

About half of Canadians see a need in taking training – Computer and occupational training most popular.



The research gauged the opinions among Canadians on their employment status, required training and their concerns regarding technology and AI's impact on the job market.

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land-and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,069 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between November 30th to December 2nd, 2023, as part of an omnibus survey. The margin of error for this survey is ± 3.0 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

The research was commissioned by Senator Bellemare and was conducted by Nanos Research.

Key Findings



CANADIANS SPLIT ON INTEREST IN TAKING TRAINING

Just under one in two Canadians are either interested in taking training ([29%](#)), interested but do not have time ([7%](#)) or interested but cannot afford it ([13%](#)), while just under one in two say they have all the training they need ([28%](#)) or do not want training ([17%](#)). Younger Canadians aged 18 to 34 are more likely to say they are interested in taking training ([66%](#)) than older Canadians aged 55 plus ([28%](#)).



CANADIANS AGREE MOST THAT THEY SHOULD TAKE TRAINING TO IMPROVE THEIR COMPUTER AND OCCUPATIONAL SKILLS

When asked to assess their agreement with statements on training, Canadians are most likely to agree or somewhat agree that they should take training to improve their computer skills ([16% agree; 29% somewhat agree](#)), followed by training to improve their occupational skills ([18% agree; 22% somewhat agree](#)).



ONE CANADIAN IN FIVE SAYS TECHNOLOGY AND CLIMATE CHANGE ARE LIKELY OR SOMEWHAT LIKELY TO THREATEN HIS JOB

[20%](#) of Canadians say that technological and climate changes are likely ([6%](#)) or somewhat likely ([14%](#)) to threaten their job. While under four in five Canadians say technological changes and climate change are unlikely ([48%](#)) or somewhat unlikely ([30%](#)) to threaten their jobs.



ALMOST TWO IN FIVE CANADIANS SAY IT IS LIKELY OR SOMEWHAT LIKELY THAT TECHNOLOGY AND CLIMATE CHANGE AFFECT THEIR WORK AND WILL REQUIRE TRAINING

[37%](#) of Canadians say it is likely ([10%](#)) or somewhat likely ([27%](#)) that technology and climate changes affect their work and will require training. While almost three in five Canadians say their work tasks and their training needs are unlikely ([34%](#)) or somewhat unlikely ([24%](#)) to be affected by technological changes and climate change,

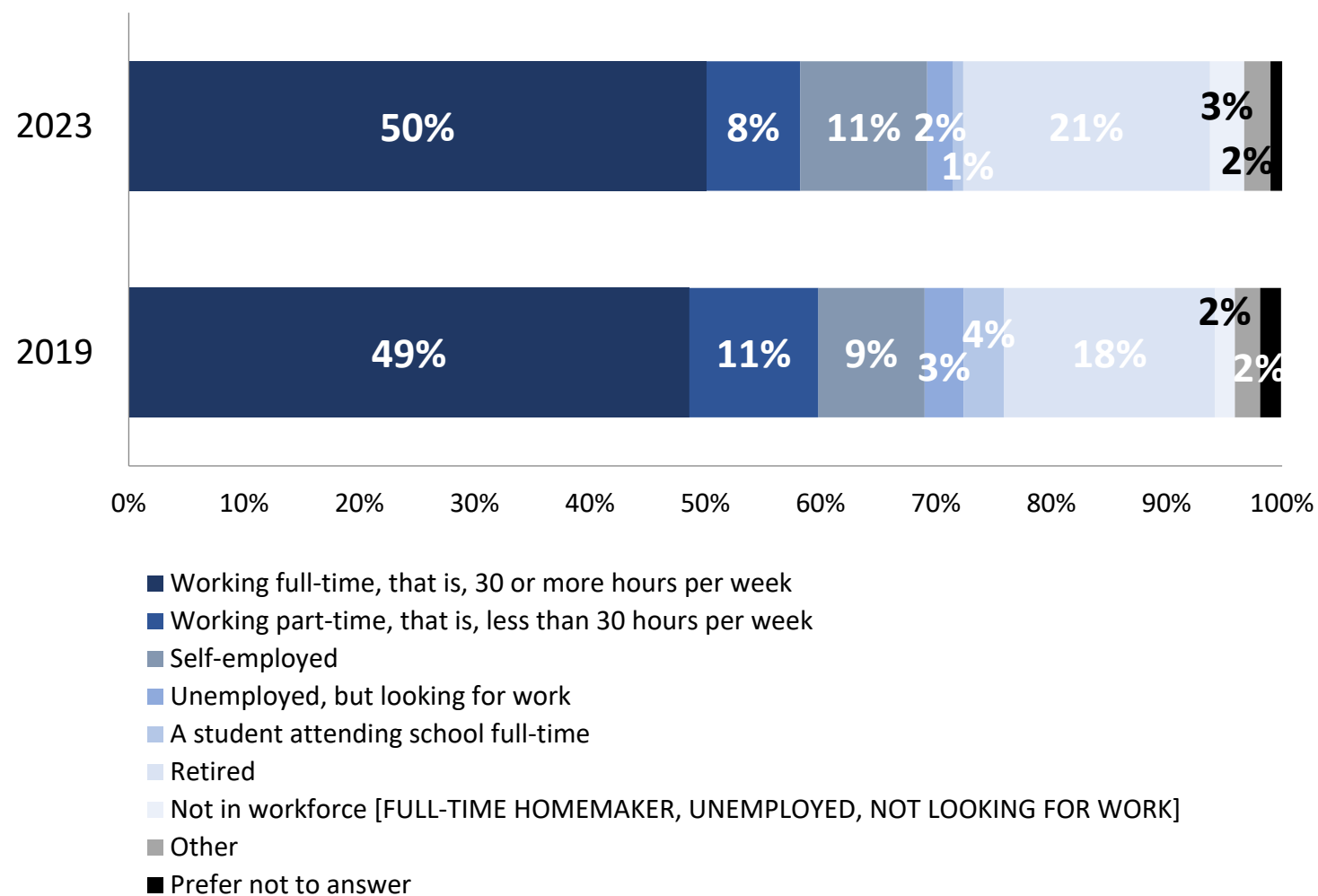


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Consistent with the previous wave of research in 2019, one in two Canadians report they work full-time, while around one in ten each are working part time or self-employed, and just over one in five are retired.

