
Three years after the release of the National Inquiry, Canadians are over three times more likely to rate the job done by the Government of Canada as poor rather than good when it comes to ending the ongoing national tragedy of missing and murdered Indigenous women and girls (MMIWG).







June 3rd, 2022 marks the third anniversary of the National Inquiry for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG). The national inquiry released its final report, titled Reclaiming Power and Place, on June 3, 2019, after two years of gathering testimonies from families and survivors across the country where it identified 231 Calls for Justice.

In light of the third anniversary, the Native Women's Association retained Nanos research to conduct research among Canadians to gauge their views on their awareness and level of knowledge of this topic, as well as their views on the importance of the Government of Canada taking action to provide justice for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG). The research also focused on how Canadians perceived the job done by the Government of Canada on a number of actions relating to Indigenous Peoples, Truth and Reconciliation, and MMIWG.

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,001 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between May 26th to 30th, 2022 as part of an omnibus survey. The research was commissioned by Native Women's Association of Canada and was conducted by Nanos Research.

Key Findings – Job done by Government of Canada



JOB DONE ENDING MMIWG TRAGEDY

Canadians are over three times more likely to rate the job done by the Government of Canada as poor (41%) rather than good (12%) when it comes to ending the ongoing national tragedy of missing and murdered Indigenous women and girls (MMIWG). They are also two times more likely to say the same about making communities safe today for Indigenous women, girls, and LGBTQ and Two-spirit People and working to prevent future violence against them.



JOB DONE DELIVERING ON PROMISES

Canadians are three times more likely to say the Government of Canada is doing a poor job (50%) rather than a good job (14%) at delivering on promises to have clean water for Indigenous communities. Similarly, they are more likely to say they are doing a poor job (39%) rather than a good job (16%) at delivering on promises to support safe Indigenous communities.



JOB DONE RESPECTING INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

Canadians rate the job done by the Government of Canada accepting responsibility for the past actions federal governments that may have been harmful to Indigenous peoples highest (mean score of 5.5 out of 10) but are split on the job done with respect to Truth and reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples (mean of 4.9), respecting the rights of Indigenous Peoples (mean of 5.1), and respecting the views of Indigenous Peoples (mean of 5.0).

AWARENESS AND KNOWLEDGE OF 231 CALLS FOR JUSTICE FOR MMIWG

About seven in ten Canadians have heard of the 231 Calls for Justice identified by the National Inquiry for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG) (71%) and rate their level of knowledge on the topic as average (mean of 5.1 out of 10). Residents of BC who have heard of the National Inquiry for MMIWG rate their level of knowledge highest (mean of 5.7) compared to those from other regions.



IMPORTANCE OF GOVERNMENT TAKING ACTION TO PROVIDE JUSTICE FOR MMIWG

Almost nine in ten Canadians believe it is important (61%) or somewhat important (26%) for the Government of Canada to take action in order to provide justice for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG). Women (70%) and residents of Ontario (66%) are more likely to believe it is important for the Government to take action.



IMPORTANCE OF BEING TRANSPARENT IN SPENDING TO ADDRESS MMIWG

Over nine in ten also believe it is important (72%) or somewhat important (23%) for the Government of Canada to be transparent in their spending for addressing the national tragedy of MMIWG. Residents of the Prairies (83%) are more like to believe this is important than residents of Ontario (70%), Atlantic Canada (70%) or Quebec (64%).







Awareness of the 231 Calls for Justice








Rating the job done by the Government of Canada making communities safe today











Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and celllines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,001 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between May 26th to 30th, 2022 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada.

Individuals were randomly called using random digit dialling with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for a random survey of 1,001 Canadians is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

The research was commissioned by Native Women's Association of Canada and was conducted by Nanos Research.
