Canadians on positive relationship that benefits Canada Canadians continue to rank the United States as the partner they are most comfortable with in terms of having a positive relationship that benefits Canada with two in three that say so (67%), a slight increase from 2022 (62%). This followed far behind by Europe (24%) and Asia(2%).

UK remains highest rated on most positive opinion

Canadians have the most positive opinion of the UK in terms of being a positive partner to Canada with close to nine in ten that say they have a positive (53%) or somewhat positive (33%) opinion, followed by Germany (45% positive, 34% somewhat positive), which is similar to the last wave. Positive opinion of the United States continues to increase compared to 2019, 2021 and 2022.

Cooperation on trade issues most preferred

When asked to rate the level of cooperation Canada should have with Europe, over four in five Canadians think there should be high levels of collaboration (score of 7 to 10 out of 10) between Canada and Europe on trade issues (85%) which represents a noticeable increase from the last wave (79%) and overtakes security issues (82%) in terms of the highest rating.



Australia and Germany are preferred energy partners

Australia gets the highest rating from Canadians in terms of the energy partner they are comfortable with (score of 7-10 out of 10) with about three in five that say so (73%), a significant increase from 2022 (62%), followed closely by Germany (70%).









Canadians are most likely to want a high level of collaboration between Canada and Europe on trade issues (85%), followed closely by security issues (82%). Consistent with previous waves, a strong majority of Canadians have a favourable (40%) or somewhat favourable opinion (42%) of NATO.




Canada-Europe cooperation on trade and prosperity














Level of comfort with Russia and Canada as energy partners