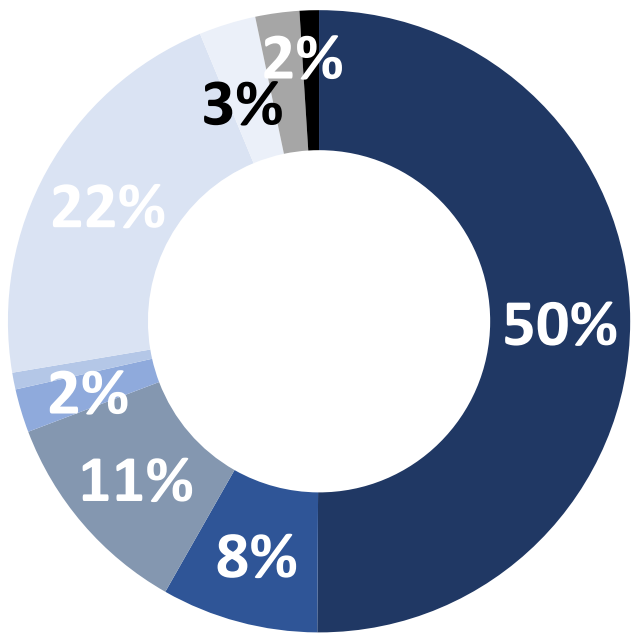

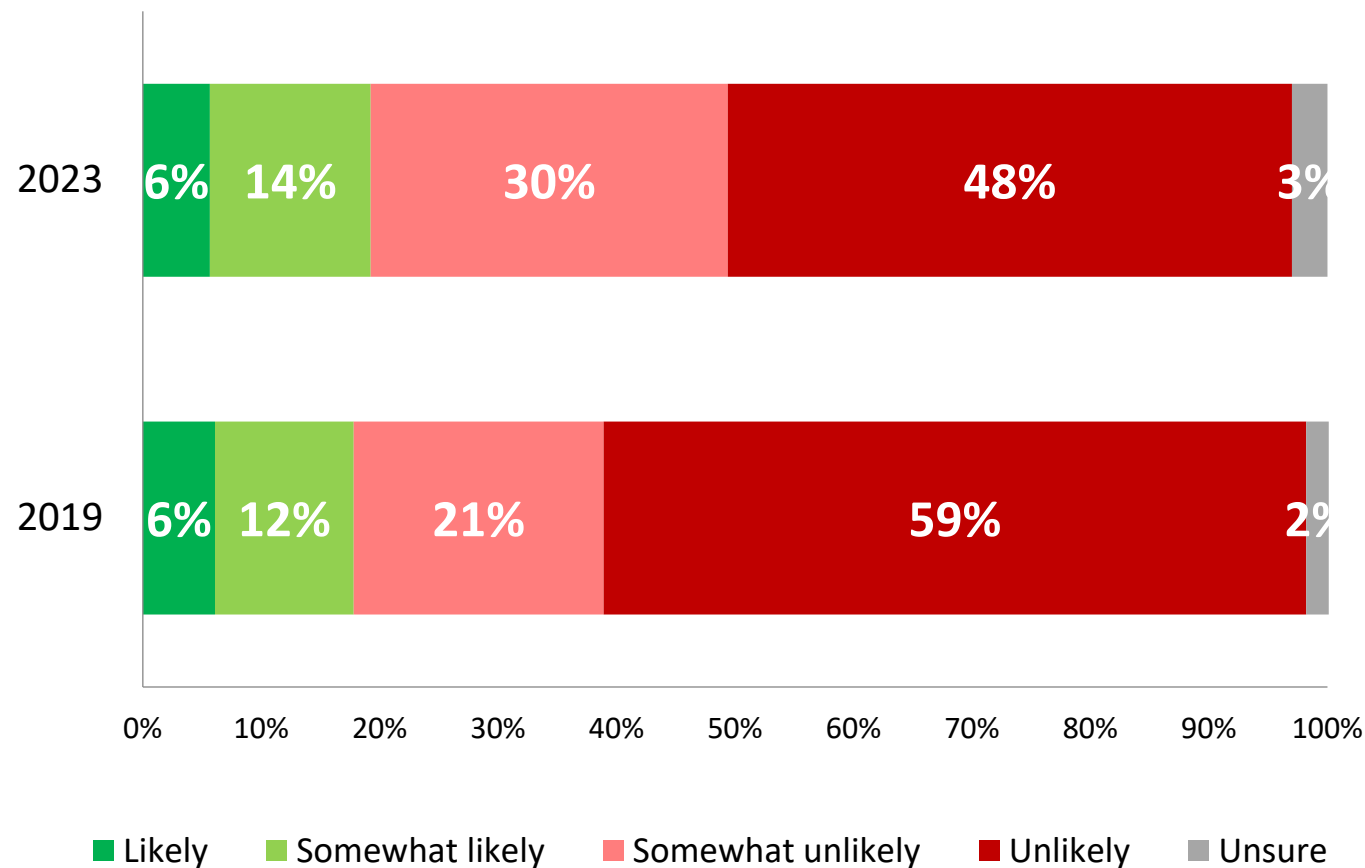

A majority of Canadians say technological changes are somewhat unlikely or unlikely to threaten their jobs. The proportion of those who say it is unlikely has decreased by nine percentage points since 2019 and the proportion who say it is somewhat unlikely has increased by 11 percentage points.

