



Increase in positive sentiment of the United States from Canadians since Trump departure continues in 2023.

Key Findings



United States keeps top spot for Canadians on positive relationship that benefits Canada
Canadians continue to rank the United States as the partner they are most comfortable with in terms of having a positive relationship that benefits Canada with two in three that say so ([67%](#)), a slight increase from 2022 ([62%](#)). This followed far behind by Europe ([24%](#)) and Asia([2%](#)).



UK remains highest rated on most positive opinion
Canadians have the most positive opinion of the UK in terms of being a positive partner to Canada with close to nine in ten that say they have a positive ([53%](#)) or somewhat positive ([33%](#)) opinion, followed by Germany ([45%](#) positive, [34%](#) somewhat positive), which is similar to the last wave. Positive opinion of the United States continues to increase compared to 2019, 2021 and 2022.



Cooperation on trade issues most preferred
When asked to rate the level of cooperation Canada should have with Europe, over four in five Canadians think there should be high levels of collaboration (score of 7 to 10 out of 10) between Canada and Europe on trade issues ([85%](#)) which represents a noticeable increase from the last wave ([79%](#)) and overtakes security issues ([82%](#)) in terms of the highest rating.



Australia and Germany are preferred energy partners
Australia gets the highest rating from Canadians in terms of the energy partner they are comfortable with (score of 7-10 out of 10) with about three in five that say so ([73%](#)), a significant increase from 2022 ([62%](#)), followed closely by Germany ([70%](#)).

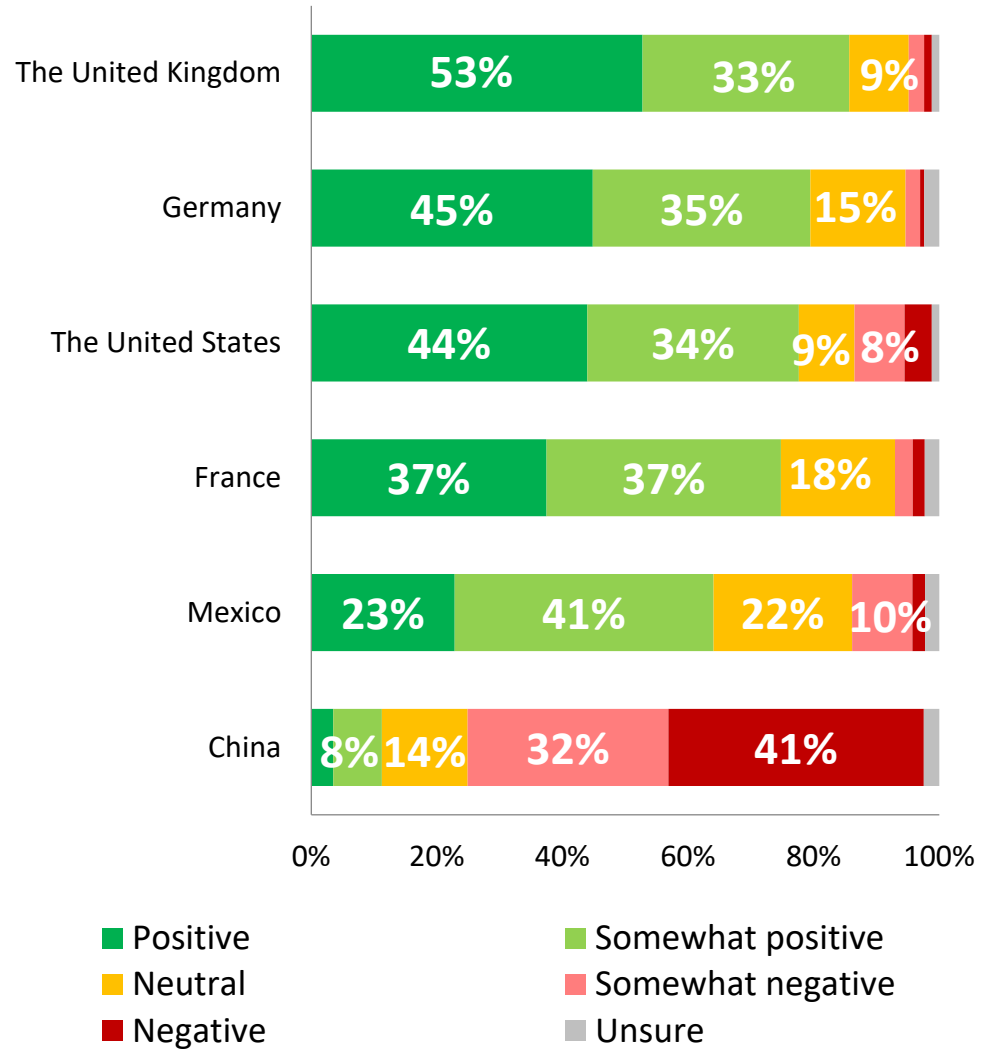

say they have a positive or somewhat positive opinion of the United Kingdom followed by Germany and the United States, while three in four have a positive or somewhat positive opinion of France and two in three have a positive or somewhat positive opinion of Mexico. Three in four Canadians have a negative or somewhat negative opinion of China.

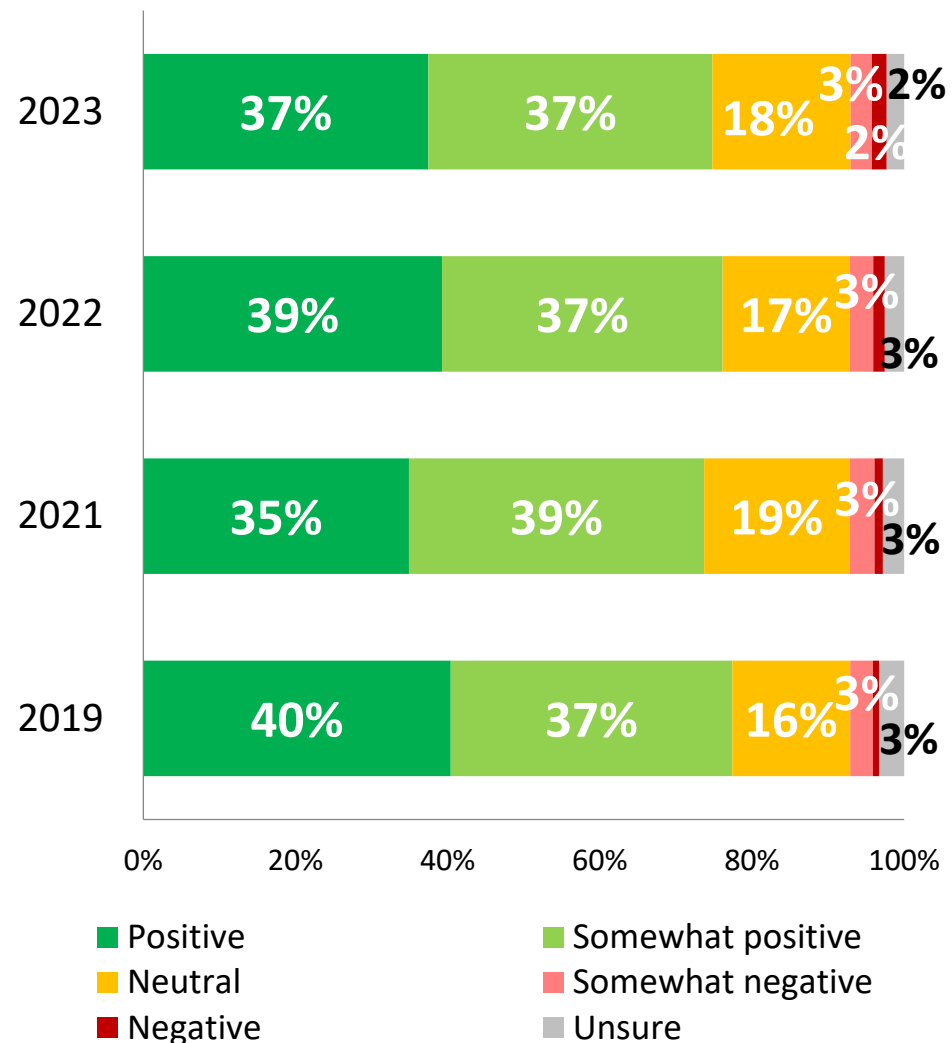

say they have a positive or somewhat positive opinion of France in terms of being a positive partner, consistent with all previous waves of research. Residents of Québec are more likely to say they have a positive (49%) or somewhat positive (35%) opinion of France than residents of the prairies (37% positive, 32% somewhat positive) and of British Columbia (30% positive, 37% somewhat positive).

