Half of Canadians with a mortgage are concerned or somewhat concerned about making payments when their mortgage renews.



Nanos was retained by CTV News to conduct research among Canadians to gauge their views on mortgage payments.

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,006 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between December 27th to 29th, 2023 as part of an omnibus survey. The margin of error for this survey is ±3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

say they are concerned (24%) or somewhat concerned (28%) about their ability to make their mortgage payments when their mortgage renews. Younger Canadians (18 to 34) are more likely to be concerned (29%) or somewhat concerned (34%) about this than those 55 plus (16% concerned; 20% somewhat concerned), and women are more likely to be concerned (26% concerned; 33% somewhat concerned) than men (22% concerned; 21% somewhat concerned).

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and celllines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,006 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between December 27th and 29th, 2023 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The sample included both land- and cell-lines across Canada. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada.

Individuals randomly called using random digit dialling with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for this survey is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.