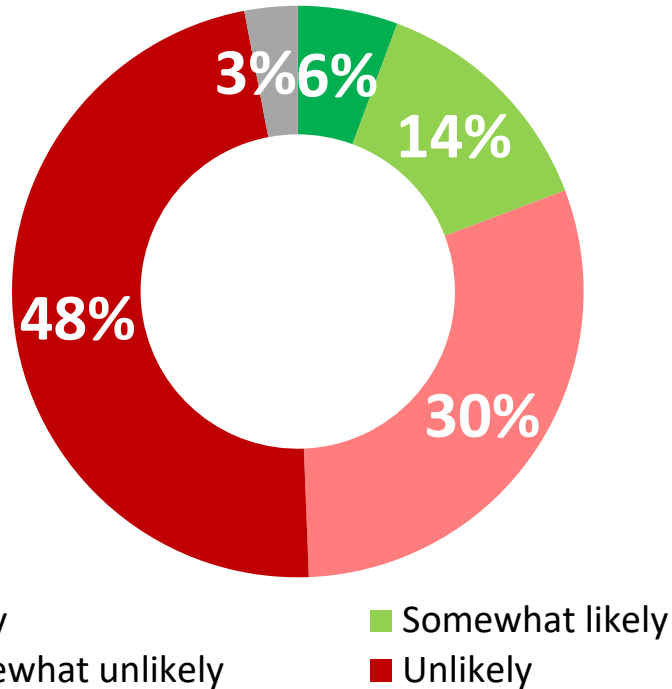

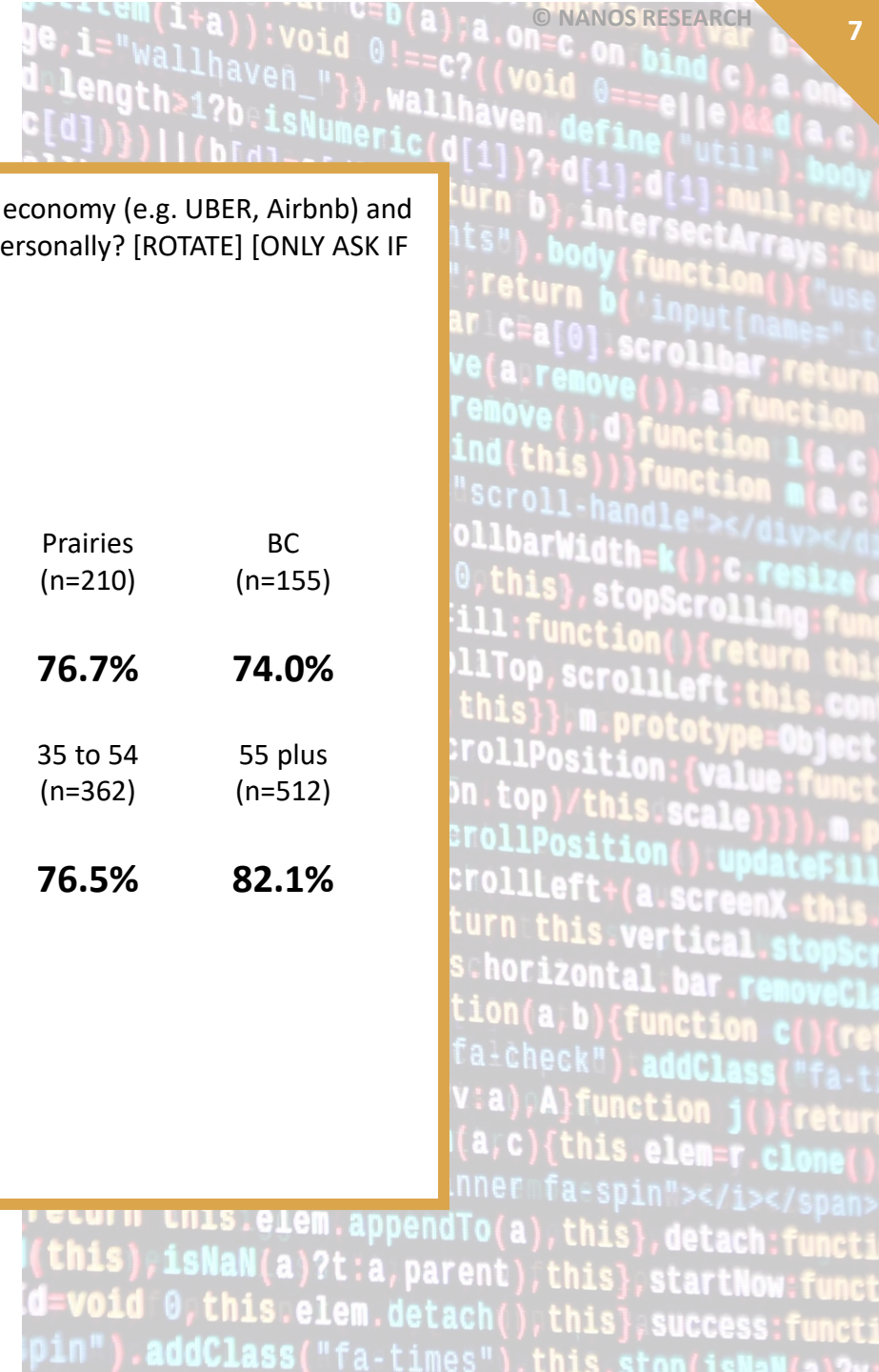

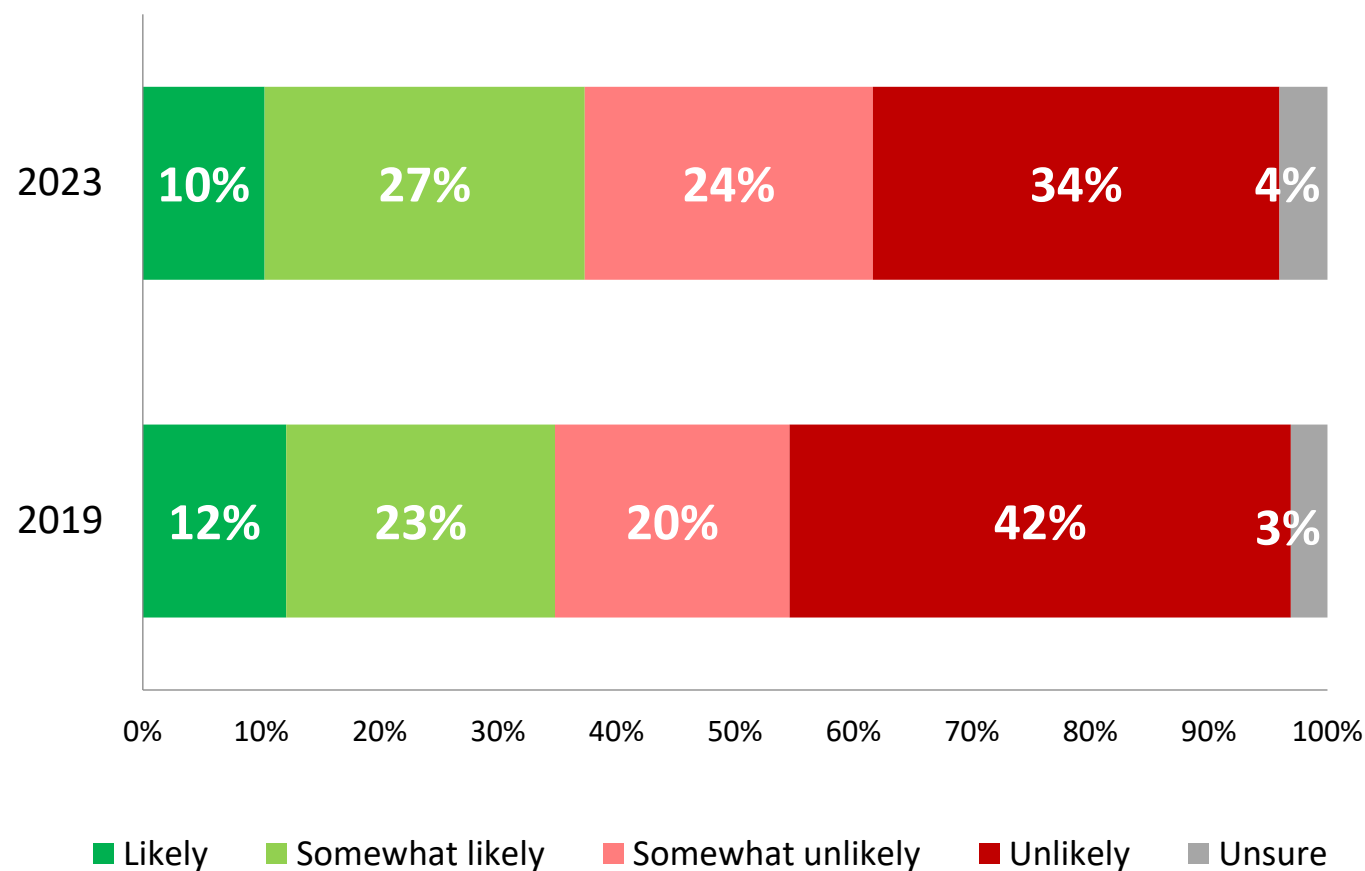


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Just under