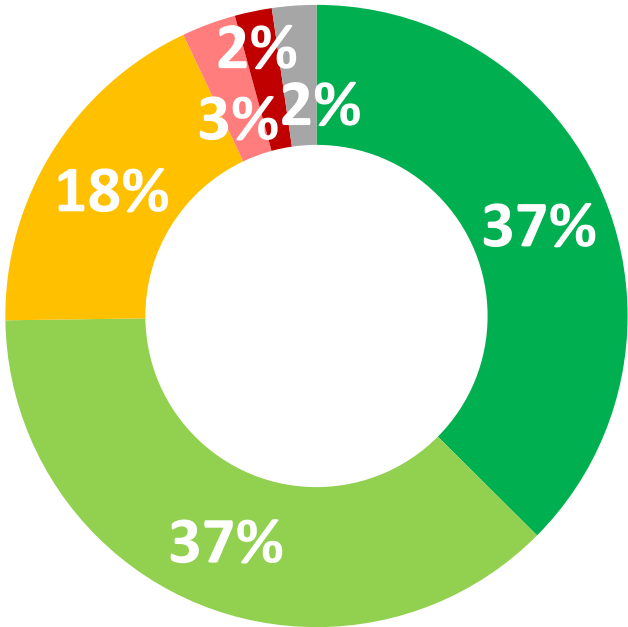

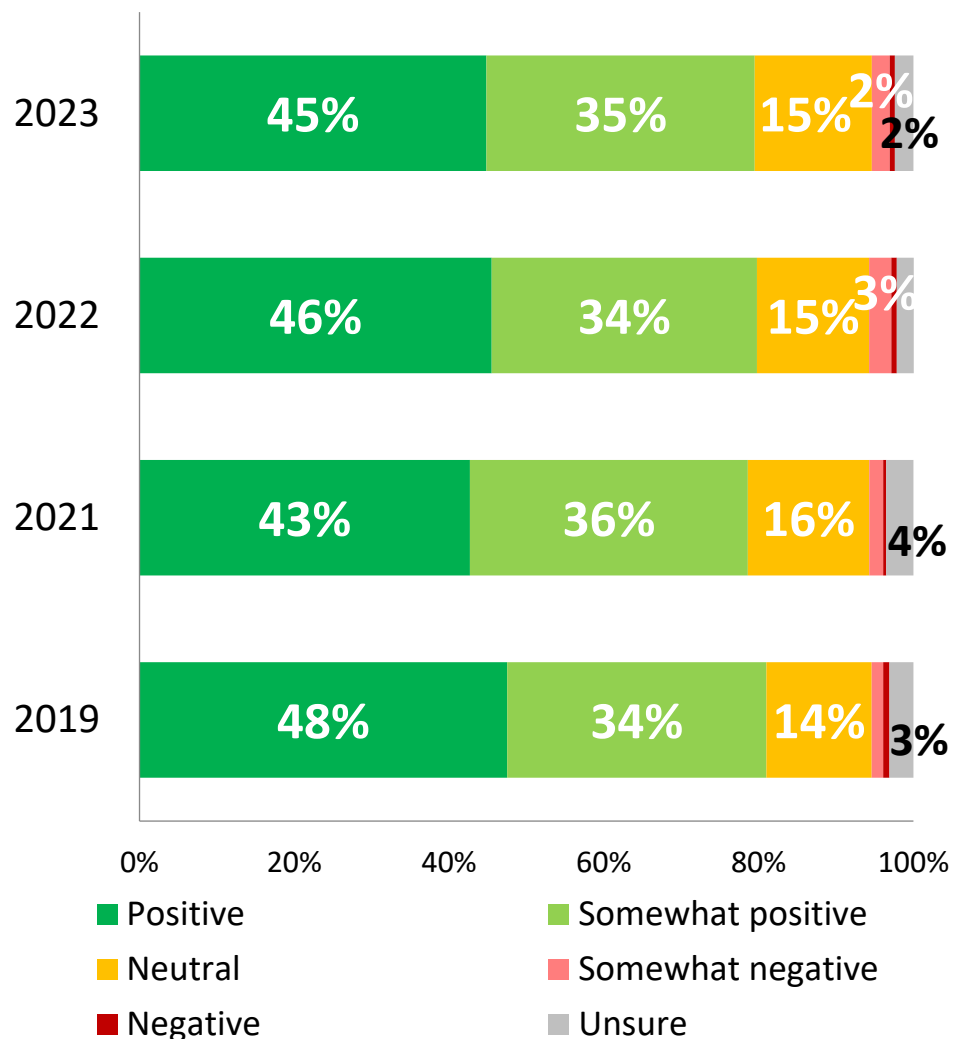

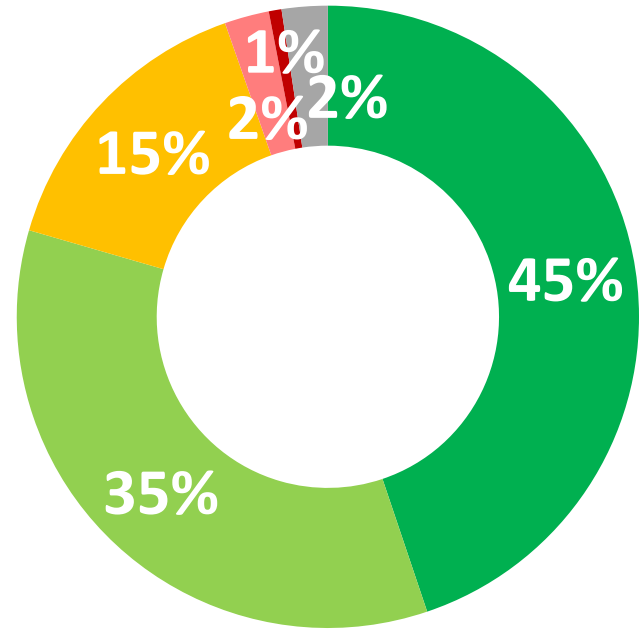

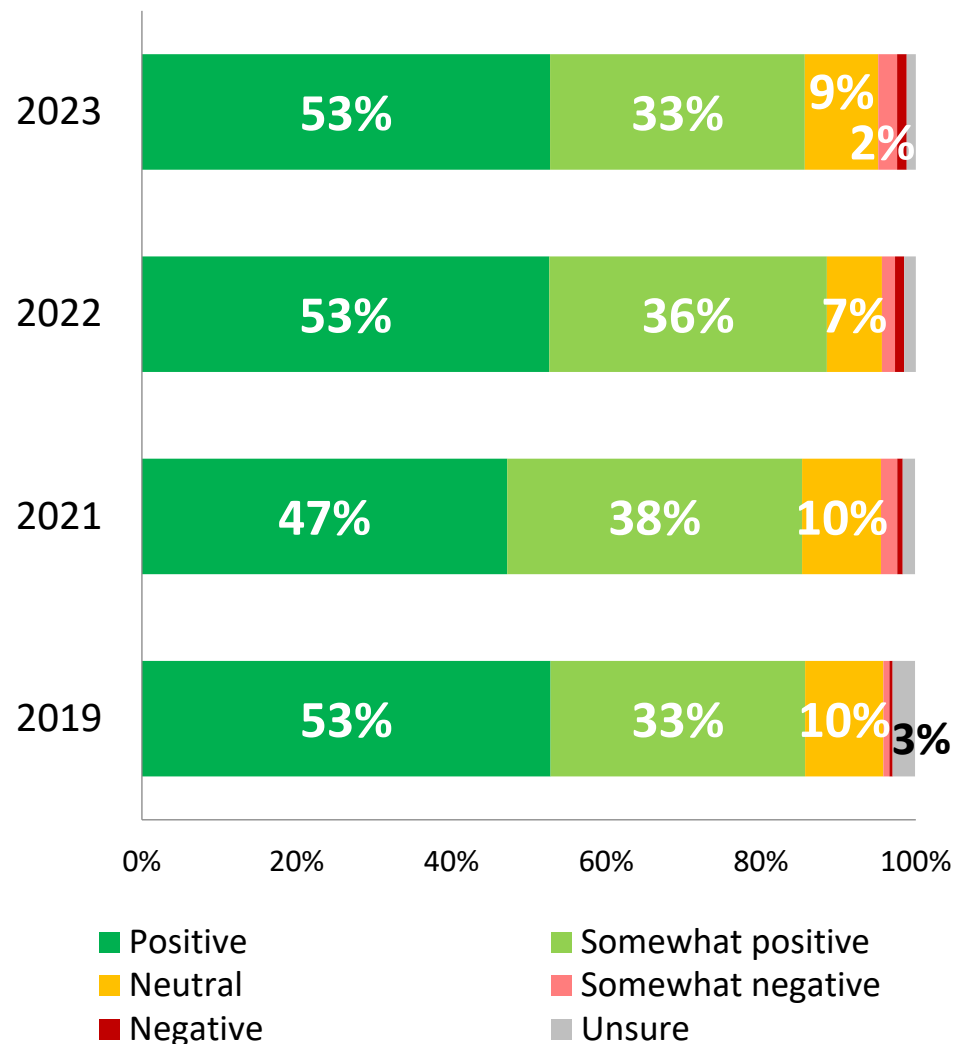

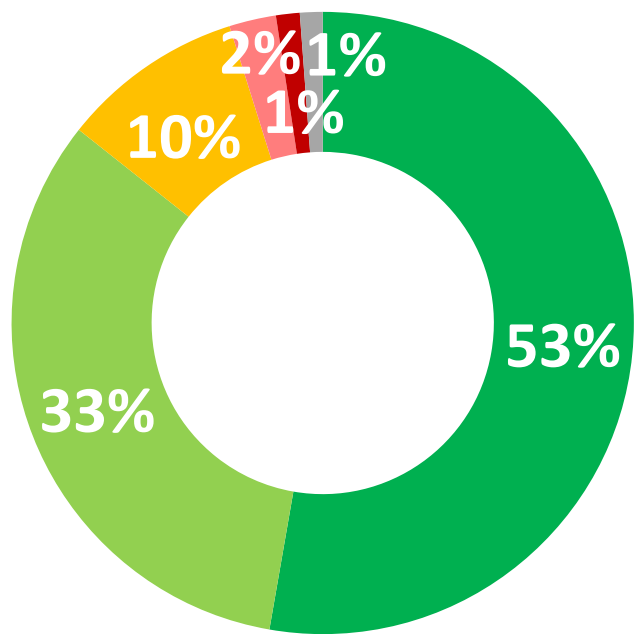

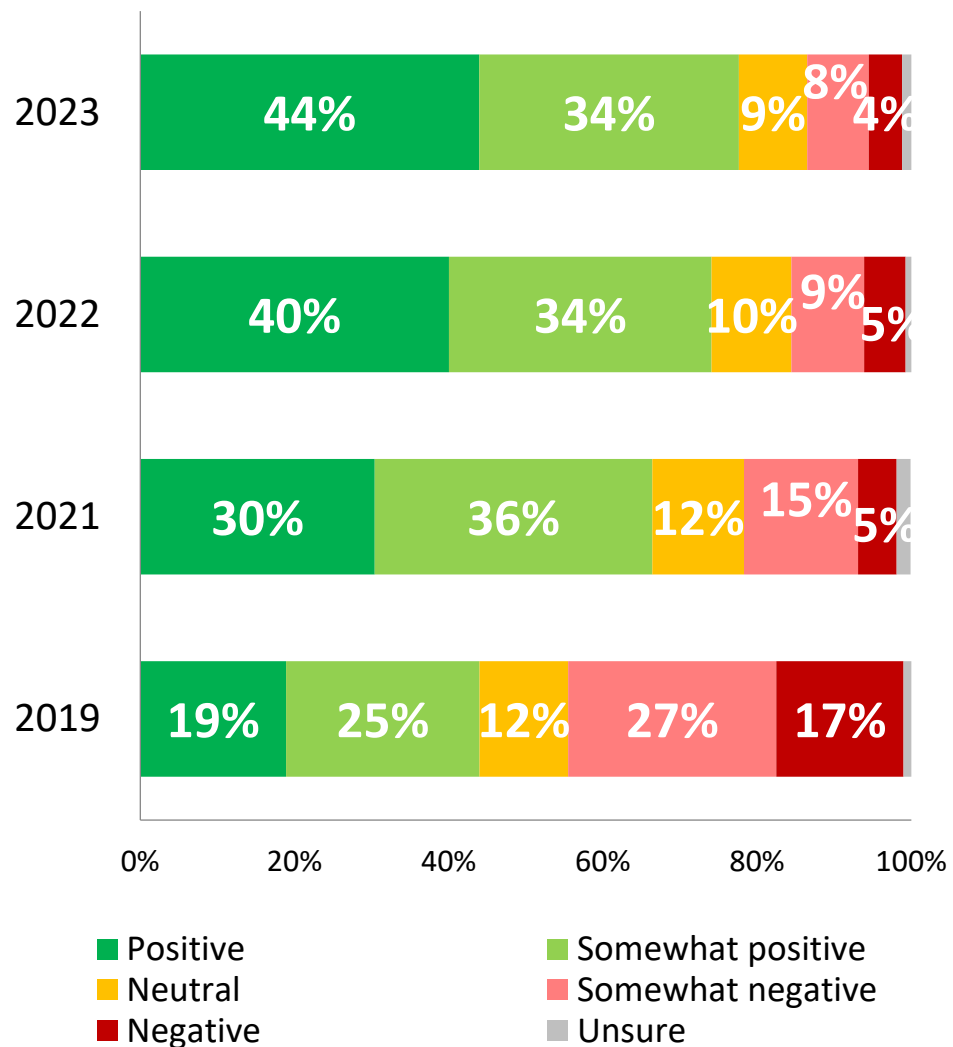
Opinions of Canada's relationship with the United States

Close to **8 in 10** Canadians

say they hold a positive opinion of the United States in terms of being a positive partner with Canada, which has been increasing every year since the 2019 wave, where fewer than one in two had a positive or somewhat positive impression. Younger Canadians aged 18-34 are less likely to have a positive (39%) or somewhat positive (32%) impression than older Canadians aged 35-54 (43% positive, 36% somewhat positive) and 55 plus (48% positive, 33% somewhat positive).

