

One in Four Canadians do not trust any federal Party with the federal government's finances post-Covid-19 - Liberals have edge over the Conservatives.

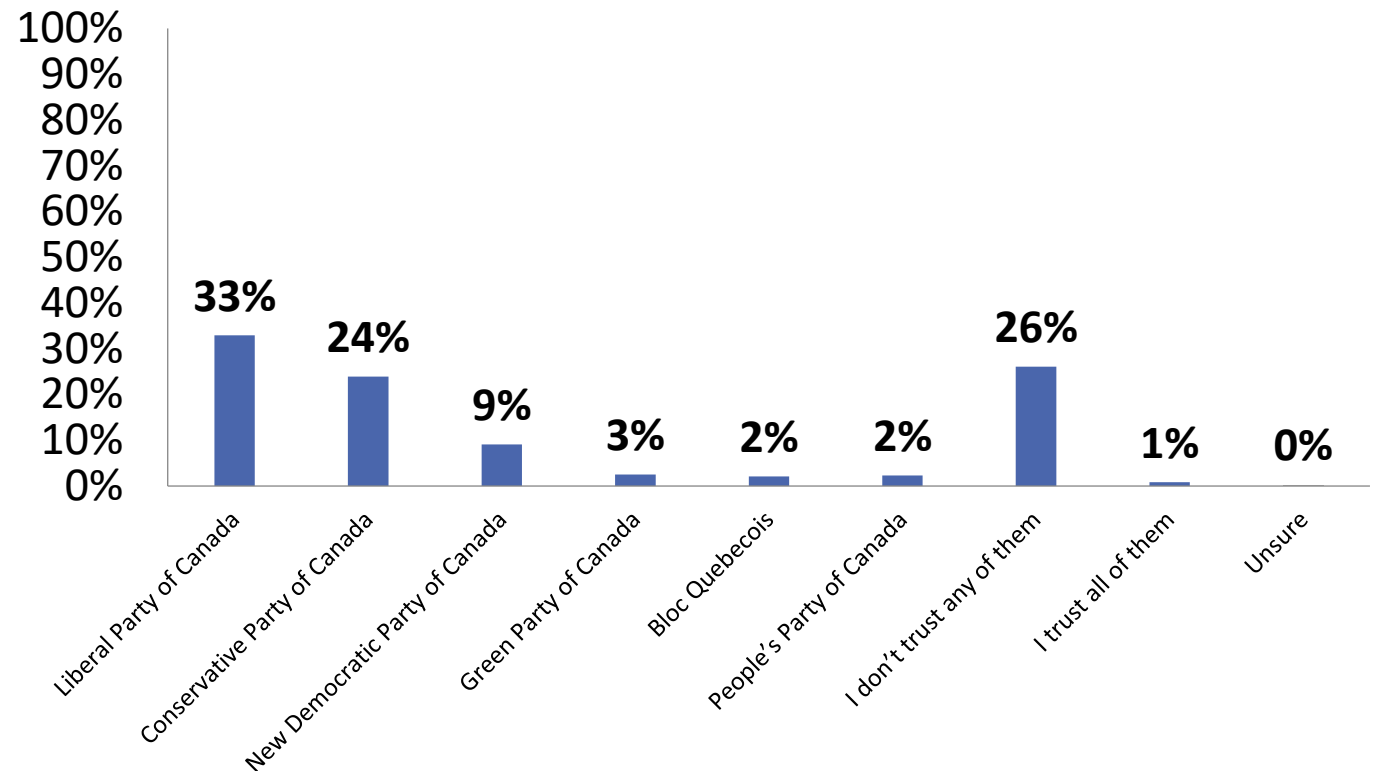
Trust in federal parties to manage federal government's finances

Q Which federal party do you trust most to manage the federal government's finances once the pandemic is behind us? [RANDOMIZE]

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Canadians have mixed views on who they trust most to manage the federal government's finances post-pandemic with one in three (33%) trusting the Liberals and about one in four trusting the Conservatives (24%). Twenty-six per cent of Canadians do not trust any of the federal parties.

METHODOLOGY

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,016 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between February 28th to March 4th, 2021 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada. Individuals randomly called using random digit dialing with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for this survey is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

This study was commissioned by Bloomberg News and the research was conducted by Nanos Research.
