

Younger Canadians report lowest level of satisfaction with Canada as a country Younger Canadians (18-34) report the lowest level of satisfaction (mean of <u>5.8</u>) with Canada as a country compared to all other demographics, especially older Canadians (55 plus) (mean of <u>7.2</u>) who report the highest satisfaction level. Education and Health system remain top contributors to Canada being a better country Canada's universities and colleges (mean of <u>7.3</u>) and Canada's health system (mean of <u>7.0</u>) are ranked as top major contributors to Canada being a better country.



Political institutions lowest contributors to Canada being a better country Canadians rate political institutions including the House of Commons (mean of 5.7), the prime minister (mean of 4.9), the Senate (mean of 4.1) and the Governor General (mean of 3.6) the lowest on the list of contributors. Of note, the Governor General was the only institution to show year by year improvement








Contribution of Canada's universities and colleges making Canada a better country



Contribution of Canada's universities and colleges making Canada a better country















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
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Contribution of Canada's Governor General making Canada a better country








Contribution of Canada's Prime Minister making Canada a better country










Canada's House of Commons


Contribution of Canada's House of Commons making Canada a better country










Contribution of Canada's Senate making Canada a better country







Contribution of Canada's arts and cultural organisations making Canada a better country










Contribution of Canada's charities making Canada a better country




Contribution of the Canadian Armed Forces making Canada a better country