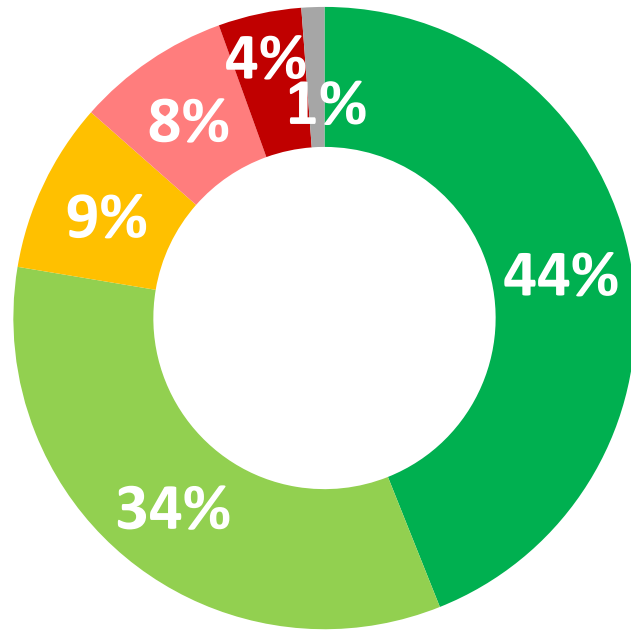

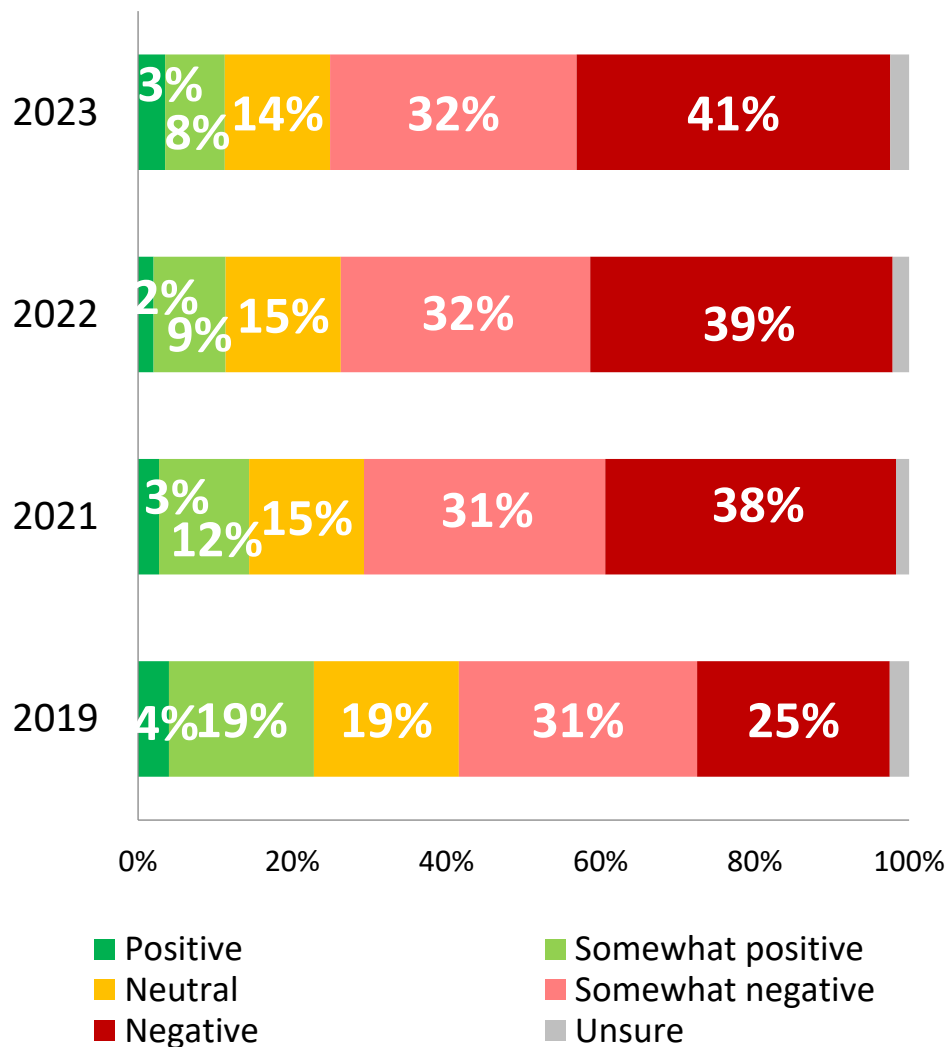

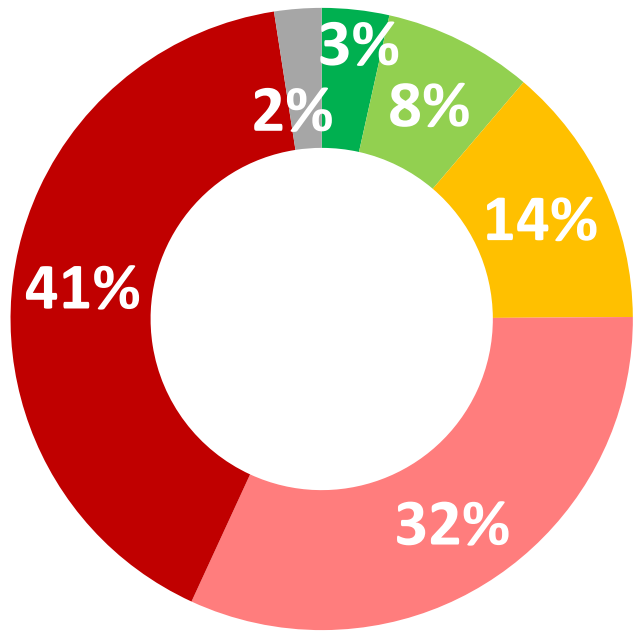

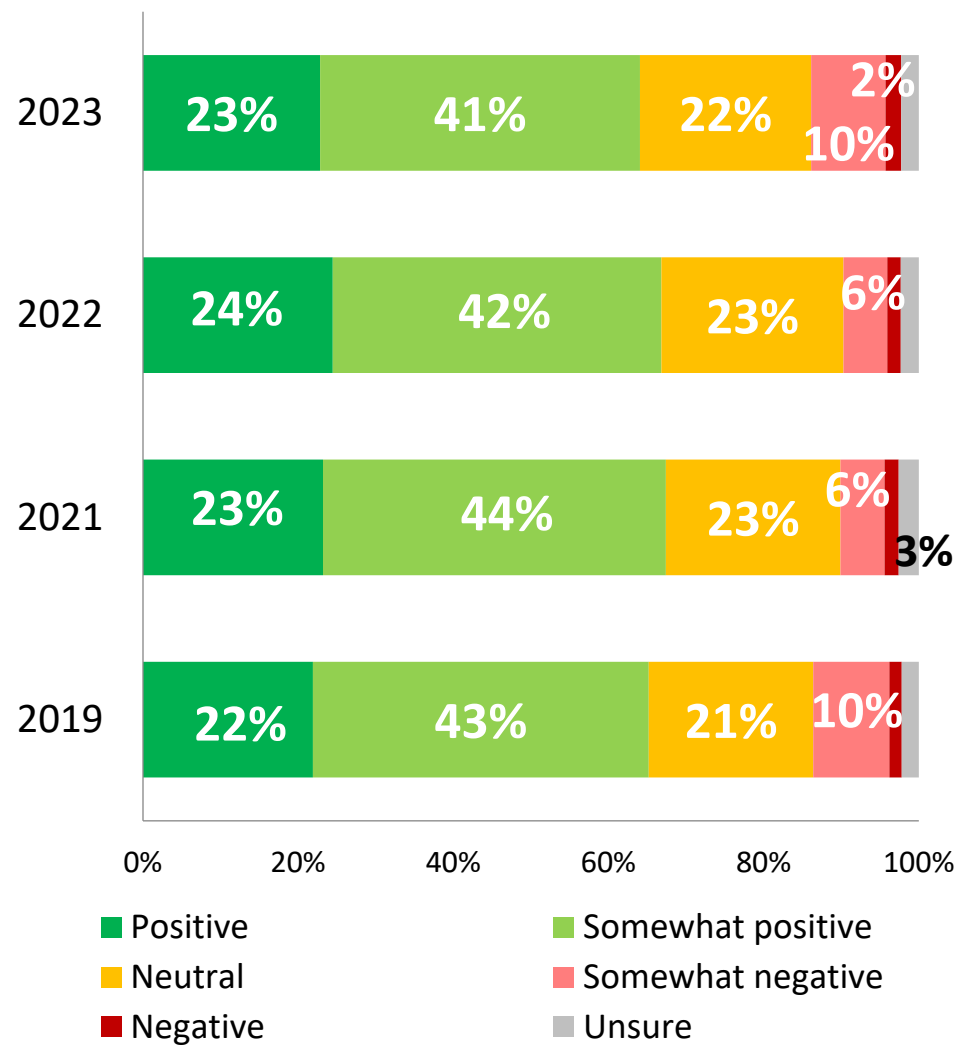

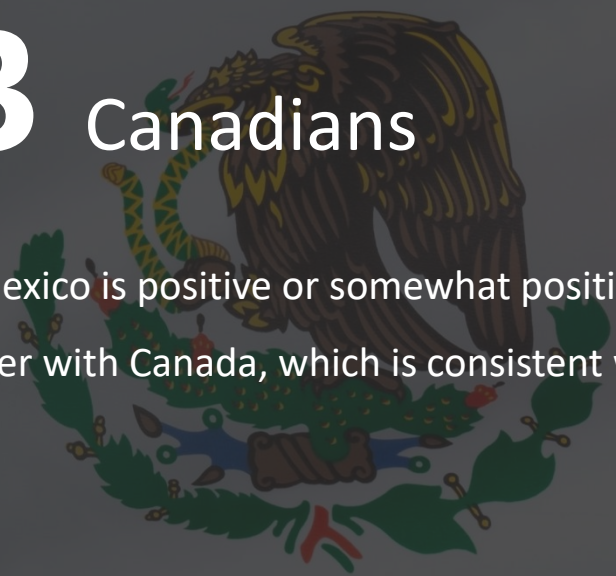

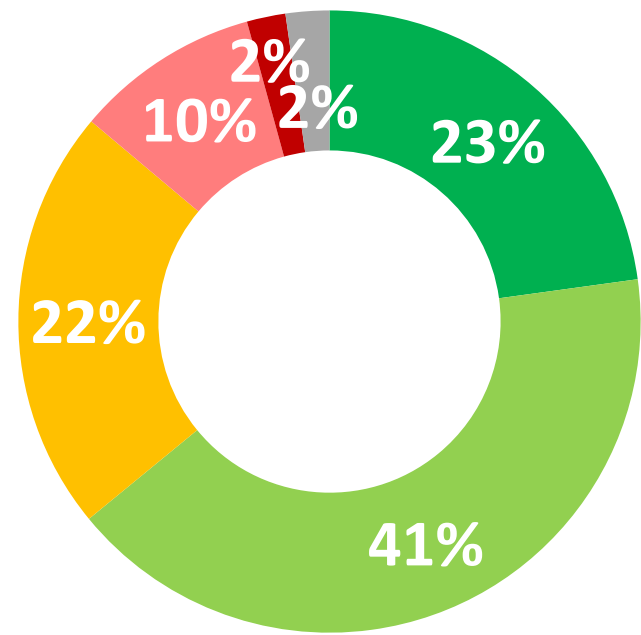

Canada's relationship with Europe

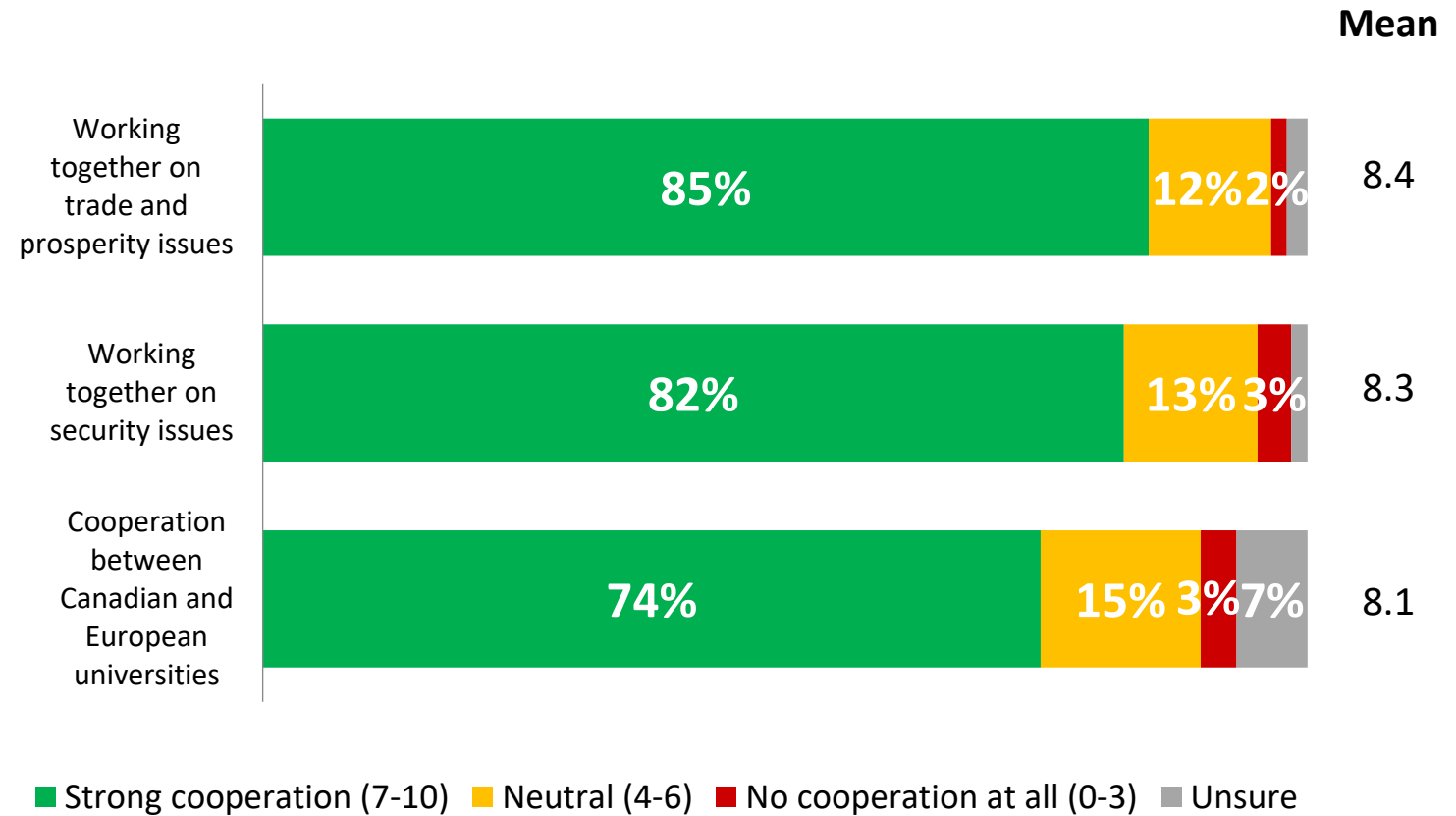
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Canadians are most likely to want a high level of collaboration between Canada and Europe on trade issues (85%), followed closely by security issues (82%). Consistent with previous waves, a strong majority of Canadians have a favourable (40%) or somewhat favourable opinion (42%) of NATO.

