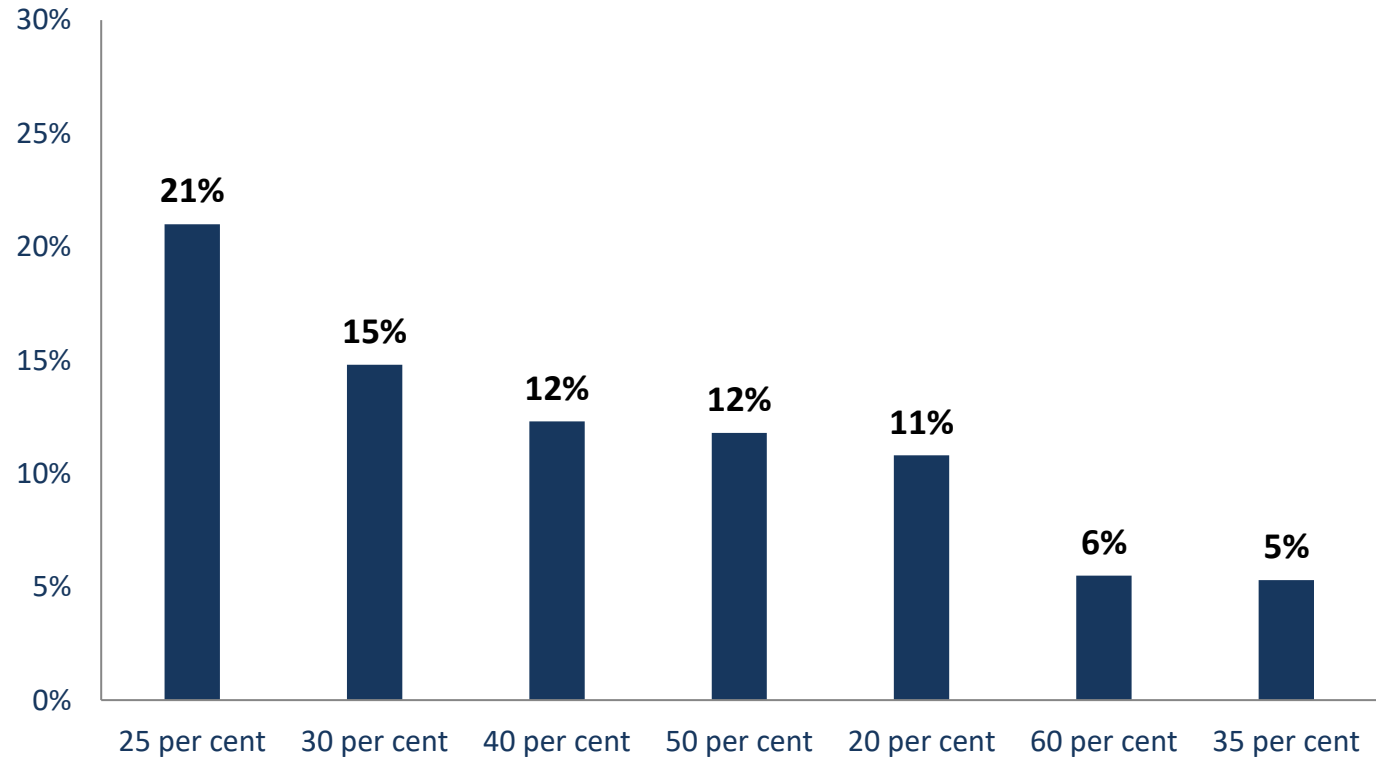

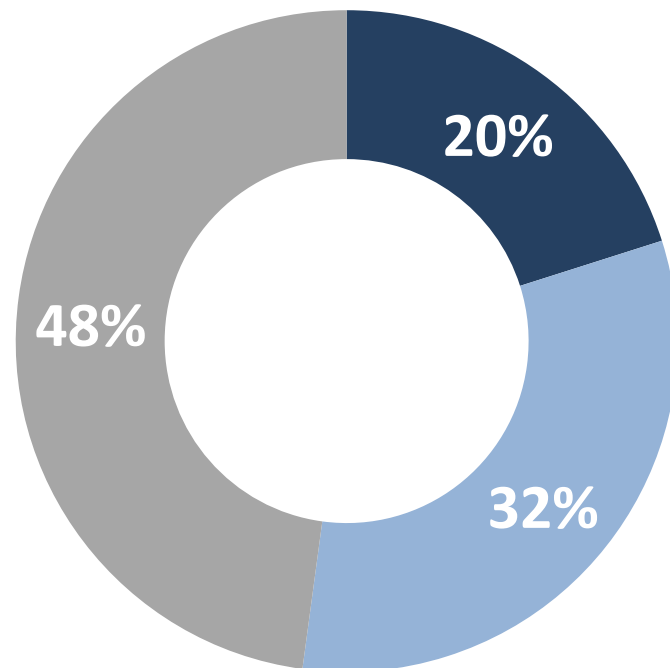
