



Political institutions lowest contributors






Level of satisfaction with Canada as a country


















Contribution of Canada's House of Commons making Canada a better country


Contribution of Canada's Senate making Canada a better country




Contribution of Canada's Health system making Canada a better country


Contribution of Canada's charities making Canada a better country