three in five Canadians say it is unlikely or somewhat unlikely that technological changes will affect their work tasks and that they will need training. 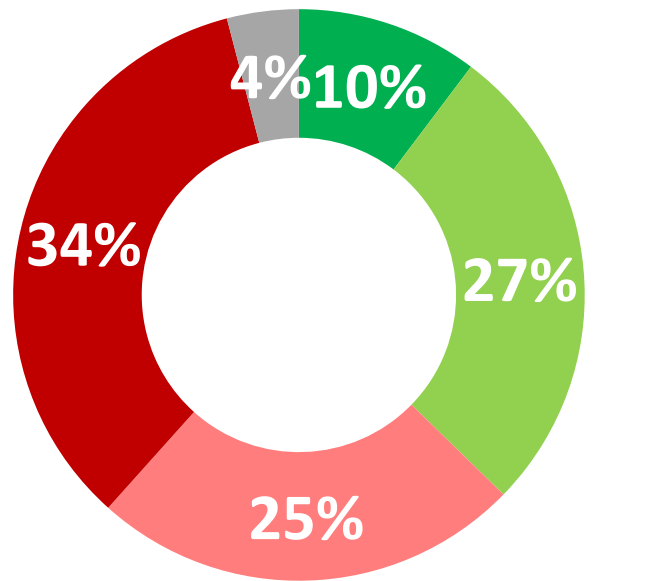

