









Managing the economy








# Job done by the federal Liberal Government handling Canada US relations

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and celllines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,051 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between June 30<sup>th</sup> and July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, as part of an omnibus survey. Individuals randomly called using random digit dialling with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for this survey is  $\pm 3.1$  percentage points, 19 times out of 20.