On average, Canadians give high scores when asked to rate the level of cooperation Canada should have with Europe in working together on trade and prosperity issues (mean of 8.4), working together on security issues (mean of 8.3) and cooperation between Canadian and European universities (mean of 8.1).

Views on Canada's cooperation with Europe



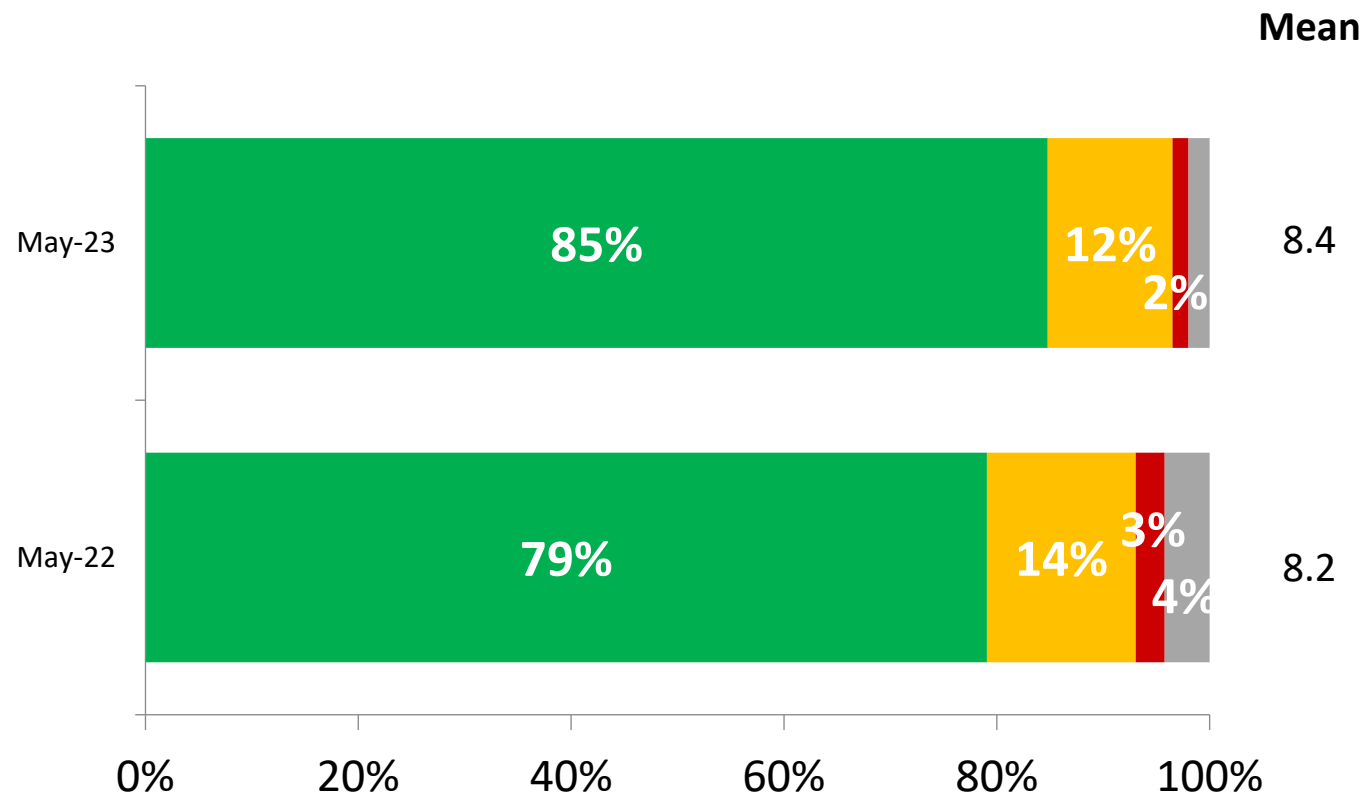

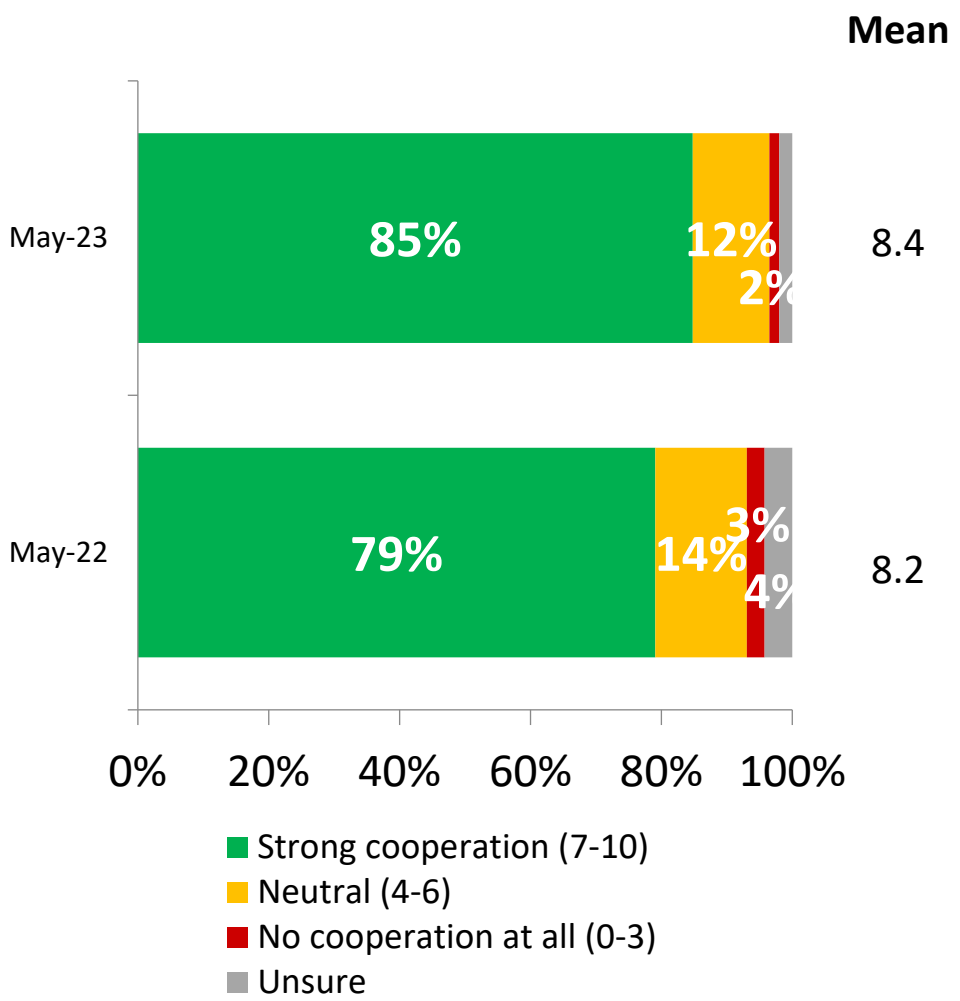

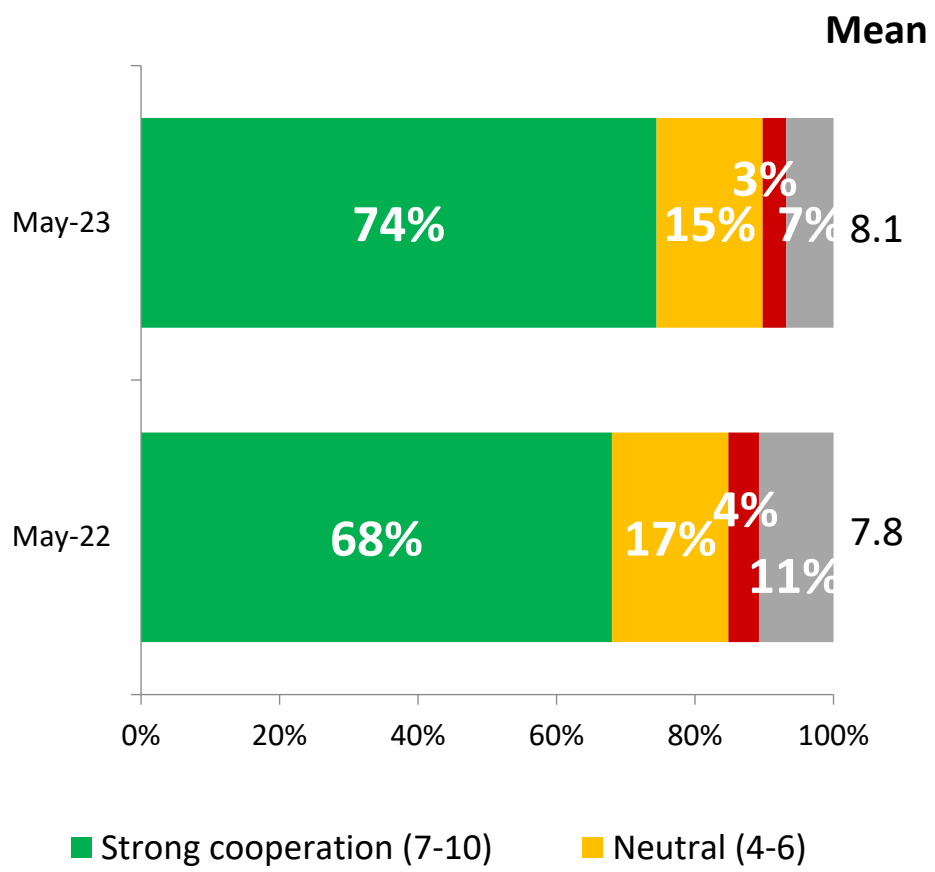

