





Canadians have mixed views when it comes to who they trust most to have a strong plan for the environment with just over one in five who trust the Liberals most (22%) and just under one in five who trust the Greens most (19%). Younger Canadians are more likely to trust the NDP most (25% of those 18-34) compared to older Canadians (15% of those 55 plus).






Working to have more affordable housing

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and celllines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,029 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between August 28th and 30th, 2021 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada.

Individuals randomly called using random digit dialling with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for this survey is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

This study was commissioned by CTV News and the Globe and Mail and the research was conducted by Nanos Research.