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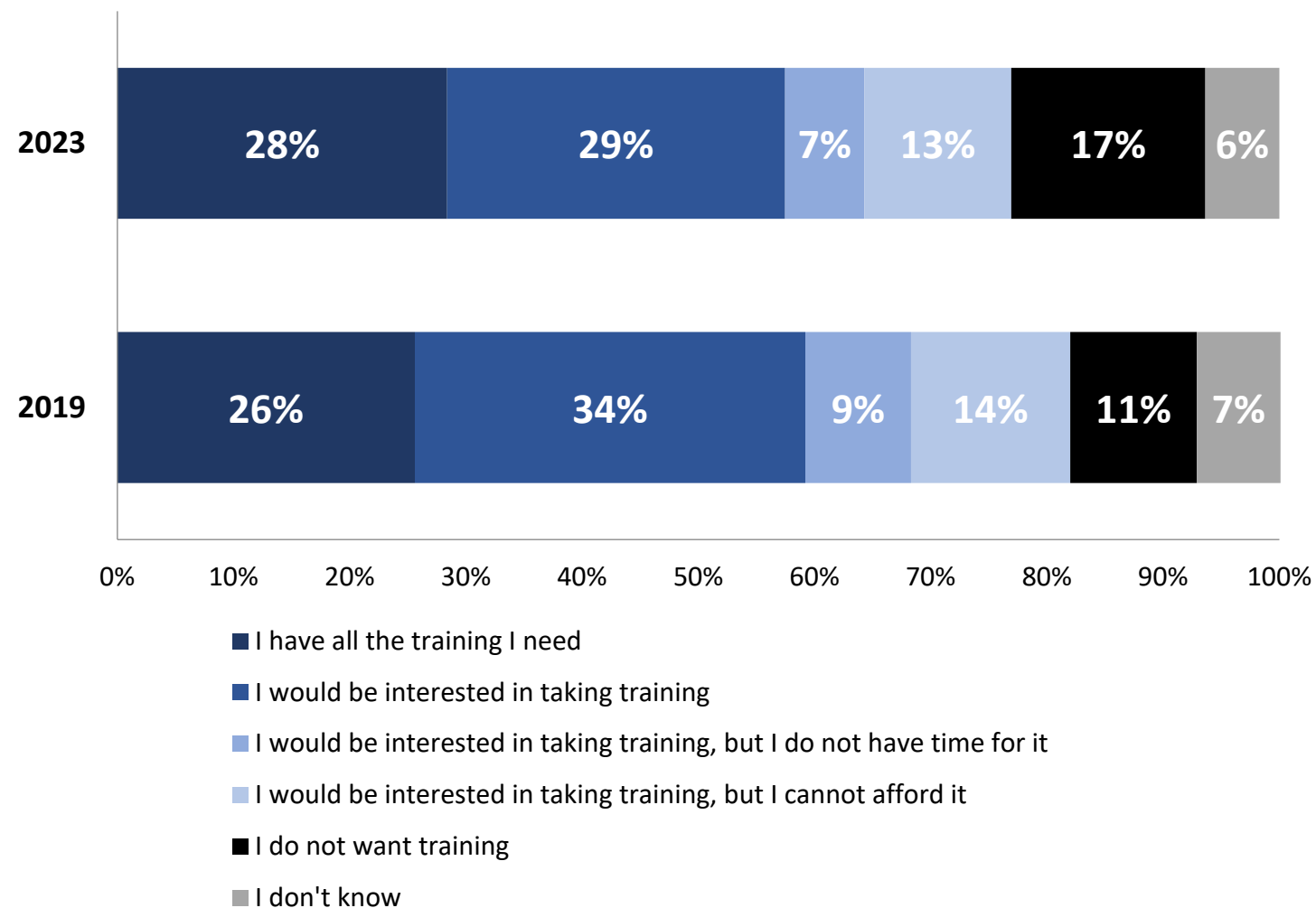


Over one in four Canadians say they have all the training they need, which is consistent with the previous wave of study in 2019, while the proportion of those who say they would be interested in taking training has decreased slightly, and the proportion of those who say they do not want training has increased.

Younger Canadians aged 18 to 34 are more likely to say they are interested in taking training than older Canadians aged 55 plus.