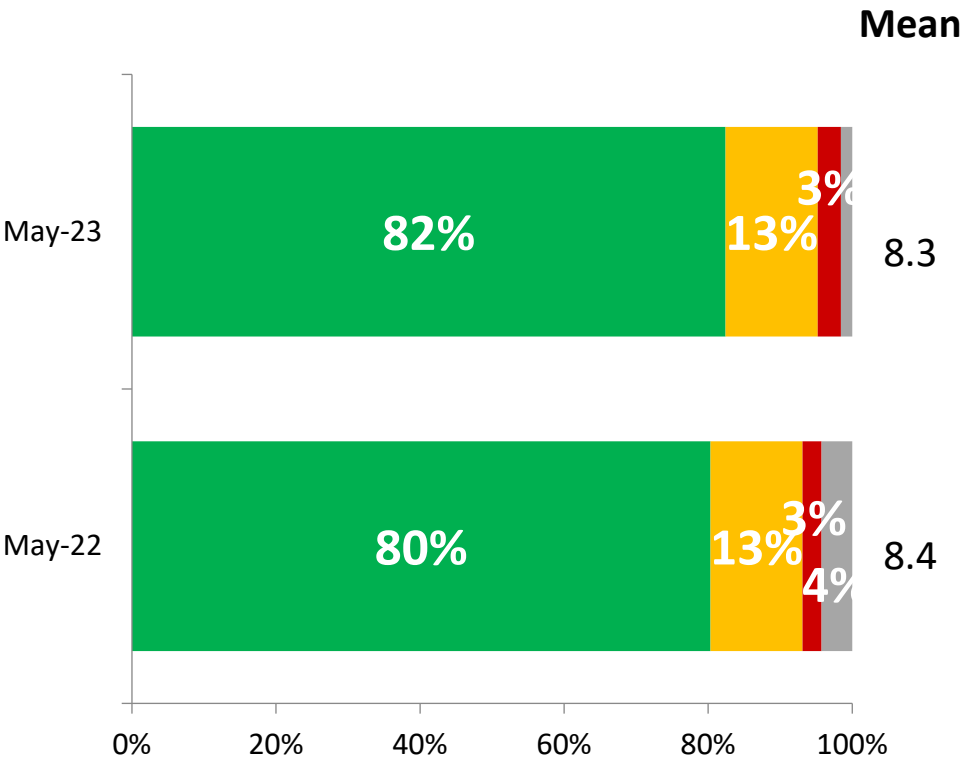

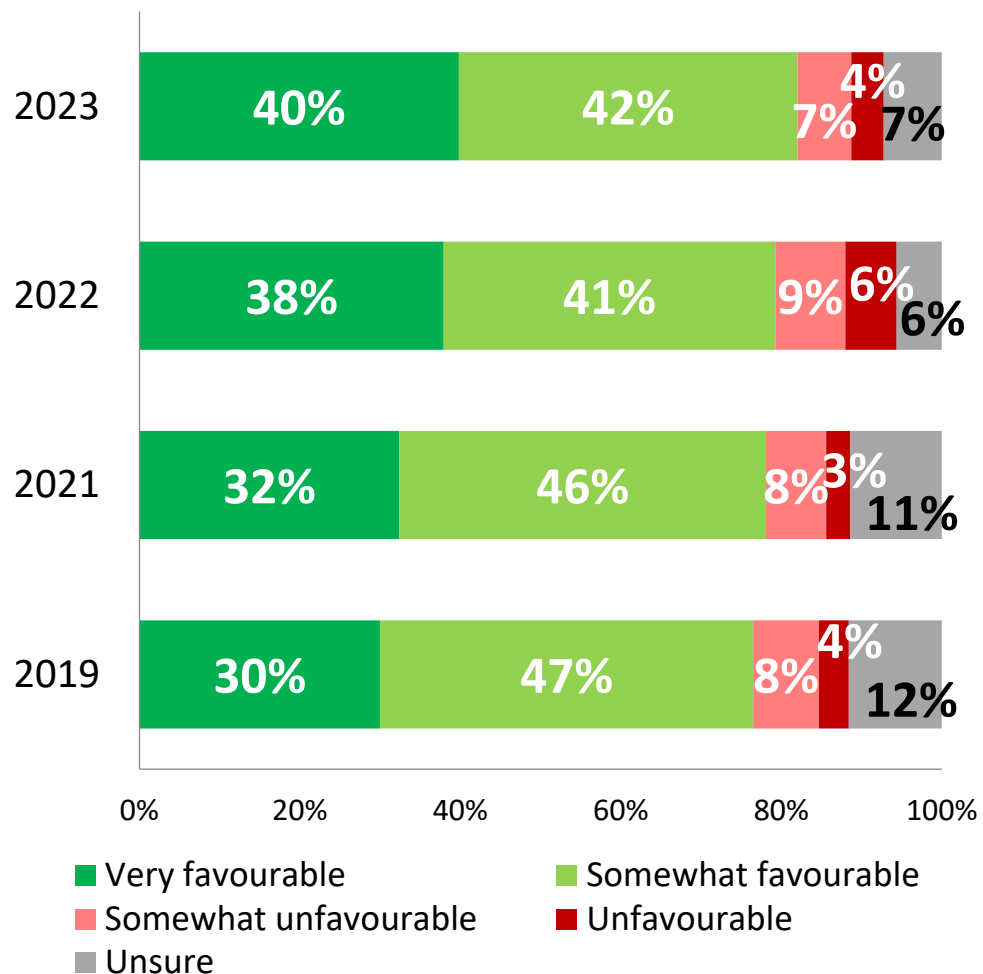

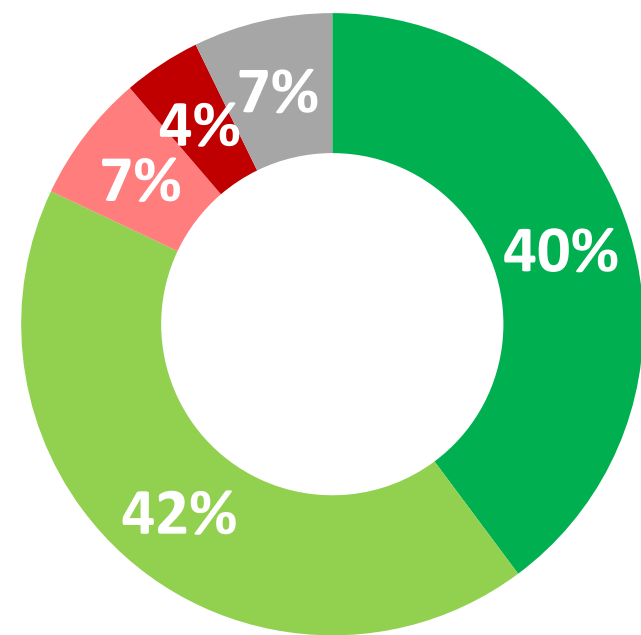

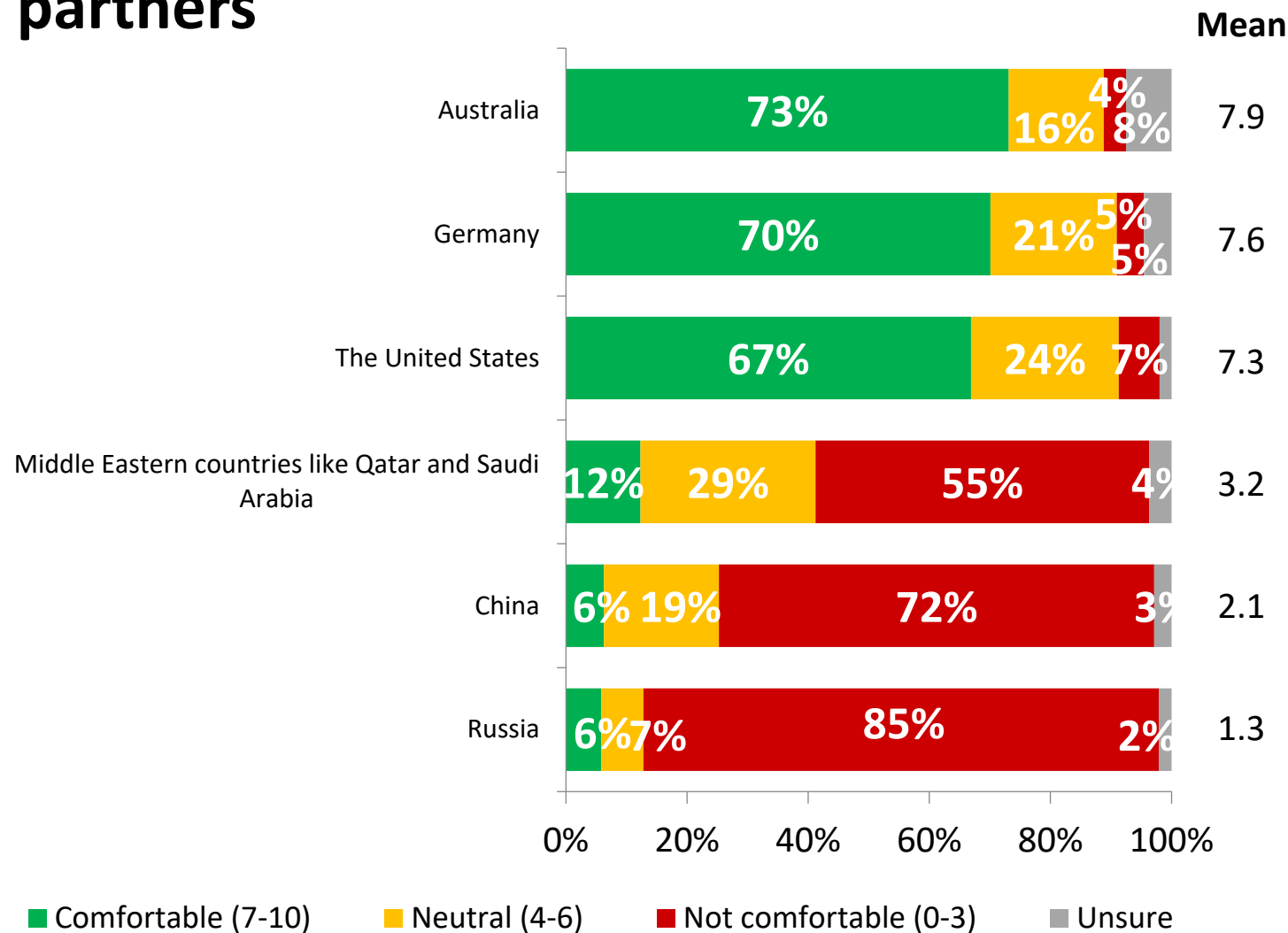

Levels of comfort with countries as energy partners

