

# Canada's preparedness for another protest like the Freedom Convoy protest

Q – Do you think Canada is prepared, somewhat prepared, somewhat not prepared or not prepared for another protest like the Freedom Convoy truckers protest?



Canadians are divided on whether Canada is prepared for another protest like the Freedom Convoy Truckers protest, with one in two that say Canada is prepared or somewhat prepared, and just under one in two who say the opposite.



# Confidence in Canada to handle another protest like the Freedom Convoy protest

Q – Do you have more, less or about the same amount of confidence in the ability of the police in Canada to handle another protest like the Freedom Convoy truckers protest?



Canadians are split on their confidence in the ability of the police in Canada to handle another protest like the Freedom Convoy truckers protest, with about one in four each saying they have less or more confidence.

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and celllines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1025 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between November 27<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada.

Individuals randomly called using random digit dialing with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for this survey is  $\pm 3.1$  percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

This study was commissioned by CTV News and the research was conducted by Nanos Research.
