## Canadians more likely to support increasing economic sanctions rather than going to war with Russia over Ukraine.



## ECONOMIC SANCTIONS

There is strong support among Canadians (63\% support, 20\% somewhat support) for increasing economic sanctions and actions against Russia even if it resulted in a prolonged series of price increases. Younger Canadians were less likely to support (47\%) or somewhat support this (21\%).


## GOING TO WAR WITH RUSSIA

While Canadians are more likely to oppose (32\%) or somewhat oppose (13\%) going to war with Russia over Ukraine rather support (21\%) or somewhat support (26\%) this, support is stronger when asked about going to war with Russia if it invades another country other than Ukraine (41\% support 25\%

## AIRLIFTING UKRAINIAN REFUGEES

A majority of Canadians support
(58\%) or somewhat support (27\%) using Canadian tax dollars to airlift Ukrainian refugees to Canada. Just over one in ten oppose (six per cent) or somewhat oppose (eight per cent) this.

## ACCEPTING UKRAINIAN REFUGEES

About four in ten Canadians, each, say that we should accept more Ukrainian refugees (44\%) or the same amount (41\%) compared to Syrian refugees, while under one in ten (seven per cent) say we should accept fewer.

## ESTABLISHING NO-FLY ZONE

Canadians are split on whether or not they support having NATO establish a no-fly zone over Ukraine, with under one in two who support (22\%) or somewhat support (25\%) this, and under one in two who oppose (30\%) or somewhat oppose (15\%) this.
