



## **SUMMARY**





Nanos in collaboration with the Canadian Defence and Security Network conducted a survey of Canadians to gauge their knowledge, perceptions and attitudes towards defence and security issues. To follow are the key findings of the study.

#### Canada's place in the world

- Canadians most frequently say that Canada should have a peacekeeping role in the world Thirty-one per cent of Canadians say Canada's role should be as a peacekeeper, mediator and voice of reason, followed by 13 per cent who say a leader and decision maker, as well as 10 per cent should say advocate for human rights and helping those in need and an example or role model, respectively.
- More than four in five Canadians say diplomacy is very important to advancing Canada's place in the world Asked the importance of a number of items to Canada's place in the world on a scale of 0, not at all important, to 10, very important, diplomacy was most frequently rated as very important (82% give it a rating of 7 to 10 out of 10, mean of 8.1 out of 10), followed by international trade (80%, mean of 7.9 out of 10), environment (79%, score of 7.9 out of 10), immigration (59%, score of 6.7 out of 10), national defence (54%, score of 6.6. out of 10) and foreign aid (54%, score of 6.3 out of 10).
- Canadians who have served in the Armed Forces and those with a high school education or less are more likely to say national defence is important than Canadians who did not serve and have no family who served Canadian who have served in the Armed Forces rate national defence as having an importance of 7.8 out of 10 and Canadians with high school or less as 7.5 out of 10 to advancing Canada's place in the world, compared to a score of 6.3 out of 10 from those who did not serve and have no one in their family who served in the CAF and 6.0 out of 10 among Canadians who completed graduate studies.
- Those who served in the CAF less frequently say that immigration is important to advancing Canada's place in the world Members of the CAF rated the importance of immigration to advancing Canada's place in the world 5.6 out of 10 (5.9 among those with a high school education or less), while Canadians who did not serve and have no family who served scored it at 6.9 out of 10 (7.5 among those who completed graduate studies).

### **SUMMARY**





- Canadians are three times as likely to say Canada should promote its values rather than interests On a sliding ten-point scale going from 0, promoting interests to 10, promoting values, three in five Canadians (59%, score of 7 to 10) say promoting its values should be Canada's foreign policy priority, nearly one in five (17%, score of 0 to 3) say promoting its interests should be the priority, while one quarter (24%, score of 4 to 6) say a balance between promoting values and interests.
- Canadians most frequently say Canada should promote values such as inclusivity, fairness and equality and interests such as trade and economic exchange A quarter of Canadians say that Canada should promote values such as inclusivity, fairness, equality (25%), followed by peace (13%), human rights (13%) and democracy (11%), while over a third say interests such as trade and economic exchange (36%), followed by environmental responsibility (16%) should be promoted.
- Canadians most frequently say they care about how Europe views Canada Asked how much they care about how Canada is viewed by several countries or organizations on a scale from 0, do not care, to 10, care, most frequently Canadians (78%, score of 7 to 10) say they care how Europe views Canada, while the they least frequently say they care about how China perceived Canada (36%, score of 7 to 10).

#### International threats to Canada

• Canadians are twice as likely to say that that Canada is facing international threats to a high degree than to say they are not facing threats at all — Canadians were their views on the extent to which Canada faces international threats, from 0, not at all, to 10, to a high degree. Two in five (41%) say Canada is facing international threats to a high degree (7 to 10 out of 10), just over a third (36%) give a middle range rating (4 to 6 out of 10), and one in five (20%) say not at all (0 to 3 out of 10). Three per cent are unsure.





- Canadians who have served in the CAF report a higher degree of perceived international threats Canadians who served in the CAF score the degree to which Canada faces international threats a 6.3 out of 10, compared to 5.5 out of 10 for Canadians who did not serve and have no family who served.
- China is perceived as the top threat to Canada both today and in the future One in five (22%) Canadians say China is the most important threat to Canada, followed by 17 per cent who say the US/Trump and 10 per cent say cyber attacks. When it comes to the greatest international threats Canada will face in 10 years, 15 per cent say China and 13 per cent say climate change and the environment and eight per cent are cyber attacks.





# Importance of diplomacy advancing Canada's place in the world











# Importance of environment to advancing Canada's place in the world











# Level of care about Africa's view of Canada











Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,504 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between August 21<sup>st</sup> and August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada.

Individuals were randomly called using random digit dialling with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for this survey is  $\pm 2.5$  percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

The research was commissioned by the Canadian Defence and Security Network and was conducted by Nanos Research.
