Majority are ok with those being treated for mental illness accessing medical assistance in dying; sentiment for MAID declines for waiting treatment for mental illness.

Canadians are more likely to agree (33\%) or somewhat agree (29\%) that people who are receiving treatment for mental illness should be able to access MAID than to agree that those who are waiting for treatment should be able to access it (19\% agree, 20\% somewhat agree). Overall, support for both is higher in Quebec and lower in the Prairies
