Investing in a home seen as being more positive than negative – residents believe region is a good place to raise a family with an overall good quality of life.

The Brantford Regional Real Estate Association (BRREA) retained Nanos Research to conduct a survey among residents of the City of Brantford and the County of Brant, 18 years of age and older.

The objectives of the research were as follows:

- Understand what people think of the City of Brantford and the County of Brant, and gain advice on how to make it a better place;
- Gauge the demographics of people buying houses, and find out the factors that are most important when purchasing; and,
- Gauge what residents think of the value of real estate in their neighborhood.

The research was commissioned by Brantford Regional Real Estate Association (BRREA) and was conducted by Nanos Research.

## **Key Findings**



#### **INVESTMENT BUYING A HOME**

Buying a home is more likely to be seen as a positive rather than a negative investment. One in two residents of the City of Brantford/County of Brant say buying a home today is a very good (15%) or good (35%) investment while only one in four say it is a poor (18%) , or very poor (8%) investment. Older residents (55 plus) are more likely to say it is a good (42%) or very good(18%) investment compared to younger residents (18-34)(31% good, 9% very good).



#### **MOVING TO BUY A HOME**

About three in four residents of the City of Brantford/County of Brant say they would consider (73%) moving out of the City of Brantford/County of Brant to a nearby community, if their preferred type of housing in the City of Brantford/County of Brant was not available for the price they could afford. Younger residents are more likely to say so (18 to 34)(74%) compared to older residents (55 plus)(59%).



#### VALUE OF REAL ESTATE Residents of the City of Brantford/County of Brant are more likely to say the value of real estate in their neighborhood will decrease (39%) or stay the same (34%) rather than increase (22%). Those who earn over \$100,000 a year are more likely to say so (46%) compared to those that earn less than 60,000 a year (33%).



## **Key Findings - Continued**



#### PREFERRED HOUSING TYPE

While the proportion of Brant residents who currently lives in Single detached family homes (77%) matches the proportion of those who would want to live in them (78%), there is a gap among Brantford residents with a higher proportion that would like to live in a single detached family home (72%) than those who currently do (63%).



#### **BUYING A SECOND PROPERTY**

Two thirds of Brantford residents who plan on purchasing a home in the next ten years show interest in buying a second property (17% interested, 15% somewhat interested) while over four in ten in Brant say the same (28% interested, 15% somewhat interested). Over one in two say they are not interested (56% for both Brantford and Brant residents).



#### LOCATION OF NEXT HOME

Four in ten residents of Brantford who plan on purchasing a home in the next ten years say their ideal location would either be the City of Brantford (29%) or the County of Brant (12%), while four in ten mention a location outside the region and 17 per cent are unsure. Under two in ten residents of Brant mention the region (four per cent Brantford, 14% Brant), while fifty per cent mention a location outside the region (including 18% who mention Paris). One third were unsure (33%).





## **Key Findings – Continued**



#### Views on the City of Brantford One in two residents of Brantford say the City is moving in the right direction (52%), while 33 per cent say it is moving in the wrong direction and 15 per cent are unsure. Overall, the city is rated highest in terms of a place to raise a family, the overall quality of life and a place where Indigenous Peoples are welcome. Housing affordability and public transit received lower ratings.

Views on the County of Brant Similarly, to the City of Brantford, one in two residents of Brant say the County is moving in the right direction (51%), while 33 per cent say it is moving in the wrong direction and 16 per cent are unsure. It is rated the highest by its residents in terms of it as a place to raise a family, the overall quality of life and as a safe place to live. It scored lowest in terms of Brant being a place to take public transit

Advice from residents of Brantford Asked what advice they have to make the city a better place, residents of the City of Brantford suggest most frequently that they would like to see homelessness and opioid use addressed (19%) and cleaning up the City and downtown (13%).



Advice from residents of Brant Residents of the County of Brant most frequently say their advice to make the County a better place would be to stop building new homes, slow down developments and keep green spaces (21%) and build better and more infrastructure (15%).



## The quality of life in Brantford/County of Brant

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Residents of the City of Brantford and the County of Brant both rate the City/County as a place to raise a family (mean of 7.1 and 8.2, respectively) and the overall quality of life as good (mean of 6.8 and 7.8, respectively).

Residents of the City of Brantford say they live there because they grew up there and it's their hometown (35%), because of job opportunities and that it is close to work or that they are a farmer (18%) and because of affordability (10%). Residents of the County of Brant also mention first that they live in the County because they grew up there and it's their hometown (26%), but they were more likely to mention they prefer the quiet/small town/country (19%) and they like the area and it's a nice please to live (13%).

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Residents of the County of Brant most frequently say their advice to make the County a better place would be to stop building new homes, slow down developments and keep green spaces (21%) and build better and more infrastructure (15%). 

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
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### Location of workplace









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## Housing preferences in Brantford/County of Brant

#### **Current housing type**







Would you say that buying a home today is a very good, good, average, poor, or very poor investment?











The margin of error for this survey of 747 residents of the City of Brantford and the County of Brant is  $\pm 3.6$  percentage points, 19 times out of 20.