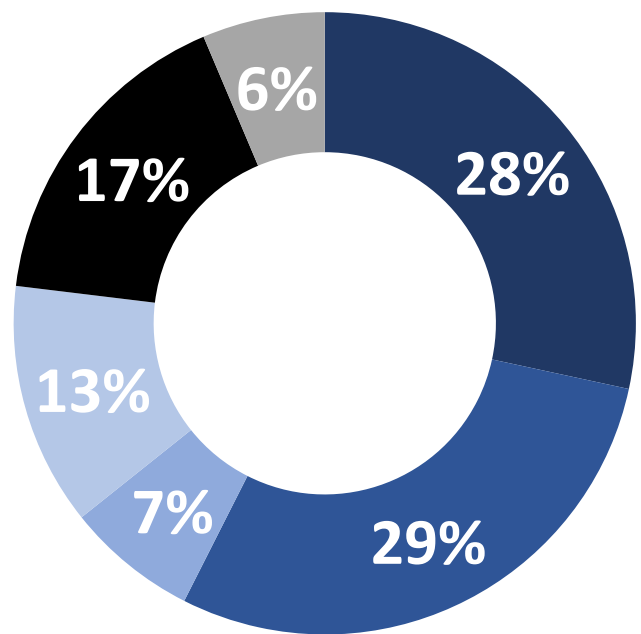

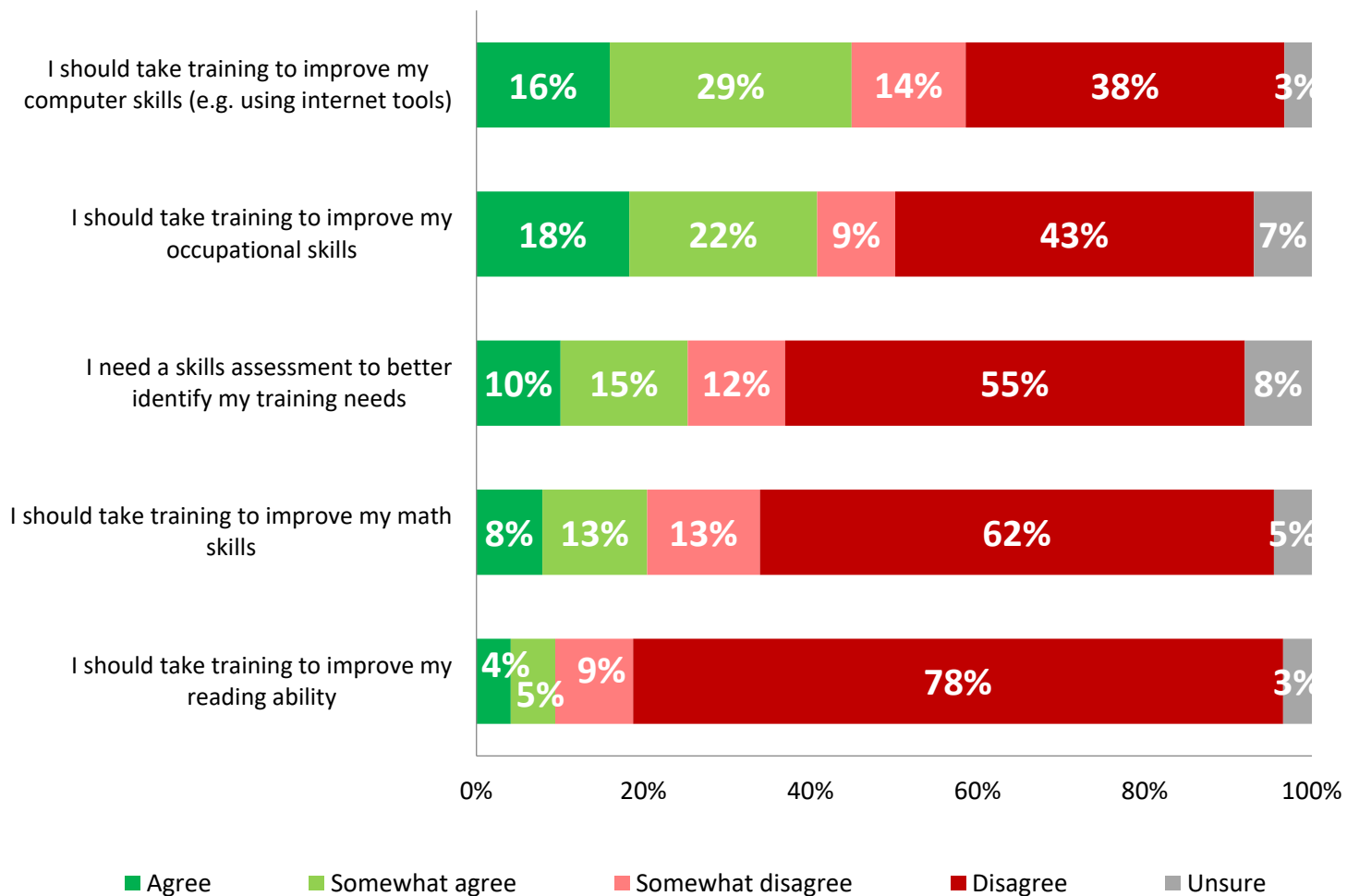

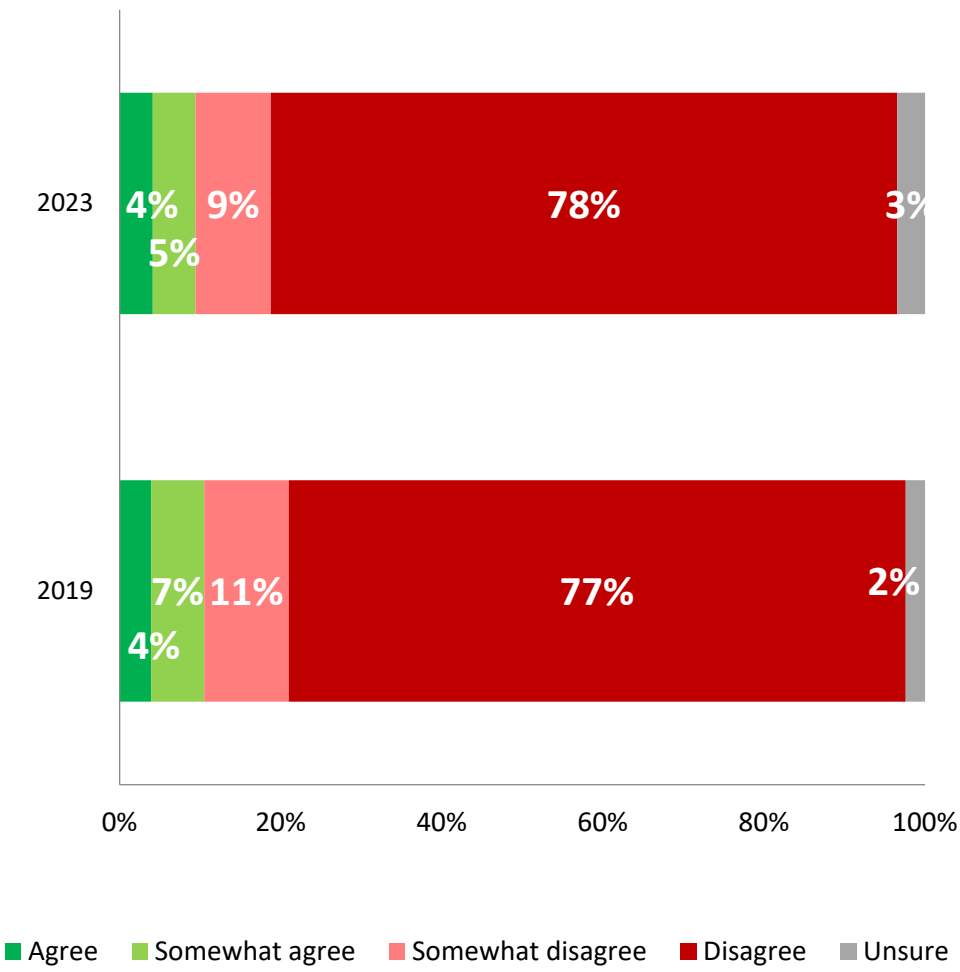

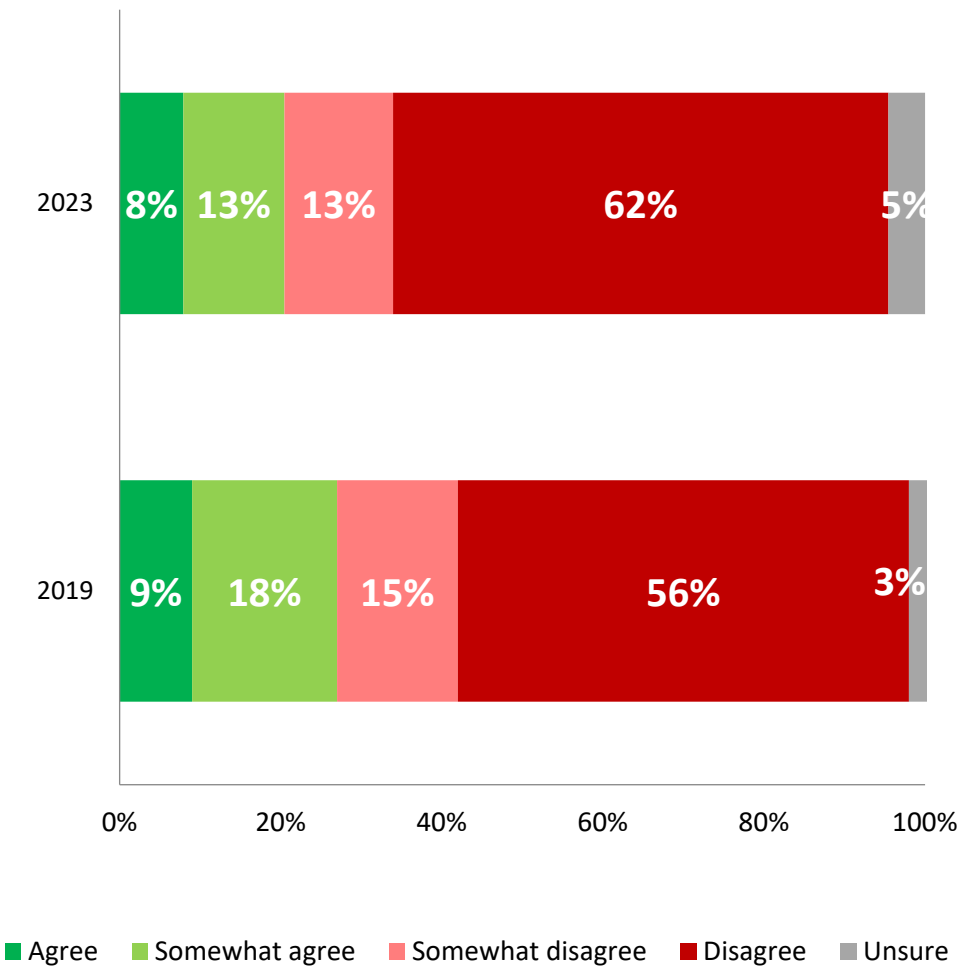

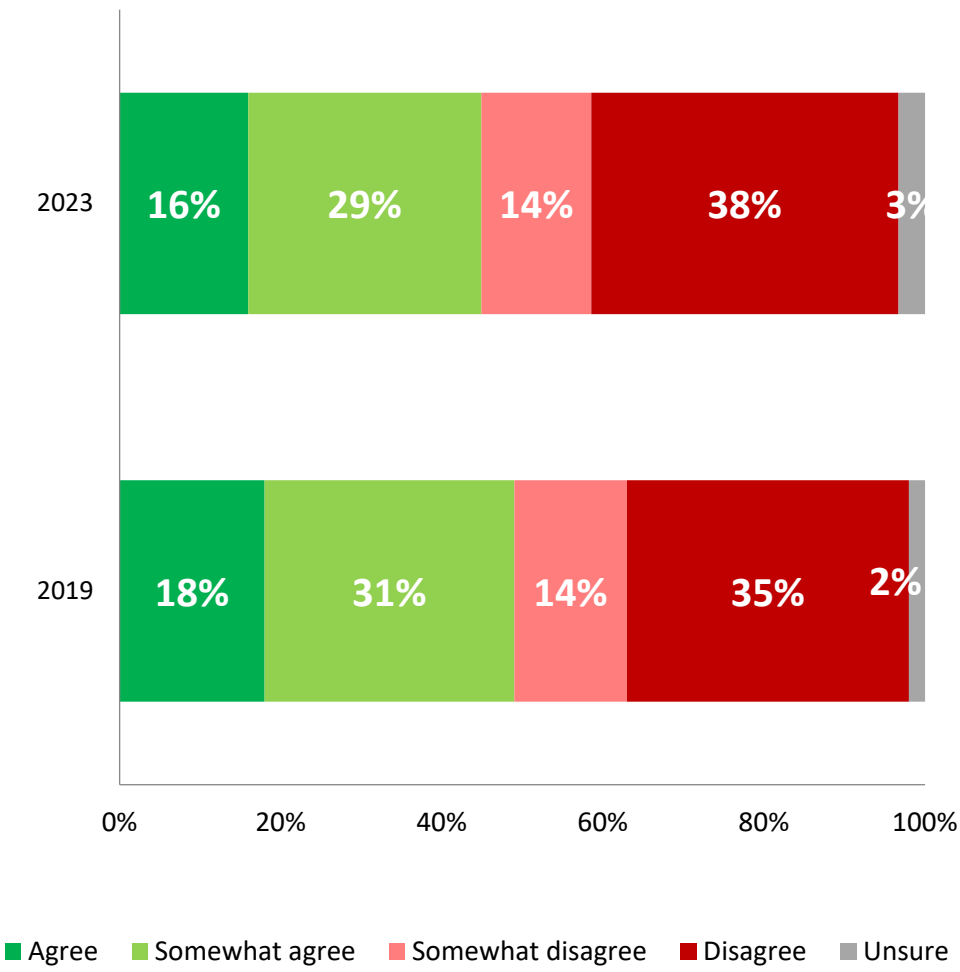

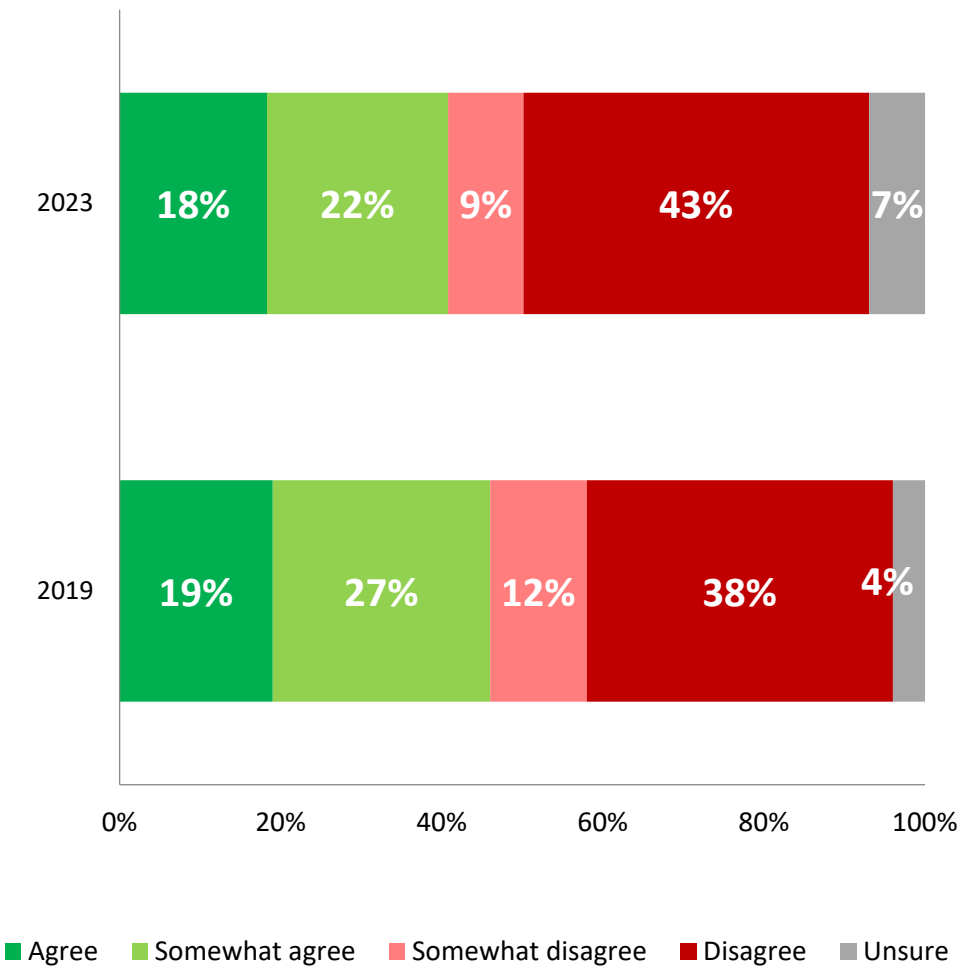

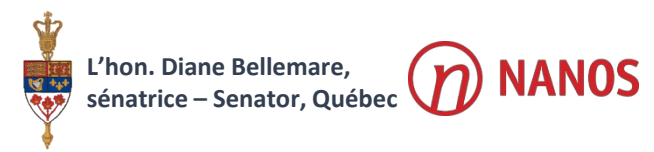

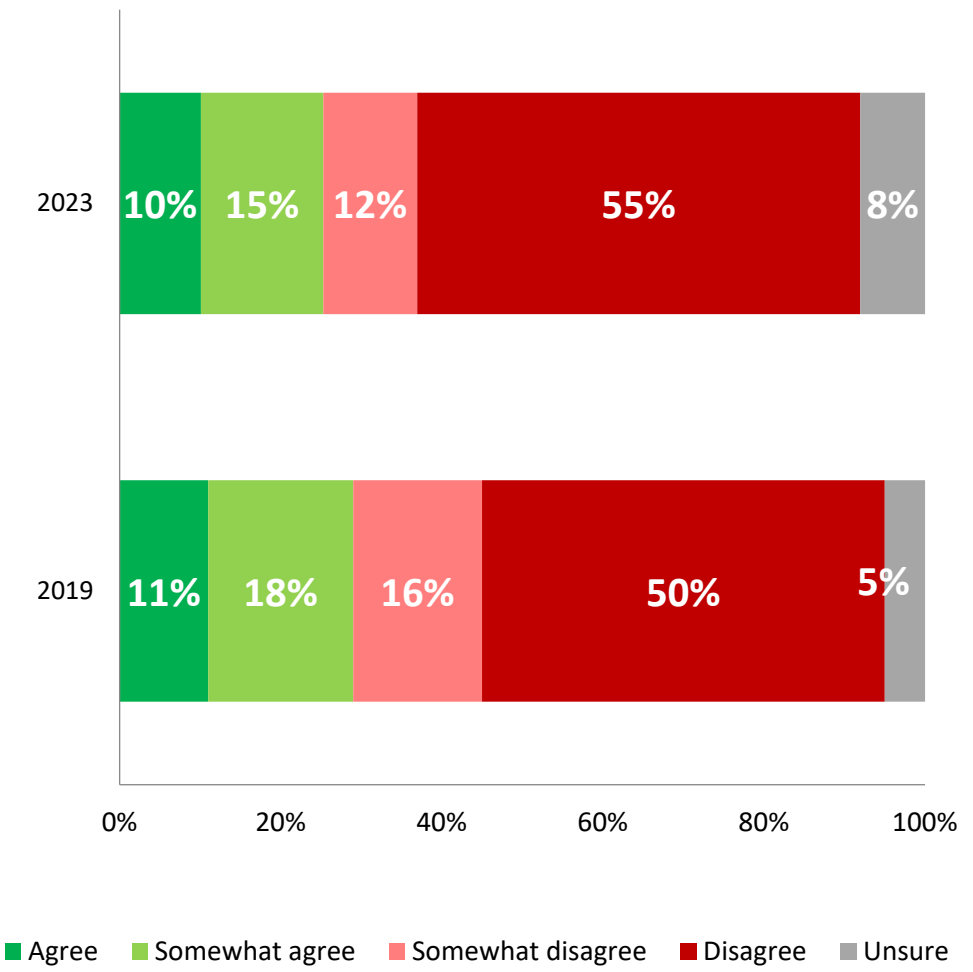

METHODOLOGY

Nanos conducted an RDD dual frame (land- and cell-lines) hybrid telephone and online random survey of 1,069 Canadians, 18 years of age or older, between November 30th and December 2nd, 2023 as part of an omnibus survey. Participants were randomly recruited by telephone using live agents and administered a survey online. The results were statistically checked and weighted by age and gender using the latest Census information and the sample is geographically stratified to be representative of Canada.

Individuals were randomly called using random digit dialling with a maximum of five call backs.

The margin of error for a random survey of 1,069 Canadians is ± 3.0 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.

The research was commissioned by Senator Bellemare and was conducted by Nanos Research.