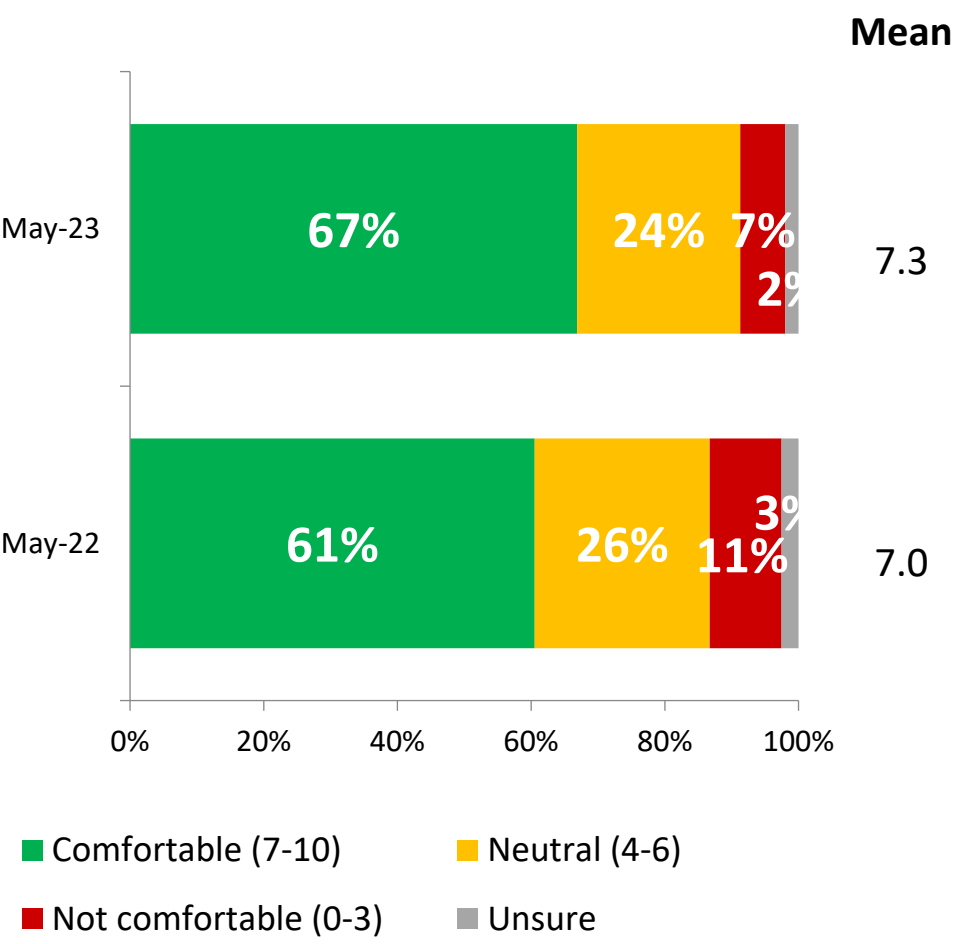

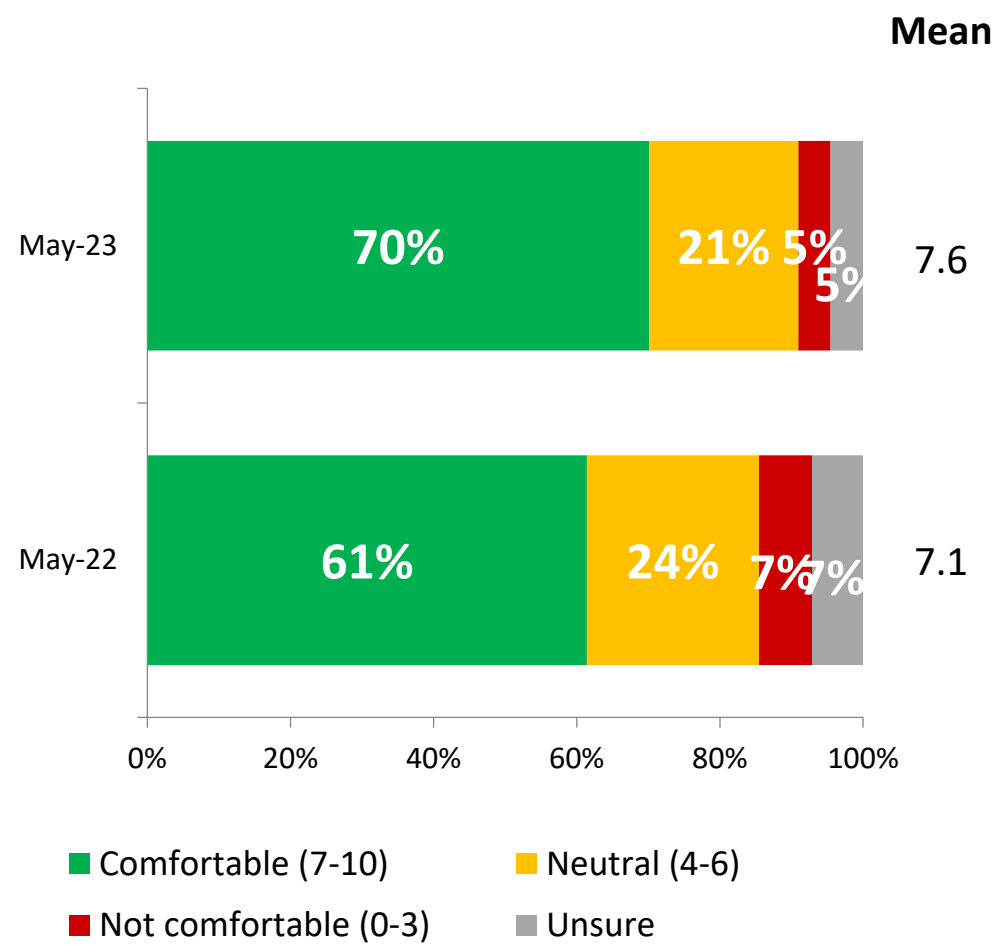

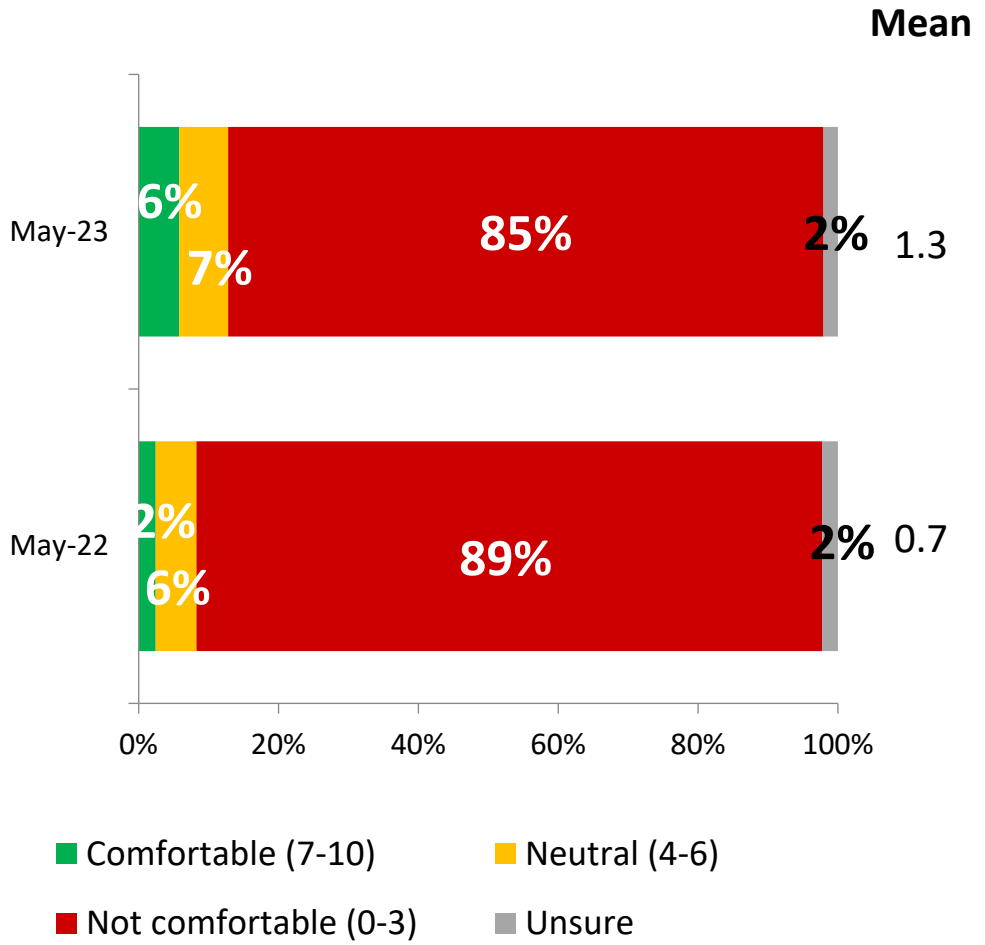

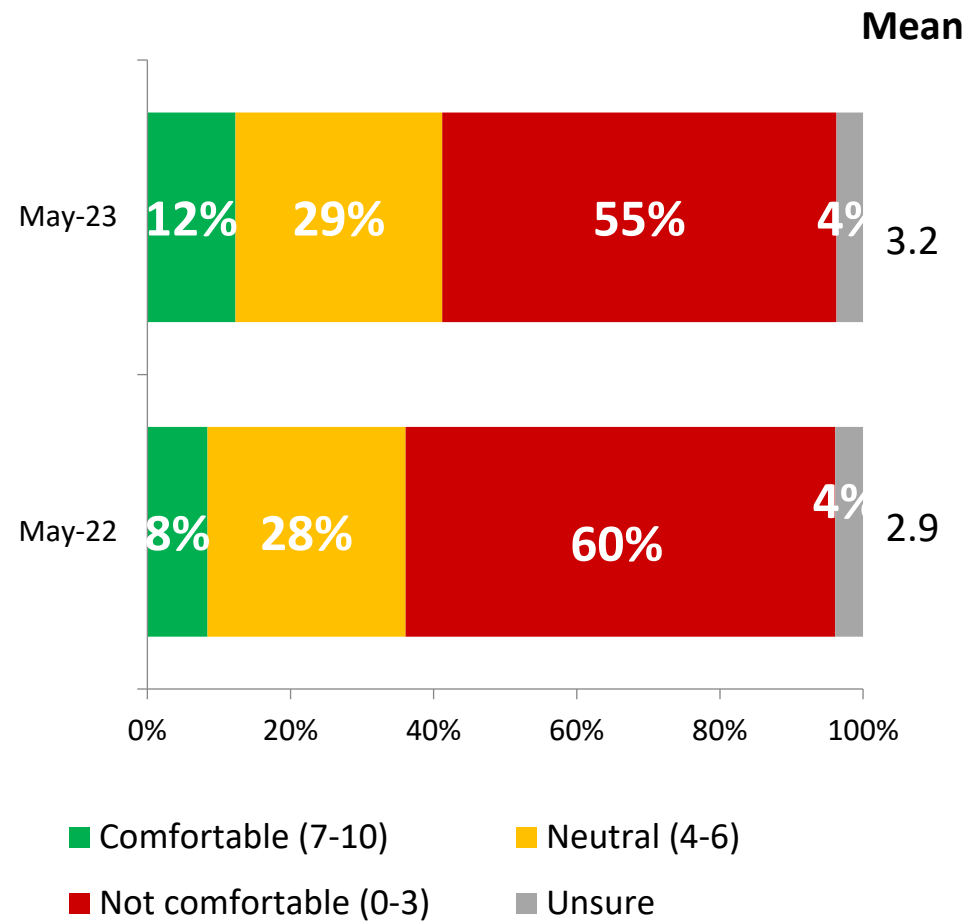

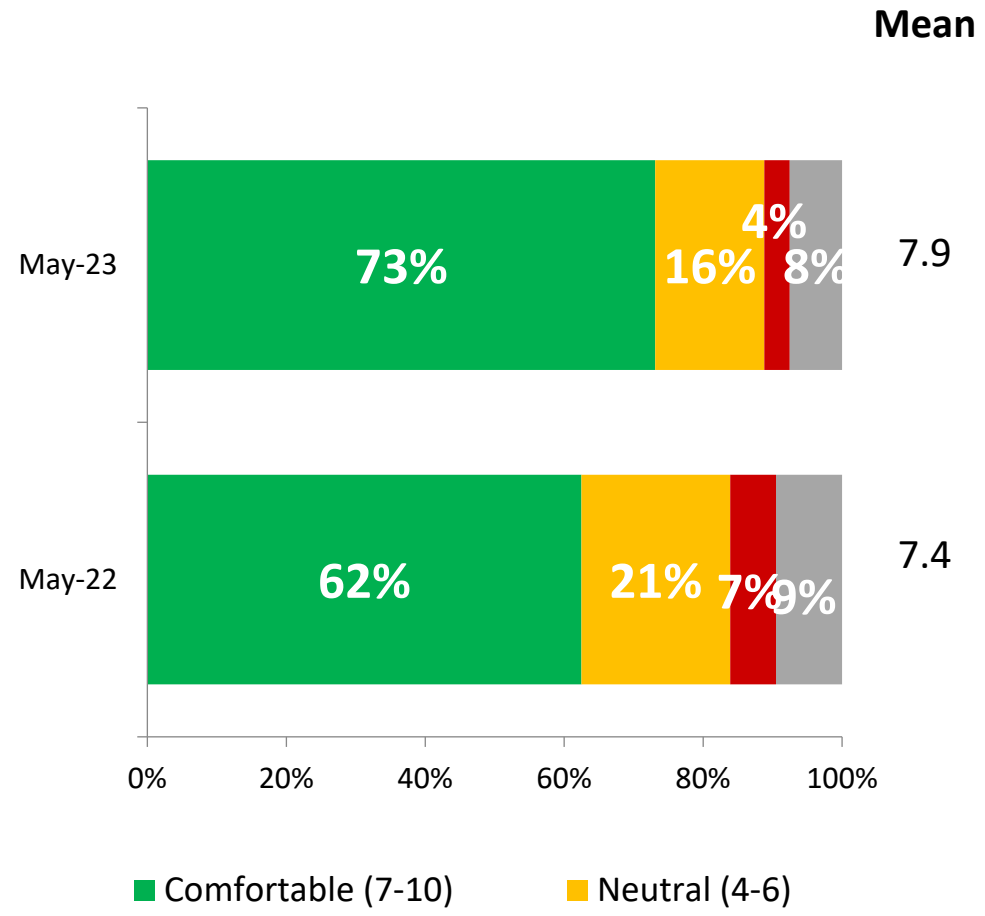

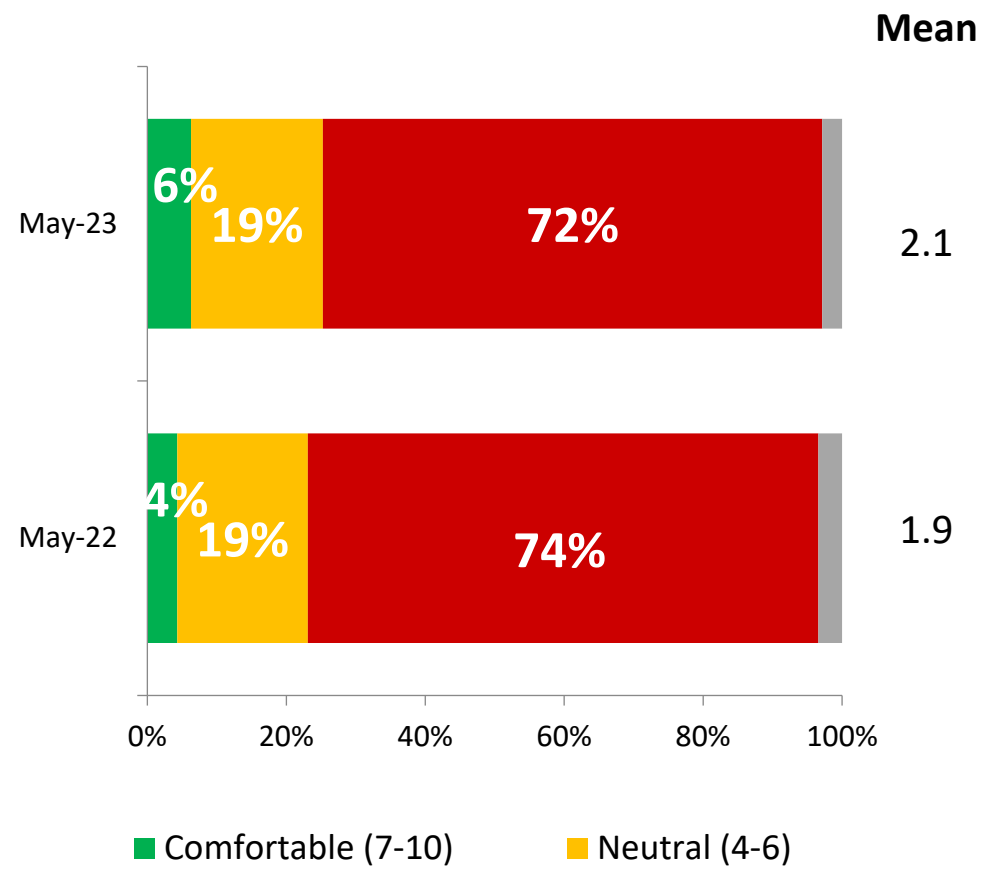
